≸tar editor gets HC bail in 10 cases

The High Court yesterday granted anticipatory bail to The Daily Star Editor and Publisher Mahfuz Anam for eight weeks in 10 cases.

With yesterday's order, Mahfuz Anam got bail from the HC and lower courts in all the 82 cases filed against him. Of the cases, 65 are defamation suits while 17 were filed seeking to bring sedition charges against the Star editor.

The HC bench of Justice AKM Asaduzzaman and Justice Md Ataur Rahman Khan granted the bail after hearing 10 separate petitions filed by Anam seeking anticipatory bail in the cases.

The Star editor appeared before the HC bench during the hearing.

Barrister Rafique-ul Hug, assisted by Barrister Abbas **Uddin and Barrister Margub** Kabir, moved the petition for Anam.

Hajj flights from Aug 4

Hajj flights to carry Bangladeshi pilgrims to Saudi Arabia will begin on August 4 and continue till September 5.

The return flights would operate from September 17 to October 16, Civil Aviation and Tourism Minister Rashed Khan Menon said yesterday.

He was talking to reporters following an interministerial meeting on Hajj preparations at the Secretariat.

The holy Hajj is likely to be on September 12, subject to moon sighting.

PPRC-UNDP STUDY ON HOUSEHOLDS

Less than half of the people surveyed by the UNDP recently said they were optimistic about their individual future, prompting calls for an improvement in political governance and establishment of the rule of law.

Only 10.1 percent expressed confidence that the country's political situation would improve.

The survey was conducted last year over 1,500 households in Dhaka city, 17 municipalities and 33 villages covering 45 districts. The study findings of the United Nations Development Programme were

shared at a policy dialogue on "Challenges of political development and sustainable growth: costs and consequences of political conflicts in the college, told The Daily Star. Bangladesh" at the UNDP office in the capital yesterday.



Bangladesh at high risk

Says global study

Bangladesh is fourth among countries most at risk of malware threats, according to Malware Infection Index 2016 of Microsoft Asia.

The index released yesterday listed Pakistan, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Nepal and Vietnam as Asia-Pacific countries with the highest malware encounter rates.

Clinton 'clinches the nomination'

Hillary Clinton has reached the number of delegates needed to capture the Democratic US presidential nomination, according to tallies by two US media outlets, as she and rival Bernie Sanders face off in contests in six states yesterday. Passing the milestone of 2,383 delegates late Monday

secured Clinton's status as the presumptive Democratic nominee, and she becomes the first female standard-bearer of a major US political party.

It's a dramatic political resurgence for a highly experienced but controversial candidate who lost to Barack Obama in their 2008 battle for the Democratic nomination. This time the 68-year-old former secretary of state survived an extraordinarily
