

EASTERN HOUSING AT AFTABNAGAR, BANASREE

Form expert committee to identify water bodies: SC

The Supreme Court has asked the government to form an expert committee to identify the water bodies and water reservoirs within the project of Eastern Housing at Aftabnagar and Banasree in Dhaka and to measure their sizes.

The environment and forest secretary has been ordered to form a six-member committee led by a professor of the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (Buet) in 15 days from the receipt of the order.

The expert committee has been asked to

submit a report on the numbers and sizes of water bodies and water reservoirs within the project of Eastern Housing at Aftabnagar and Banasree to the apex court in 45 days after formation of the committee.

Terming Chittagong city's traffic management system terrible, Chittagong Deputy Commissioner (DC) Mesbah Uddin yesterday urged senior traffic officials to actively try to lessen sufferings during Ramadan.

Addressing a meeting of the District Law and Order Committee at his office, he accused traffic sergeants and constables of gossiping during work hours and said paying due attention to work would bring about a positive change.

Mesbah said chickpeas and sugar prices were at a "tolerable" level for regular drives by the administration's mobile court. He said the courts were also checking prices of clothes at

shopping malls. "Our mobile courts found a punjabi of Tk 1,000 being sold at Tk 3,000 in the shopping malls. They can profit Tk 500 per punjabi but how can they charge at such a high rate," he asked.

Zero tolerance for police extortion on highways

Ctg SP warns colleagues

Superintendent of Police of Chittagong AKM Hafiz Akter yesterday warned police personnel against extorting transport workers on Dhaka-Chittagong and Chittagong-Cox's Bazar highways.

He said he would show zero tolerance in this regard and urged transport owners and workers to report any case of extortion immediately to him. In the same breathe, the police official warned transport operators against overcharging passengers during Eid-ul-Fitr.

Hafiz Akter voiced the warnings while meeting with transport owners and workers at his office in the port city to discuss how to ease homebound people's journey on the occasion. It was decided that cargo vehicles will not operate on highways three days before and after the Eid day.

A police control room would be set up to receive complaints and address those immediately, he said.

MITU MURDER CASE

Court rejects revision petition of suspect

A Chittagong court yesterday afternoon rejected a revision petition moved by defence side challenging the remand granted against Abu Nasar Gunnu, who was arrested in connection with the murder of Superintendent of Police (SP) Babul Akter's wife Mahmuda Khanam Mitu.


Chittagong Metropolitan Sessions Judge Md Shahenur passed the order, said court sources.

Earlier, a Chittagong Metropolitan Magistrate court granted a seven-day remand for Gunnu and following the

order, defense lawyers lodged the petition, said Public Prosecutor Fakruddin Chowdhury. On June 8, detective branch of Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP) conducting a drive at a shrine named Darbare

Musabiya in Hathazari detained Gunnu. Following the arrest, mentioning him as an "ex-Islami Chhatra Shibir activist", police officials said they have informa-

tion that he was present at the place where Mitu was killed. Asked about progress of the investigation, CMP Commissioner Iqbal Bahar said they still have not found any visible progress. "We are trying so that no aspect remains untouched in our investigation," he said.
