Fratricide

A local Awami League leader was killed allegedly by his younger brother at Bazrapur village in Moheshpur upazila of the district on Tuesday. The deceased, Mozibur Rahman Khokon, 69, son of late Kadar Ali Tarafdar of the village, was president of ward No 3 unit of AL. Police and locals said Khokon and his younger brother Azibor Rahman Mohon locked in an altercation over distribution of mangoes. At one stage, Mohon gave a blow on his elder brother's face. He fell down on the ground and became unconscious. He later died on the way to hospital. Locals caught Mohon and handed him over to police.

Fake doctor jailed

A mobile court sentenced a fake doctor to three months' imprisonment in Kawkhali upazila of the district on Tuesday. The convict is Kazi Md Hasan Imam Shameem, 40, son of Abdul Mannan of Dibuarpur village. Md Jahangir Hossain, officer-in-charge of Kawkhali Police Station, said Shameem introducing himself as an MBBS doctor and medical officer of Patuakhali Eye Hospital has been giving treatment to the local people for the last few months. On information, the law enforcers raided his house in the afternoon and arrested him. He was later produced before the court, led by Upazila Nirbahi Officer Labani Chakma, which pronounced the verdict.

Fire at Prime Bank

A fire broke out at Prime Bank Ltd in the town early yesterday, burning computers, important files and furniture. The bank was at a building adjacent to Dinajpur Fire Service and Civil Defence. Nur Islam, assistant director of Dinajpur Fire Service and Civil Defence, said the sentries found fire on the second floor of the building. Immediately, the firefighters informed the bank officials about the incident. As the bank officials arrived there after half an hour, the firefighters rapidly went to the spot and doused the blaze around 3:00am. Bank officials blocked journalists and declined to provide any information.

Youth, schoolboy beaten to death in Kushtia, Narsingdi

A young man and a schoolboy were beaten to death in Bheramara upazila of Kushtia and in Narsingdi town yesterday and the day before.

In Kushtia, police recovered the body of a youth from Islampur area of Bheramara upazila yesterday, reports our correspondent.

The dead was identified as Zinnat Ali, 26, son of Fazlul Haq of the area. He was a day labourer.

Nur Hossain Khondokar, officer-in-charge (OC) of Bheramara Police Station, said locals found Zinnat's body on a farmland and informed them. Police recovered the body at around 1:30am.

Police, quoting family members of

the victim, said Zinnat had a quarrel with neighbour Bablu over allegation of an extramarital affair between his wife Sabina and Bablu.

Zinnat went out of his house on Tuesday and did not return. He was beaten to death, the OC said.

Police are trying to find the killers, he added.

In Narsingdi, a schoolboy was beaten to death allegedly by two classmates over previous enmity at Khalpar in the district town on Tuesday afternoon, reports a correspondent.

The deceased was identified as Parvez Miah, 13, son of Sattar Miah of Bilasdi in the district town. He was a Class VII student in Narsingdi Ideal High School.

Golam Mostafa, officer-in-charge of

Narsingdi Police Station, said Parvez and his friend Nurul Amin, 13, also from Bilasdi, went out of their school during tiffin hour.

At that time, two of their classmates -- Ariful Islam and Ruman Miah -- took Parvez and Nurul to Khalpar and mercilessly beat the duo with a cricket bat, leaving them seriously injured.

On information, some teachers of the school rushed to the spot and took them to Narsingdi General Hospital, where doctors referred them to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH).

Parvez succumbed to his injuries on the way to the DMCH around 3:00pm, the OC added.

'GUNFIGHT' WITH COPS

Criminal killed in Laxmipur

A criminal was killed in a 'gunfight' between police and his cohorts at Junedpur village in Laxmipur Sadar upazila early yesterday.

The deceased, Yousuf, 35, son of Ali Akbar of the village, was a member of local criminal gang 'Laden Masum Bahini'.

