## NOT PROCURING QUAKE EQUIPMENT HC issues contempt rule against 3 govt officials

The High Court yesterday issued a contempt rule against three government high officials including relief and disaster management secretary on the charge of not procuring necessary rescue equipment in line with its 2009 directive in case of any earthquake disaster.

Two other officials are director general of fire brigade and its director (operation).

In the rule, the court asked the officials to explain by Sunday as to why contempt proceedings should not be initiated against them.

The bench of Justice Syed Muhammad Dastagir Husain and Justice AKM Shahidul Huq came up with the rule following a contempt petition filed by Human Rights and Peace for Bangladesh. Petitioner's counsel Manzill Murshid told The Daily Star that the HC following a writ petition on July 29, 2009 in its directive asked the government to procure necessary rescue equipment in case of any earthquake disaster in the country.

The HC also ordered the government to form a committee to review the government's preparation in facing earthquake disaster and prepare a list of equipment in this regard.

Later on, a committee was formed and it made a list of equipment along with recommendations, he said.

Manzill said the government too purchased equipment, but some of them were not in line with the recommendation of committee formed under the HC directive.

It means that the respondents did not comply with the HC directive properly which tantamount to contempt of court, he added.

## Road crashes kill 2, injure 4

Talking to The Daily Star on the sidelines of the roundtable, Dr Guillaume Fournie, a veterinarian and epidemiologist from the Royal Veterinary College, UK, said through BALZAC they would have a better understanding of the whole range of poultry value chains in Dhaka and Chittagong.

Md Ahasanul Hoque, who teaches veterinary epidemiology at Chittagong Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, hoped that the outcome of this exercise would provide the government and departments concerned with better policy options to contain avian influenza.

completed, our mothers and sisters will feel secure when they go outside their homes..."

A DNCC female ward councillor, Shanaz Parvin Mitu, demanded for an equal treatment with their male counterparts.

"Our territory is vast. We work hard but don't get proper recognition," said Masuda Aktar, another DNCC ward councillor.

There are 36 male councillors for the same number of wards under DNCC whereas the number of female ones is only 12 (one female councillor for every three wards).

Toufique Imrose Khalidi, editor-in-chief of bdnews24.com, said though female ward councillors were somewhat empowered, their power was not proportionate to their male counterparts.

While giving a keynote presentation, Kazi Sufia Akhtar, movement Secretary of BMP central committee, demanded playgrounds, libraries, hostels, public transports, toilets and security for women.
