**Radiohead shares cryptic video**

Radiohead posted an ominous video to Instagram yesterday, set to a snippet of its "A Moon Shaped Pool" track "The Numbers."  
The video shows a barefoot, plain-dressed man carefully sweeping up a few scraps of garbage while a trickle of sand behind him slowly fills up his tiny habitat.  
Radiohead credits the video to London-based director Oscar Hudson, who also shouted it out on his official site.  
A week ago, the band announced it had commissioned some artistes to craft "short vignettes" interpreting parts of the new album.  
"A Moon Shaped Pool" was released to mass acclaim on April 27 and debuted at No. 3 on the Billboard 200.

**AvoidRafa's "Bhaar" released**

To anyone who has followed the rock music scene of Bangladesh over the last decade, Rafa is one of the most distinctively recognizable names. From his early days as a heavy metal drummer to adding a fresh burst of energy to local rock juggernaut Aurthohin and being a fantastic record producer, he has done a great deal, but that has not come without a cost: an album of his own.

Finally, that weight got off his chest, when "Bhaar", the debut album of his solo project AvoidRafa, was released on Friday at the Russian Cultural Centre. ABC Radio FM 89.2 - where Rafa also hosts his show HotBox - partnered with HotBox Entertainment for the event that featured album signing and a live concert. ABC Radio's COO Daniel Afzalur Rahman and popular ad and TV filmmaker Shafayet Mansur Rana were present at the ceremony. A

number of rockers from other bands also joined Rafa on stage for a portion of his live set.  
The double-disc album had earlier been available for a free stream on AvoidRafa's site, which it still is, and is also available on the music streaming app Gaan, aside from the physical CDs. Rafa's musical prowess shines through in the 21 songs (plus a bonus track), that mixes up powerful progressive rock with funky pop-rock styles that his audience come to associate him with.

**Zainul's death anniversary observed in M'singh**

A painting competition for children was held at the hall room of Shilpacharya Zainul Abedin Sangrahshala (art gallery) marking the 40th death anniversary of the master painter, on May 20. Marking the anniversary, the art gallery organised two-day programmes that included a discussion.  
Over 107 children from different educational institutions took part in the competition in four groups. Of the participants, 12 were selected for prizes. The judges of the competition were Mohammad Abdur Rouf, principal of Shilpacharya Zainul Abedin Fine Arts Institute; and Badal Chakraborty, a trainer of Zainul Shishu Charupath.  
Earlier, Nihar Ranjan Roy, principal of Alamgir Monsur Memorial College inaugurated the competition as chief guest. Deputy keeper of the art gallery Dr. Bijoy Krishna Banik delivered the welcome speech.  
At the inaugural session, the speakers said that the younger generation would benefit greatly through a promotion of the ideology and art works of the maestro. Shilpacharya, the pioneer of modern art in this part of the globe, placed Bangladesh arts on the world map, they added.

"I'm deeply grateful to have spent the last 10 years with my family at 'Grey's Anatomy' and ABC, but for now, I'm taking some welcome time off," Ramirez said in a Twitter statement Thursday night.  
Shonda Rhimes, creator of the show, commented: "Dr. Callie Torres came into our lives dancing it out in her underwear almost a decade ago and I could not be happier or more proud of her journey. Sara Ramirez's performance inspired me as well as millions of fans each week. We wish her the best on her well-deserved time off. I

will miss Callie tremendously, but am excited for what the future holds for Sara. She will always have a home at Shondaland."  
Ramirez wrote that she is leaving "for now," which suggests she may return to the show - and as stated in both Ramirez and Rhimes' tweets, it appears that the door is open, should she want to return.  
Confirmation of Ramirez's exit comes after the actress fueled speculation that she may be on her way out by posting a mysterious tweet last month, tweeting, "That's a wrap for Doctor Callie Torres ... Thank You all for an enriching & unforgettable rollercoaster ride!"  
Ramirez first appeared in Season 2 of "Grey's Anatomy" and was upped to a series regular in Season 3.

Moushomi and Fatema. The challenge set before them was a fish kofta which must also maintain a spongy texture. The idea did not seem new to the participants and they went about their work with immense focus.  
In the end though, not everyone could be declared a winner. Rafiya won the round, earning yet another badge but Moushomi wasn't so lucky.
