# Five children hurt in bomb blasts

Four child workers and another child were injured in two bomb blasts in Ashulia and Savar, on the outskirts of the capital, yesterday and on Sunday.

In Ashulia, three unidentified persons riding a motor-bike yesterday exploded a bomb near a restaurant in Ashulia Rural Electrification area, leaving four of its child workers injured, said witnesses. However, police said the explosive was found by an employee of the shop and it exploded when he threw it in the air.

In Savar, eight miscreants blasted Molotov cocktails into a victory rally of Firoz Kjol, a newly elected member of Harindhara Union Parishad, in Hemayetpur area on Sunday, leaving one injured.

To me, she is still alive. A woman like her can't die."

That was the tone of the memorial meeting jointly organised by Bangladesh Mahila Parishad at Bangla Academy. Nurjahan Begum died on May 23 at age 91.

Editor of the Begum magazine, Nurjahan had created a space for women writers and journalists in the country's first illustrated Bangla magazine for women, by breaking the shackles of strictly conservative Bangalee Muslim society of the 1940s.

Bangladesh Mahila Parishad President Ayesha Khanam said the progressive role of women in every sphere of life today was not achieved in a day; it happened because of the role of visionaries like Nurjahan, who worked in silence to transform society.

She said today there were hundreds of women journalists, and surely many of them were inspired by the courageous leap Nurjahan had taken.

Women's leader Dr Maleka Begum said Nurjahan Begum would live on in her works. She was a journalist, women's movement organiser, and women of all professions and geographical areas found place in her magazine.

The visibility of women in today's society is the contribution of women like Nurjahan Begum, Begum Rokya and Begum Sufia Kamal, she added.

# Another accuses

Some army men and 20 to 25 Razakars got down, detained some Hindus and brought them to one Banabasi Sutradhar's house in their village, he said.

The other group detained some other Hindus, including him, from the village and took them to the house, he added.

Keeping them under the surveillance of two armed Razakars and other Razakars, the army men went to neighbouring Nabinpur village, and when they returned after some time, they were heard saying the Hindus there had fled, said Badal.

The 39 detainees including him were taken to Nikli Police Station and following the order of Hussain, 35 adults were tied with ropes while he and three other minors were kept under a jackfruit tree in front of the station, he said.

The Razakars and army men started torturing the 35 with sticks and bayonets and then they took them away, said Badal.

Around 8:00pm, they heard gunshots and after an hour, the captors including Hussain returned, talking to each other about how the detainees were shot dead, he said.

Hussain and an army man released them the next day. His father, elder brother, five cousins, brother-in-law, three nephews were among the victims, he added.

He said one Kamini Barman had managed to flee the killing with a bullet wound in his hand. Badal said Razakars and Pakistani army men had also tortured women of their village that day. Defence counsel Abdus Sattar Palwan completed his cross-examination before the three-member tribunal led by Justice Anwarul Haque, who adjourned proceedings until June 12.
