50,000 Bangladeshis freed from foreign jails in 5yrs Foreign minister tells JS

Around 50,000 Bangladeshi nationals were freed from foreign jails over the last five years, Foreign Minister AH Mahmood Ali told the parliament yesterday. As per the statistics placed in parliament,

the minister said a total of 49,503 Bangladeshis were released in 20 countries between 2012 and May, 2016. The highest 18,721 Bangladeshis were

released from Malaysian jails during the period, while 17,335 prisoners in Saudi Arabia and 5,000 in the UAE, said Ali replying to lawmakers' queries. In the scripted answer, the FM said

2,025 were released from Singapore, 1,982 from Mexico, 875 from India, 728 from Turkey, 720 from Jordan, 650 from Lebanon, 440 from Iraq, 377 from Myanmar, 250 from Hong Kong and 241 from Pakistan.

Apart from this, 48 were released from Nepal, 45 from Brunei, 35 from Belgium, 17 from Iran, nine from Korea, three from Libya and two from Morocco.

Meanwhile, in reply to queries, Home Minister Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal told the House that Bangladesh had extradition treaties with India and the UAE.

Bangladesh signed "the agreement on the transfer of sentenced persons" with the UAE in October 2014, he said. In reply to another query, he said

Pakistan's reaction on the trial of war

criminals in Bangladesh was totally irreverent, biased, unacceptable and beyond etiquette. The minister said after the execution of war criminals Pakistan parliament brought condemn motions and its foreign minister

issued arrogant statements. "These are unblushing interference in an independent country," he said.

He mentioned that Pakistan govern ment's statements in favour of war criminals were tantamount to admitting its involvement in mass killing during 1971 and accepting the responsibility. About the tri-national treaty among

Bangladesh, India and Pakistan, the minister said there was nothing stated in that agreement that persons involved in crimes against humanity like mass killing, arson and rape could not be tried.

Rather Pakistan itself failed to follow the compulsion to bring its citizens involved in mass killing under trial, he added.

AL MP slams Rana Dasgupta over seeking Indian PM's help for minority people STAFF CORRESPONDENT

Ruling Awami League lawmaker Abdul Mazid yesterday in parliament slammed Bangladesh Hindu-Buddhist-Christian Oikya Parishad leader Rana Dasgupta for his alleged speech on seeking the Indian prime minister's intervention regarding security of minority people in Bangladesh.

The AL lawmaker from Habiganj-2 alleged that Rana Dasgupta's comment will hamper Bangladesh's communal harmony.

"Why he [Rana] is speaking the way Pakistan speaks about Bangladesh?" said Mazid mentioning that Bangladesh is a country of communal harmony which is internationally recognised. But Rana Dasgupta has spoken against this communal harmony.

He also said the government has given special allocation of Tk 200 crore in the budget for the welfare of Hindu community.

Physiotherapists seek dignity in profession

Leaders of Bangladesh Physiotherapy Association (BPA) yesterday said they would not accept the government's any "illogical recruitment proposal" which diminished their professional status.

Addressing a press conference at Dhaka Reporters Unity, they alleged that BPA had recently passed a "controversial" proposal for the recruitment of para-medic and technologists by downgrading the physiotherapists, said a press release by BPA press secretary Mohsin Kabir. Former secretary general

of Physical Medicine Association Prof Abdur Rashid, however, told The Daily Star that it was the government's duty to take any decision for the recruitment not by any person or organisation.

"They (BPA) can't raise an allegation against Physical Medicine Association because it is the government which takes all decisions," he added.
