

200 families homeless as Jamuna erosion serious

Erosion by the Jamuna River has rendered over 200 hundred families under five unions of two upazilas homeless in the last five days.

The erosion-hit five unions are Bharatkali in Saghata upazila and Gazaria, Fazlurpur, Kanchipara and Uakhali in Fulchhari upazila.

The increasing water level of river also devoured nearly 200 homesteads at several villages under the unions.

Besides, around 300 families living near the danger points have already started shifting their belongings to safer places. Many of them have even taken shelter on the abandoned embankment and roads.

A number of homesteads, including two educational institutions, have been devoured by the surging water of Jamuna in the last two weeks.

KUSHTIA SCHOOLTEACHER Medical board finds rape evidence

A female teacher of Mujibnagar upazila in Meherpur, who is undergoing treatment at Kushtia General Hospital, was a victim of rape.

A three-member medical board led by Dr Tarun Kanti Ghosh, associate professor of Kushtia Medical College, said while talking to the

journalist at the hospital after carrying out the test yesterday.


The 24-year-old woman, now undergoing treatment at a hospital under police custody, might have been raped in an unconscious state, Dr Tarun said.

Officer-in-Charge Shahabuddin Chowdhury of Kushtia Model Police Station said we have asked

the adjacent police stations to enhance their cooperation to arrest the culprit.

We also alerted the Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) members at different border points so that the culprit could not cross the border, Sub-inspector Ashraf Islam of the police station, also the investigation officer of the case, said.

The female teacher along with her school's headmaster Shariful Islam went to Kushtia on Thursday night to attend the teachers registration examination scheduled for Friday.

Kid raped, accused held

A child was raped allegedly by a youth in Kaliti village under Kulaura upazila of the district yesterday morning.

The alleged rapist, Swapon Rajbhar, 20, of the village, is an unemployed person.

Anwar Hosain, sub-inspector of Kulaura Police Station, said the victim, a six-year-old child was at her house in the morning while her family members went outside for work.

Locals said Swapon went to the girl's house and lured her with chocolate to go to his house, and raped her. Hearing the screams of the girl, neighbours went to the spot, rescued the victim and admitted her to Moulvibazar 250-seat hospital.

Md Shamsudoha, officer-in-charge of Kulaura Police Station, said police arrested Showpon Rajbhar in the morning.

Victim's family filed a case in this connection yesterday.

Over 1,500 teachers sans govt's pay roll for years

Over 1,500 teachers and employees of non-government colleges, high schools and madrasas in the district have been serving without monthly payment order (MPO) for years.

At present, at least 67 institutions in the district are eligible for getting MPO. Of them, five are in Sadar, five in Fulchhari, 14 in Sadullapur, four in Palashbari, 15 in Gobindaganj, 15 in Sundarganj and nine in Saghata upazilas.

Getting little financial help from their institutions occasionally, the teachers and staff are having difficulty in maintaining livelihood and consequently, losing interest in their job.

"We have no other option for searching new jobs at present, as we have already passed 18 years of services with the hope of getting MPO," said some teachers of Lengabazar Ideal College in Sadar upazila.

According to district secondary education office, an educational institution should comply with the terms and conditions including location, population, board accreditation, result of public examination and number of students and teachers for enrolling MPO as per government directives. On fulfilling the conditions, an institution can apply for MPO to the authorities concerned.

At least 67 non-government educational institutions in the district are yet to get MPO after submitting proposals through proper channel. The teachers and staff are reluctant to teach students properly amid this adverse situation.

During a visit to some institutions, it was found that Lengabazar Ideal College was set up in 1998 and got permission to start functioning in 1999 and received academic accreditation of the board in 2003. The college is yet to be enrolled for MPO despite repeated appeals to the

authorities concerned.

"We have passed a long time rendering sincere education to the children but received very poor amount from college fund and are still waiting for MPO," said Uzzal Kumar, a lecturer of the college.

Over 200 students of the college appear in the public examinations every year and achieve bright results.

We appealed to education ministry for MPO, but no progress was made in this respect, said Mizanur Rahman, principal of the college.

Patoya Mehdiabag High School in Gobindaganj upazila was set up in 1998 and got academic accreditation in 2003 but the school is yet to be enrolled for MPO.

Contacted, District Secondary Education Officer Shaheen Akhter said they often forwarded proposals of educational institutions for enrolment under MPO as per requirement but the matter depends on the government's decision.
