PATENTING JUTE GENOMES

Govt to spend over \$8m on legal fees

The government has decided to spend \$8.25 million on legal assistance over a span of 15 years to obtain patents on jute genomes decoded by Bangladeshi scientists.

The cabinet committee on purchase gave the approval of the expenditure in retrospect nearly six years into the government's embarking on a contact with US law firm, Foley Hoag, in 2010 to gain an exclusive right to the use of the intellectual property. Bangladeshi scientists led by Maqsudul Alam decoded

the genomes of two types of jute plants in 2010 and 2013. The team also decoded the genome of a fungus harmful to more than 500 crops in 2012. Right after the first success in jute genomics, the govern-

ment appointed the foreign legal firm in December 2010 through direct purchase method instead of the open tender method. After years of paper works, retrospective approval for the

appointment of Foley Hoag for a 15-year period (2010-2025) at an expense of \$8.25 million has been given by the cabinet committee on economic affairs in March this year. Yesterday's approval from the cabinet committee on

purchase came in line with that long process. Officials confirmed The Daily Star yesterday that

Bangladesh rushed in retaining the foreign legal service for patenting taking into consideration the tremendous interests on obtaining jute genome patents by some other competing countries including a neighbouring one.

Applications have already been filed for seven out of 15 intended patents on the intellectual property and two of those are in the final stage of getting patented in 12 countries including the United States while three others are also at an advance stage and two more are at provisional stage. Preparations for filing the rest are underway, they said.
