

BNP turned to Mossad to stay in power

Claims state minister for foreign affairs

BNP had been trying to cling to state power through using the Israeli intelligence agency, State Minister for Foreign Affairs Shahriar Alam alleged yesterday.

The government has information about it, he told journalists at his office. In this connection, he referred to meetings between BNP leaders and Mossad. "The government can ban BNP tomorrow if the information is placed together," he said.

The minister said to defuse BNP's conspiracy, the government is continuously contacting global friends. He also alleged that Pakistan has been

HC summons OC, SI for not turning in probe report in time

The High Court yesterday summoned the Officer-in-Charge BM Farman Ali and Sub-inspector Moniruzzaman of Airport Police Station to appear before it on May 29 for not submitting the investigation report in a gold smuggling case to a court despite its order.

The bench of Justice M Enayetur Rahim and Justice Amir Hossain issued the summons on a suo moto (own) move during hearing of a bail petition filed by an accused.

Illegal water trading rendering

some 30 to 40 domestic consumers are selling water from their connections, while the authorities concerned keep on turning a blind eye, alleged residents.

Visiting the areas recently, this correspondent found at least twenty points in Miller Matha, Bandartila, Cement Crossing, and Narikeltola, where Wasa water was being sold from domestic connections. The sellers kept a pipeline from where the jars were filled and then got loaded on the vans.

Rickshaw-van puller Sohel, who also sells water for a living, said he buys water from the connection of one Mohammed Javed of the Hospital Gate area.

Contacted, Javed denied his involvement in selling water. Md Jashim, who was also found

selling water to van pullers in Bandartila area, said they have permission for selling water. When asked, he could not show the document.

But as per the Wasa officials it is illegal to use domestic connections for commercial usage.

For domestic connections, Wasa charges Tk 7.61 per cubic meter or 1,000 litre, the rate is tripled for commercial use. Wasa spends Tk 15.9 for producing per cubic meter water, said Engr AKM Fazlullah, managing director of CWasa.

"We are losing money in the domestic supplies, but cannot increase the price as we are yet to supply as per demand. Many consumers have to pay the meter connection fee without getting water," he said.

"Whenever we get an allegation

we take action and so far have taken against many," said Touhidul Islam, who recently took charge as Wasa chief revenue officer.

CWasa Executive Magistrate Hillol Biswas said from January to April this year he had conducted mobile courts and disconnected a total of 44 connections, seized 9 rickshaw-vans (for selling water), four motors (for extracting water), and fined Tk 4.4 lakh across Chittagong city for various irregularities including water selling.

Selling Wasa water from domestic connections is a punishable crime under article 52 of Water Supply and Sewerage Authority Act 1996, he said, adding, the offender could be fined up to Tk 10 thousand or face up to six months' imprisonment or both.

Cabinet 'safe haven for convicts': BNP

BNP yesterday alleged that the current cabinet has become a "safe haven" for convicts as three ministers punished by courts were still in it.

The party also accused the government of being of "double standards" as opposition-backed elected representatives were being arrested and removed from offices in "false cases" on one hand while ruling party men and ministers were left untouched even after being convicted by courts on the other.

Addressing a press conference at BNP's Naya Paltan central office, Senior Joint Secretary General Rizvi Ahmed said though no action was taken against ruling party convicted leaders, the government has so far suspended 23 BNP-backed mayors, 27 upazila chairmen, 13 upazila vice chairmen and over 200 UP chairmen and members after implicating them in 'false' cases.

"A special judge's court in Dhaka on February 14, 2008 convicted Disaster Management and Relief Minister Mofazzal Hossain Chowdhury Maya, jailed him for 13 years and fined him Tk 5 crore in a graft case. The attorney general and other legal experts said Maya cannot be there in the cabinet anymore," he said.

ZIA CHARITABLE TRUST GRAFT CASE HC order on Khaleda's prayer Sunday

The High Court will pass order on Sunday on two petitions filed by BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia seeking stay on the trial proceedings against her in the Zia Charitable Trust corruption case.

The bench of Justice M Enayetur Rahim and Justice Amir Hossain fixed the date after concluding hearing arguments from the lawyers.

On April 18, the BNP chief filed the petitions challenging a lower court order that rejected her applications in the corruption case lodged by Anti Corruption Commission in 2011, one filed for a re-cross examination of the case investigation officer while another for scrutinising the case diary.

On April 17, a Dhaka court rejected the applications after Khaleda's lawyers submitted those before the court at Bakshibazar in her presence. In the petitions filed on April 18, Khaleda also prayed to the HC to stay the trial proceedings. On April 21, a judge of another HC bench expressed unwillingness to hear the same petitions of Khaleda Zia, AC lawyer Khurshid Alam Khan told The Daily Star yesterday.

Earlier on April 7, the HC rejected another petition of Khaleda, clearing the way for a lower court to continue the trial proceedings.

WAR CRIMES TRIAL Closing arguments end against 3 of Habiganj

The prosecution yesterday in the case against three Habiganj men, who are facing four charges of crimes committed during the 1971 Liberation War, completed their closing arguments on factual aspects.

The accused -- Muhibur Rahman Boromia and his brother Mujibur Rahman Angur Mia and their cousin Abdur Razzak -- however, pleaded not guilty before the tribunal.

Prosecutor Sultan Mahmud Simon placed his arguments citing testimonies of the prosecution witnesses and the documentary evidence they have submitted earlier.

The International Crimes Tribunal-1 also started hearing the argument from the defence counsel. Masud Rana, a counsel for Razzak, yesterday placed his argument on first charge.