Four policemen also sustained injuries during the 'gunfight' that took place in front of Mollabari of the village, police said.

Officer-in-Charge Azizur Rahman Mia of Chadranganj Police Station said law

enforcers, acting on a tip-off, arrested Yousuf from Bangshal area in the capital on Tuesday noon and brought him to Laxmipur the same night.

After primary interrogation, a police team took Yousuf to the village to recover firearms.

Sensing the presence of the police team, Yousuf's accomplices opened fire forcing the law enforcers to retaliate, the OC said, adding that Yusuf was shot and died on the spot while other members of the gang managed to flee.

Police also seized a pistol and five bullets from the spot.

Charge-sheeted accused takes oath as UP chairman

A newly elected union parishad (UP) chairman, charge-sheeted in a case for torturing a woman, took oath at the deputy commissioner's office in the district yesterday.

DC AKM Shamimul Haque Siddiquee administered the oath of office to the elected chairmen at noon. Superintendent of Police Syed Mosfiqur Rahman was present.

The accused is Khaledul Islam Swapan, chairman of Gazalia Union Parishad in Galachipa upazila, and president of the upazila unit of Jubo League.

On March 27, a woman's head was shaved for her alleged extra-marital affair with a nephew of her husband of Ichhadi village under the union.

Police on May 4 submitted charge sheet against Swapan and MA Kuddus, former chairman of the

union, in the case for torturing the woman, said Md Rafiqul Islam, officer-in-charge (inquiry) of Galachipa Police Station.

Following publication of the gazette, the district administration had arranged the oath-taking function for the UP chairmen elected on March 22, the DC said, adding that he did not know who was charge-sheeted.

SP Syed Mosfiqur Rahman said he was not aware that the charge-sheeted accused took oath at the DC's office.

Khan Mosharraf Hossain, administrator of Patuakhali district council, among others, was present at the oath taking function.

Despite repeated calls this correspondent could not contact the newly elected UP chairman for his comment on the issue as he did not receive phone calls.

In total, the number of known planets outside our solar system now sits at 3,264 - an impressive figure, considering astronomers had never spotted any as recently as 1989.

Of the 1,284 new planets, around 550 are believed to be rocky, like Earth. Nine of these also sit in their star's 'habitable zone', where the surface temperature allows liquid water to exist. With this new discovery, the number of known planets in the universe which could hold the building blocks for life has increased to 21.

Ellen Stofan, chief scientist at Nasa's Washington headquarters, said: "This [discovery] gives us hope that somewhere out there, around a star much like ours, we can eventually discover another Earth."

In total, Kepler spotted 4,302 planet 'candidates' between 2009 and 2013, 1,284 of which had a 99 percent or greater probability of being a planet.

Another 1,327 are considered "more likely than not" to be planets, so the Kepler discovery could be even bigger than Nasa is claiming. 707 are believed to be "other astrophysical phenomena," rather than genuine planets.

5 sued for killing child worker

Five people, including the bakery owner, have been sued on charge of killing a child worker at Ramkrishnapur village in Laxmipur Sadar upazila on Monday.

Abul Kalam, father of slain Alauddin, 12, filed the case accusing bakery owner

Mohammad Nasir, and its four staff--Al-Amin, Shahjahan, Shamim and Mizan--with Chandraganj Police Station on Monday night.

After filing of the case, police arrested Nasir, 32, and Al-Amin the same night. Officer-in-Charge (OC) Azizur Rahman of Chandraganj Police Station said.

The arrestees were yesterday produced before the

Chief Judicial Magistrate Court that sent them to jail.

Alauddin was beaten to death allegedly by his employer and colleagues at Ananda Bakery in the town.

Quoting victim's father, police said Nasir along with other staff of the

bakery beat up the boy mercilessly for not attending his workplace in early hours everyday, leaving Alauddin dead.

The killers then hung Alauddin's body from the ceiling of the bakery and fled the spot.
