

Road crashes kill five

CITY DESK

Five people were killed and five others injured in road accidents in four districts yesterday.

In Jessore Sadar, Mahmudur Rahman Topu, 23, at Chachra check post was killed when a bus rammed his motorcycle in Palbari area.

The bus driver was driving on the wrong side of the road, police said.

In Chittagong, an unidentified man, aged around 40, was killed when a lorry ran him over while he was crossing the Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Baroiarhat municipality area of Mirsarai upazila.

In Mymensingh, a visually impaired beggar was killed when a truck crushed him while he was sitting on a rickshaw beside Mymensingh-Haluaghat road in Amuakanda area of Phulpur upazila.

The deceased was Rabiul Karim, 35, of Deugram.

In Savar, Bhujua, a member of an ethnic minority community, hailed from Rangpur, was killed when a truck ran over him while he was standing beside Dhaka-Aricha highway in Nayarhat area of Ashulia.

In Baroiarha area of the district, an unidentified person was killed and five others were injured as a bus plunged into a ditch beside Nabinagar-Chandra highway.

25 fishermen 'abducted' from Sundarbans

At least 25 fishermen were allegedly abducted by bandits from the east Sundarbans early yesterday.

Locals said members of "Sagor group" abducted them from different points of the forest.

The bandits are demanding Tk 20,000 to Tk 25,000 as ransom from each of the families, they said.

The abducted hail from Joymoni, Chila and Sundortola of Mongla upazila, and different villages of Rampal upazila in Bagerhat.

Of them, Mukul, Polas, Rana, Pitor, Sujon and Mamun are of Chila, locals said.

Md Saidul Islam, divisional forest officer of east division of the Sundarbans, and Mehedi Masud, zonal officer of west zone of coast guard in Mongla, however, said they were not aware of the incident.

Mobile libraries at doorsteps enlightening Naogaon people

Recently introduced 10 mobile libraries are enlightening the rural people of all 10 unions of Mohadevpur upazila of Naogaon for more than a month as those are getting a huge response.

Upazila Nirbahi Officer Tajkir-Uz-Zaman took the initiative to reach books to the doorsteps of common people, especially schoolchildren, who cannot afford those.

"We named the mobile library Deepshikha (flame)," Tajkir told The Daily Star.

Around 1,000 booklovers are visiting all the 10 libraries daily, one in each union, said the UNO.

Different kinds of books -- includ-

ing fictions, dictionaries and those which can help school students understand their text books -- are available at the libraries.

The people are benefiting from the process as they can read or borrow books, some of them are expensive, for free, said locals.

The upazila administration used rickshaw-vans for setting up the mobile libraries.

Village police of each union are assigned to voluntarily carry Deepshikha to one village to another in their respective unions every day.

Weekly, they stop at at least three educational institutions to facilitate students.

Ranjit Roy, one of the caretakers of

Deepshikha, said this van is also helping him generate income as the authorities concerned allowed him to use the vehicle to sell educational materials, including notebooks, pens, pencils and geometry boxes.

"Those who have no ability to buy a book, they can borrow it easily," said Ranjit, adding that he is quite happy for being a part of the initiative.

"From almost everywhere I got positive response from all walks of people especially schoolchildren," he said.

Suriya, a class VIII student, said it is a good initiative to spread knowledge among children in rural areas. "It's helpful for us as it has the books that we cannot afford," she said.

Man killed in Rangpur

A man was killed in Monirampur village under Pargachha upazila of Rangpur yesterday.

The deceased was Russell Mia, 30, of the village. Two people were arrested in this connection.

Family members said Russell, a farmer, did not return after some people called him outside home on Thursday night. The next morning his body was found 50 metres away from his home.

Police sent the body to Rangpur Medical College Hospital for an autopsy.

22 Eligibility and qualification of tenderer

- The minimum number of years of general experience of the tenderer in the construction works as prime contractor or subcontractor or management contractor shall be 10 (ten) years.
- The minimum specific experience as a prime contractor or subcontractor or management contractor in construction works of at least 1 (one) contract of minimum 5 (five) storied RCC frame structure building with 10 (ten) storied foundation having minimum 1 (one) basement successfully completed in government/semi-government/autonomous organization of Bangladesh within the last 10 (ten) years, with a value of at least Tk 60.00 (sixty) crore.

Man killed in Mymensingh fire

A man was killed in a fire incident in his house in Baghmara area of Mymensingh Sadar yesterday.

The deceased was Abu Mukhlesur Rahman Khan, 45. Fire Service officials said Mukhlesur was staying in the house alone as his family members went to a relative's house.

Locals saw smoke coming out of the house around 5:30am and informed fire service. Fire fighters doused the fire after one hour and recovered his body.

The fire might have occurred from an electric short circuit, said the officials.

Child drowns in Jessore

A six-year-old boy drowned in a fish enclosure in Arua village under Keshabpur upazila of Jessore yesterday.

The deceased was Abul Hossain son of Rezaul Islam of Sagardattakathi village.

Locals said in the morning Hossain with his twin brother and maternal grandfather went to the fish enclosure. At one stage, he slipped into the enclosure and drowned.

He was rushed to Keshabpur Upazila Health Complex where doctors declared him dead.

Schoolboy dies from electrocution

A schoolboy died from electrocution as he came in touch with a live electric wire, which was torn down by a storm, in Rohodaha area of Shariakandi upazila in Bogra on Thursday evening.

Shohan Mia, 15, son of Shobdal Akanda of the area, was a student of class X of Noakhila PN High School.

His foot came in touch with the wire as he could not detect it in the dark while he was returning home on foot from a flood control embankment, said police and locals.

Sub-inspector Suman Kadri of Shariakandi Police Station said they would take actions after investigation.

The body was sent to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital.
