## Charge framed against 5 for issuing fake bail orders

They also forged judge's signature; trial set to start June 21

COURT CORRESPONDENT

A Dhaka court yesterday framed charges against five people, including a bench assistant (peshkar) of another court, in connection with a corruption case filed over issuing fake bail orders through forging signature of a judge of the latter court.

The accused are: bench assistant Moslehuddin Bhuiyan, peon Sheikh Mohhamad Naim and three muster-roll clerks Mohammad Ismail Hossain, Alamgir Hossain and Jahangir Hossain.

Of them, Alamgir and Jahangir have been absconding since the incident took place.

Judge Md Akhtaruzzaman of the Special Judge Court-5 indicted them and fixed June 21 to start trial of the case.

The court cancelled bail of Moslehuddin as he was absent from the court and issued an arrest warrant against him. He was earlier granted bail by the Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court.

Naim and Ismail, now in jail, pleaded not guilty and demanded justice after the charges were read out to them.

According to the case documents, 110 accused in 76 criminal cases, now pending with Dhaka

Second Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court, were released from prison in five months following the fake bail orders issued by Moslehuddin Bhuiyan and Naim.

Fourteen of the 110 accused in 14 cases were released from jail in January, 20 accused in 10 cases in February, 20 accused in 14 cases in March, 16 accused in 12 cases in April and 40 accused in 26 cases in May, last year through the fake bail orders.

On July 12 the same year, Obaidul Karim Akando, an official of the Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court, lodged a case with Kotwali police against the two court staff.

Hours after filing of the case, police arrested Moslehuddin on the court premises, but Naim managed to flee, sensing police presence.

On August 23, a team of Rapid Action Battalion arrested Naim in the capital's Adabar area

Later, police arrested Ismail and both of them gave confessional statements before magistrates on different dates.

On March 15 this year, the Anti-Corruption Commission pressed charges against the five after finding their involvement in the incident true.

## Say hello to Annesha 3B

- who helped design Annesha 3B at KIT's lab and their mentor Prof Mengu Cho, director of the Laboratory of Spacecraft Environment Interaction Engineering (LaSEINE), joined the programme from Japan and University of Texas Assistant Prof Dr Arifur Rahman Khan joined from USA, through Skype.

Compared to conventional hi-cost communications satellites, nanosats are smaller in size, weighing between one and 10kg, and can be placed in low earth orbit, 500 to 1,500km above the equator, instead of the more expensive to launch and geostationary earth orbit satellites, placed around 36,000km away from earth.

Head of Brac University's mathematics and natural sciences (MNS) department Prof Dr Abu Abdullah Ziauddin Ahmad, its computer science and engineering (CSE) department's Associate Prof Dr Md Khalilur Rahman and a Japanese embassy counselor in Dhaka Mitsutake Numahata, also spoke at the programme.

The departments of CSE, MNS, and Electrical and Electronic Engineering (EEE) of Brac University are involved in the nanosat programme.

Speakers said the nanosat venture came in good synchronisation with Bangladesh's first communication satellite as it would help expose the country's young scientists and academics to satellite technology.

Vice-Chancellor Dr Syed Saad Andaleeb said Brac University has decided to open a satellite laboratory and, one day we'll build satellites at our own laboratory."

He explained the nomenclature of Annesha 3B saying that the 3B stood for Bangladesh, Brac and BIRDS. BIRDS is the name of the KIT's project under which the satellite programme is being carried out.

BTRC DG Nasim Pervez credited Brac University for having the vision and building the future of Bangladesh's satellite technology. Col Nasim said there is a huge prospect for young Bangladeshis to work and gain in the field of satellites.

Showing a design module of the Annesha 3B, Prof Ziauddin, also a former chairman of the Bangladesh Space Research and Remote Sensing Organization (SPARRSO), said, "It's a small box but a giant stride for us."

Prof Khalil informed the audience that the final design module would be completed by the end of the month, lab testing to be completed in November and handed over to JAXA in the year-end. Then in March, JAXA rocket would take the nanosat to ISS, who would deploy the satellite in the low earth orbit through its robotic arms.

Once placed in orbit, the satellite would generate high quality photographs of Bangladesh, meteorological data, vegetation, flood, urbanisation, sea area etc and the students and faculties would be able to analyse those for academic and research purposes.

TK 270CR LOAN SCAM' ACC summons Female model ex-Agrani Bank chairman

Anti Corruption Commission (ACC) has summoned 18 persons including former chairman and some board of directors and two incumbent high officials of Agrani Bank for quizzing over a Tk 270 crore loan scam.

They will have to appear before the ACC between June 20 and June 22.

According to official documents, a proprietor of a printing press allegedly withdrew the money from the principal branch of Agrani Bank through showing fake documents.

ACC will also submit a charge sheet in another case filed against 14 persons, including former manager of Hatkhola Branch of Agrani Bank, over "gobbling up Tk 96.7 million through issuing loans to organisations against fake documents".

The document shows that the manager and two other staff gave a loan about Tk 145.4 million to different fraud organisations without scrutiny. Until April 11, the amount of the outstanding loan stood at Tk 96.7 million.

ACC also approved charge sheets against two people for allegedly misappropriating about Tk 594 million.

# 'commits suicide

over family feud'

Husband detained

A female model allegedly committed suicide over a family feud in the capital's Mohakhali yesterday.

Soheli Rahman Nitti, 28, daughter of retired superintendent of police Motiur Rahman, hang herself from a ceiling fan in her residence following an altercation with her husband, said Sridham Chandra Roy, subinspector of Banani police, quoting her husband Abhijit Bachhi.

Abhijit took her unconscious body to Mohakhali's Metropolitan Hospital where the on-duty doctors declared her dead at 2:45am, added the SI.

However, locals saw Abhijit beating Nitti after entering their house, witnesses told the police.

According to her father Motiur, as her first marriage did not work out, she married Abhijit without family consent. Two days back Nitti told her father that she was in an abusive marriage and was often beaten by Abhijit, but Motiur took no heed of the matter at that time.

Police detained Abhijit for quizzing and the deceased's body was sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital for an autopsy, said the SI.

Motiur said he would file a case against Abhijit.

- The Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission ('Commission' or 'BTRC') invites offers/proposals from eligible Bangladeshi entities (resident citizens, proprietorships, partnerships and companies registered with Registrar of Joint Stock Companies and Firms briefly 'RJSCF' under the law(s) of Bangladesh to apply for Mobile Number Portability Services (MNPS) Operator License. However, Bangladeshi entity may have NRB and/or foreign entity as partner/shareholder. Any entity without Bangladeshi partner/shareholder is not eligible to apply. In case of a foreign entity, the equity will not be more than 51% (fifty one percent) and in case of NRB, there will be no such limitation. The foreign partner/NRB shall invest in foreign currency directly equal to his percentage of ownership and no bank loan from any Bangladeshi scheduled bank/financial institution/leasing company shall be raised for the foreign part of the investment.
- The applicant/bidder shall have to have the experience of 3 (three) years of implementing and operating successfully MNP solution for a subscriber base of not less than 10 million mobile subscribers in one or more countries on the date of bidding.
- No Mobile Operator or any of its directors/shareholders shall be allowed to be Owner/Director/Shareholder/Investor/Partner of the licensed entity providing MNP service in Bangladesh.
- The applicant companies/partnership firms shall have to be registered with the RJSCF, as well as with the concerned chamber of commerce and industries (if applicable). In case of foreign companies, the Certificate of Registration from the concerned authority of its Country of Origin shall have to be provided with the proposal/offer.
