**4 MOULVIBAZAR WAR CRIMES ACCUSED**

**Charges taken into cognisance**

Prosecutors finish placing closing arguments in case against 8 'Jamalpur Al-Badr men'

International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday took into cognisance two charges brought against four Moulvibazar men over crimes they allegedly committed during the 1971 Liberation War.

The three-member tribunal led by Justice Anwarul Haque also directed the inspector general of police to submit a report on compliance with its arrest warrant regarding three fugitives on or before August 2, when it will pass the next order.

All from Rajnagar upazila, Akmal Ali Talukder, 76, has been in jail since November 26 last year while Abdun Nur Talukder alias Lal Miah, 62, Anis Miah, 76, and Abdul Musabbir Miah, 64, are on the run.

The prosecution pressed the charges on

**Demand for ending targeted killings keeps ringing**

**Sammilito Sangskritik Jote announces protest rallies in districts June 18**

A cross section of people yesterday formed a human chain at the capital's Shabbagh intersection, demanding that the government immediately take stern actions to stop the ongoing wave of secret killings across the country.

Politicians, cultural personalities and students joined the human chain expressing deep concern over the series of murders and demanded justice for the slain bloggers and writers.

Golam Kuddus, president of Sannilito Sangskritik Jote (SSJ), said the militants are targeting people of the religious minority groups to convey the message that the state is not safe for them, and the extremists want them to leave the country.

"...the minority people are now living with anxiety," he added.

Kuddus announced that SSJ will hold rallies at district level on June 18, protesting the secret killings.

**BRAC'S NANOSAT**

**Say hello to Annesha 3B**

Brac University yesterday declared the name of a small artificial satellite, Annesha 3B, which it plans to launch into low earth orbit by May 2017.

Vice Chancellor of the university Prof Dr Syed Saad Andaleeb announced the name and signed an agreement with its Japanese partner in satellite venture, Kyushu Institute of Technology (KIT), at a special ceremony arranged on the university campus in the capital.

Director General of the Spectrum Division of Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission (BTRC) Col Md Nasim Pervez, present on the occasion, congratulated Brac University on creating history by planning to launch the country's first satellite in the orbit.

"We'll be launching geostationary communications satellite, Bangabandhu 1, on December 16, 2017, which is 3.5 tonnes in weight. The Brac's one is a nanosat, weighing less than a kilogramme. Than again size of the satellite is not an issue. The issue here is translating dream into reality. Everything starts from zero," said the BTRC DG.

The low-cost small satellite, categorised as nanosat, has been purposefully developed to serve academic and research goals. KIT has been with Brac University's nanosat launching process since the signing of a memorandum of understanding a couple of years ago and is now helping it launching the nanosat through Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) and the International Space Station (ISS).
