

Govt to recruit 28,000 primary teachers finally

The government finally decided to recruit 28,000 candidates waiting on a panel as assistant teachers in newly nationalised primary schools.
The Directorate of Primary Education (DPE) yesterday issued notice to all district primary education officers and authorities concerned to take steps to appoint the candidates as assistant teachers at the primary schools, which were nationalised in 2013, sources said.
According to yesterday's order, the candidates can be appointed in the newly created posts in around 23,000 newly nationalised schools alongside the vacant posts.
The government decided to recruit them to the posts in line with a Supreme Court directive.

Denmark to give US dollar 51m for sustainable dev

Denmark will provide US dollar 51 million to support the Bangladesh Country Programme (BCP), which focuses on inclusive, pro-poor and sustainable growth in the country.
Danish Ambassador to Bangladesh Hanne Fugl Eskjaer and Senior Secretary of Economic Relations Division Mohammad Mejbahuddin signed an agreement in this regard yesterday, said a press release of the Danish embassy.
The BCP has overall goals of "contributing to poverty reduction, growth and sustainable development as well as promoting democracy, respect for human rights, rule of law and good governance," it said.
It consists of three thematic programmes -- agricultural growth and employment; climate resilience and sustainable energy; and governance and rights.
The total support for the programme is US dollar 94 million. Denmark will contribute about US dollar 51 million while Bangladesh government's contribution to BCP will be equivalent to about US dollar 43 million.

Nigerian man, wife held

Police claimed to have nabbed two persons including a foreigner in the capital's Bashundhara on Wednesday allegedly for stealing money from an offshore company account.
The arrestees are a Nigerian and his Bangladeshi wife, said Monirul Islam, additional commissioner of Dhaka Metropolitan Police at a press briefing in DMP media centre yesterday.
Monirul, however, did not disclose the name of the company and amount of the money.

Proactive disclosure needed for easier flow of info

Speakers tell handover ceremony of publication on RTI camp

Proactive disclosure makes flow of information easier for both seekers and providers, speakers told a programme held in the capital yesterday.
The programme was organised at the Information Commission office, marking the hand-over of a publication and video documentary "Tearing the Veil of Secrecy" to the chief information commissioner, prepared by Management and Resources Development Initiative (MRDI) under its project with Manusher Jonno Foundation (MJF).
The publication contains lessons learnt from the Right to Information (RTI) Camp organised at Shinghajhuli in Chowgacha upazila of Jessore last year.
The camp aimed to make the people aware about the change information can bring to their lives and inspire them to use the RTI Act to get information that impacts their wellbeing.
Chief Information Commissioner Prof Dr Md Golam Rahman hailed the RTI camp as a new idea of advocacy.
Executive Director of MRDI Hasibur Rahman, Information Commissioner Nepal Chandra Sarker and Information Commission Secretary Sadaruddin Ahmed were also present.

PUBLIC HUMILIATION OF TEACHER IN N'GANJ HC directs SP, OC to submit probe reports by August 4

Shyamal Kanti returns home from DMCH

The High Court yesterday directed the superintendent of police and officer-in-charge of Bandar Police Station in Narayanganj to submit detailed investigation reports by August 4 on the incident of public humiliation of schoolteacher Shyamal Kanti Bhakta.
The bench of Justice Moeenul Islam Chowdhury and Justice Md Iqbal Kabir gave the order in response to their time petitions, and fixed August 7 for further hearing.
On May 29, the HC bench during hearing of a May 18 suo moto rule, ordered Narayanganj's deputy commissioner and police officials to submit separate reports specifying the steps taken against those involved in humiliating the teacher by June 8, and expressed dissatisfaction over earlier reports.
Meanwhile, the HC bench yesterday expressed satisfaction over a report submitted by the DC through Deputy Attorney General Motaheb Hossain Sazu, where the DC said two law and order protection committees have decided to take steps so that the law and order centring the teacher's humiliation does not deteriorate further.
On May 13, AKM Salim Osman, Jatiya Party lawmaker from Narayanganj-5 constituency, was seen instructing Shyamal to do squats holding his ears. Before that, he was beaten up by a mob.
The education ministry had earlier submitted another probe report saying that the Piyar Sattar Latif High School committee forced headmaster Shyamal Kanti Bhakta to resign with unproven allegation that he had hurt the religious sentiment of the Muslims.
The allegation brought against Shyamal was not found to be true, the probe body said, adding that relevant rules were not followed in suspending him. Later he was reinstated.
Meanwhile, Shyamal returned to his home yesterday after undergoing treatment for over two weeks at Dhaka Medical College Hospital. A police team escorted the headmaster to his Khanpur house in Narayanganj city in the afternoon, said Abdul Malek, officer-in-charge of Narayanganj Sadar Police Station.

Wrongly imprisoned Sylhet man gets bail at last

Nurul Islam of Sylhet, who had been allegedly suffering in jail for over two years in place of his younger brother in a murder case, got bail from the High Court yesterday.
Nurul Islam's younger brother Nazrul Islam alias Nunu Moulavi, who is the real accused in the case, was convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment by a Sylhet court in the case filed for the killing of madrasa student Nazrul Islam alias Dina in 1992.
Dina was son of Abdus Salam of Mewa village in Bianibazar upazila of Sylhet.
Yesterday, the HC bench of Justice Abu Bakar Siddiquee and Justice Mustafa Zaman Islam granted bail to Nurul Islam, 56, for next six months following an appeal filed by him seeking bail in the case, his lawyer Mohammad Aftab Uddin told The Daily Star, adding that Nurul Islam had been in the jail since March 18, 2014 due to a mistake made by police.
The investigation officer of the case wrote the name of Nurul Islam as Nunu Moulavi Nurul Islam in the case.
On March 18, 2014, police arrested Nurul Islam in place of Nazrul Islam, added Aftab.
In 1999, the trial court sentenced Nazrul Islam (Nunu Moulavi), Abdus Jalil, Abdur Rahman alias Sad, Abdus Sahid, Enam Uddin, Khalilur and Nizam Uddin to life imprisonment in the case.
Of them, Nazrul Islam and Enam are now absconding, said the lawyer.
