

France savour opener against Romania

controversy and untimely injuries comes to an end for hosts France when they finally get Euro 2016 underway against Romania in Group A

at the Stade de France on Friday. Les Bleus' preparations on the field have been distracted by claims from Real Madrid striker Karim Benzema that

his exclusion from the squad was racially motivated. Benzema hasn't played for Les Bleus since October last year after becoming embroiled in a sex-tape blackmail

scandal that targeted then international teammate Mathieu Valbuena. France's highest active goalscorer, Benzema -- who is of Algerian descent -claimed coach Didier Deschamps had "bowed to pressure from a racist part of

France." In addition, Benzema's Madrid teammate Raphael Varane will miss the tournament due to a hamstring injury.

Coach Didier Deschamps' defensive options are severely depleted as Barcelona's Jeremy Mathieu also had to withdraw from the squad, while Liverpool's Mamadou Sakho wasn't included as he was serving a provisional ban from UEFA for doping. Lassana Diarra, Kurt Zouma and

Mathieu Debuchy are also sidelined, and Deschamps has acknowledged he never imagined being hit with such headaches even just a few weeks ago.

"Everything that has happened to us since the squad was announced on May 12, honestly, even in my worst nightmares I don't think I could have imagined it," Deschamps told sports daily L'Equipe on Wednesday.

Yet, expectations are still high that a team boasting the precocious young talents of the likes of Paul Pogba, Anthony Martial and Antoine Griezmann can repeat the feats of the containing Griezmann, fresh from a 32-French sides of 1998 and 1984 in winning the World Cup and Euros finalists Atletico Madrid. respectively on home soil.

"We have the chance to play at home, there will be pressure, but it will be positive," said goalkeeper Steve all of the expected back four of Sagna, Mandanda.

"We have the obligation to have a good tournament and the objective is to win it."

Deschamps' men have been in fine form, winning nine of their last 10 matches over the past year with their only defeat coming to England when minds were focused elsewhere just days after the November Paris terror attacks.


While France's forward line will be blessed with pace and youth, there will be plenty of experience at the back with Laurent Koscielny, Adil Rami and Patrick Evra in their thirties.

Romania's hopes of springing a huge surprise will be based around a solid defence as they reached a first major tournament in eight years with the best defensive record in qualifying.

Anghel Iordanescu's men conceded just twice in 10 matches in qualifying behind Northern Ireland in Group F and also held European champions Spain to a 0-0 draw in March.

They would be delighted to frustrate the hosts before later games against Albania and Switzerland.

"The pressure on France is greater. If we manage to get a draw it would be extraordinary, and if we win it would be fantastic," said Romania assistant coach Viorel Moldovan, who used to play in France for Nantes.

Pele, Diego friendship

Diego Maradona hailed his old rival Pele as an "icon" as the pair were reunited for a "match of friendship" on Thursday.

The 75-year-old Brazil great and 55-year-old Argentine legend even embraced during the five-aside exhibition game in a sign that they have drawn a line under their longrunning feud.

"I want to thank Pele, we know who he is and who he will always be. We need icons like him," said Maradona, who starred in Argentina's 1986 World Cup triumph.

Pele, a three-time world champion, also struck a conciliatory tone in response.

"The most important is the message of peace. Many thanks to my friend Maradona for this opportunity and a big round of applause to the players who have been here today," said Pele.

"This is a moment of peace."

It was a far cry from the acrimony between them when FIFA was trying to decide the player of the 20th Century in 2000.

The world body organised an online vote which Maradona easily won. But FIFA thought the online users at the time were too young and so the vote was skewed in Maradona's favour.

It then organised a vote by readers of the FIFA magazine and cast by an international jury. This time Pele won by a landslide.

Dunga hails Coutinho

Brazil coach Dunga hailed hattrick hero Philippe Coutinho for delivering his Liverpool club form in the colours of the Selecao after he inspired the team to a 7-1 victory over Haiti at the Copa America.

Two of Coutinho's goals were beautifully struck long-range efforts and he was a constant threat throughout the one-sided game with his movement and ability on the ball.

"We have talked quite a lot to him about being the 'Liverpool Coutinho' - to take the initiative, be a leading part of the team, all within his own style," said Dunga, the former 1994 World Cup-winning captain.

"He is really taking advantage of the opportunities he has been given. After his first goal you could see him gain confidence and a player with confidence is always going to be better," he added.

Prior to Tuesday's win Coutinho had only

scored one goal for Brazil, last year in a friendly against Mexico.

Brazil's other goals came from Renato Augusto (2), teenage star Gabriel Barbosa and Lucas Lima. Coutinho had opened the scoring in the

14th minute with a long-range effort, his second was a simple tap-in and his hat-trick was completed in the final moments of the game with a spectacular bending strike from 25 yards out. "We knew we had to try more shots from

distance and this was something we improved on over the last game," said Coutinho, referring to the goalless opener with Ecuador. The 23-year-old now hopes that Brazil can

progress deep into the tournament.

"I think we have to dream big and think of the final," he said.

In the day's other match Ecuador frustrated Peru's hopes of sealing their Copa America Centenario quarter-final berth, fighting back from two goals down to snatch a 2-2 draw.

Bolt set to lose gold

Jamaican Olympic relay gold medallist Nesta Carter's "B" sample for the use of a banned stimulant at the 2008 Beijing Games has returned positive, two sources familiar with the case told Reuters on Wednesday.

The Jamaica Olympic Association (JOA) said last Friday in a statement it had received notification from the International Olympic Committee (IOC) that one of its competitors had returned an adverse analytical result but did not name the athlete.

Although his relay teammates Usain Bolt, Asafa Powell and Michael Frater are not accused of doping, it is possible the IOC could strip them of their gold medals due to Carter's Bsample testing positive.

For instance, all members of the victorious American 4x400 relay squad at the 2000 Sydney Olympics were subsequently stripped of their medals after Antonio Pettigrew admitted a doping offence and had all his results from January 1997 onwards disqualified. If Bolt, Powell and Frater lose their relay medals - they could appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).

Nadal out of Wimbledon
