



Language hero Shaikh Reaz passes away

Prof Shaikh Reaz Uddin Ahmed, a freedom fighter and a language movement veteran, died from old age complications at his Balashpur Palpara residence in Mymensingh town on Sunday, aged 80.

He left behind his wife, five sons, and a daughter to mourn his death.

He was buried at his village home in Chamurtha of Gafargaon upazila in Mymensingh at night on the day.

Reaz, also a writer, had been suffering from eye, kidney and heart related diseases for a long time.

Reaz joined the Language Movement under the leadership of his schoolteacher Subodh Chandra Bose and Awami League leader Ahmed Ali Mandol of Sreepur in Gazipur when he was a school student.

A former professor of Islamic history and culture of Alamgir Monsur Memorial College, Reaz was also an organiser of 1971 Liberation War.

31 Ctg drug stores fined for selling illegal drugs

Drug shop with 2 godowns sealed off, three including sugar trader jailed

Two mobile courts in Chittagong city fined 31 medicine shops and a business Tk 76.25 lakh and jailed three people on different charges yesterday.

In Khatunganj, a mobile court of the Chittagong District Administration jailed Mir Mohammad Hossain, owner of Ibnat Traders, a sister concern of Mir Group, for one month on charges of forcing the retailers to buy mustard oil along with sugar from them.

Executive Magistrate Tahmilur Rahman who led the drive also fined the owner Tk 1 lakh.

Jane Alam, manager of the business, was also fined Tk 20 lakh while two staff of the business were fined Tk 50,000 each on the

same charge.

The retailers have to buy 32 litres of mustard oil if they buy five sacks (each containing 50kg) of sugar from Ibnat Traders, said the magistrate.

However, the owner denied the allegation.

Another mobile court fined 31 medicine shops a total of Tk 54.25 lakh for selling unauthorised and adulterated medicines in Hazari Lane.

One of the medicine shops with its two godowns were sealed off while two staff of Sufa and Sons, another shop, were jailed for three months each.

Executive Magistrate of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) Sarwoer Alam led the court where representatives of the Drug Administration, Chittagong were present.

FROM PAGE 3 She said the gang used to publish ads in newspapers announcing employment opportunities and asking them to face interview.

Later, they took Tk 3,000 to 15,000 from the job seekers after giving them fake appointment letters. And by doing so, they have taken away about Tk 200 crore from more than 2 lakh people over the last three to four years, claimed Rab officials, based on information provided by the detainees and their own investigation.

Maj Abu Sayeed Khan, who led the drive, said they seized several documents from an office of the detainees.

Quoting some of the detainees, Mahfuza said the gang used to run offices on temporary basis in the city and frequently changed locations.

Legal process is underway against the detainees.

Rangpur city fixes Tk 801cr budget

The Rangpur City Corporation authority yesterday declared a surplus budget of over Tk 801 crore for the FY 2016-17.

Flanked by other officials and councillors of the city corporation, RCC Mayor Sorfuddin Ahmed Jhantu announced the budget at a hall room of Nagar Bhaban in the district.

RCC declared the budget with Tk 801.25 crore earning target from different sources including revenue and Tk 798.77 crore as expenditure, while the last year's budget was Tk.645.05 crore.

The mayor said this year they were not levying any additional tax on the city dwellers as the earning target exceeded the expenditure by around Tk 2 crore.

Replying to the queries of journalists, Sorfuddin said they were giving equal priority to development of all 18 wards under RCC.

He added that they would also focus on mitigating traffic congestion, building recreation centre for both children and grown-ups, and develop road communication.

RCC Executive Officer Ruhul Amin and Accountant Abdul Hakim also spoke.

TRIPURA-BANGLADESH India wants to finish border fencing by next March

The federal government of India has directed completion of fencing along north-eastern state of Tripura's border with Bangladesh by March of the next year.

The directive was issued by Secretary Border Management in the federal Home Ministry Susheel Kumar to agencies involved in the border fencing in Tripura sector.

This came weeks after Indian Home Minister Rajnath Singh ordered that another north-eastern Indian state of Assam's border with

The deceased were Laltu Hossain, 40, Ishak Hossain, 58, and Jahangir Patwari, 43. They all hailed from Magura. Illias Ali, officer-in-charge of Jessore Kotwali Police Station, said the accident initially left two cattle traders dead and another injured on the spot.

The injured was admitted at Jessore Medical College Hospital where he succumbed to his injury. A case was filed.

In Barisal Sadar, a motorcyclist was killed and two of his co-riders were injured when his vehicle collided head-on with a pickup-van on the Barisal-Bhola highway in Engineering College area yesterday.

The deceased was Riaz Hossain Khan, 25, of the upazila.

The injured Abul Hossain, 55, and Abul Hossain, 50, were sent to Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital, said Mahabubul Alam, officer-in-charge of Banar Police Station.

In Dinajpur Sadar, Md Zaman, 38, of Mohabbatpur village was killed as a truck hit his motorcycle in front of Dinajpur Children Park in Eidgah Basti area on Sunday evening.

No surprise in budget

Opposition Chief Whip Tajul tells parliament STAFF CORRESPONDENT

Opposition Chief Whip Tajul Islam Choudhury yesterday told parliament that in overall consideration, there was no surprise in the proposed budget for the 2016-17 fiscal year.

"The finance minister placed a big budget, but we see no way (guideline) to implement it," Tajul said while participating in a general discussion on the proposed budget.

The opposition Jatiya Party MP also criticised Muhith, saying that there was no good news in the proposed budget about investment and no guideline for stopping anomalies and corruption in the banking sector and revamping the share market.

He raised questions regarding the budget financing. "The government will have to face many challenges to meet the deficit
