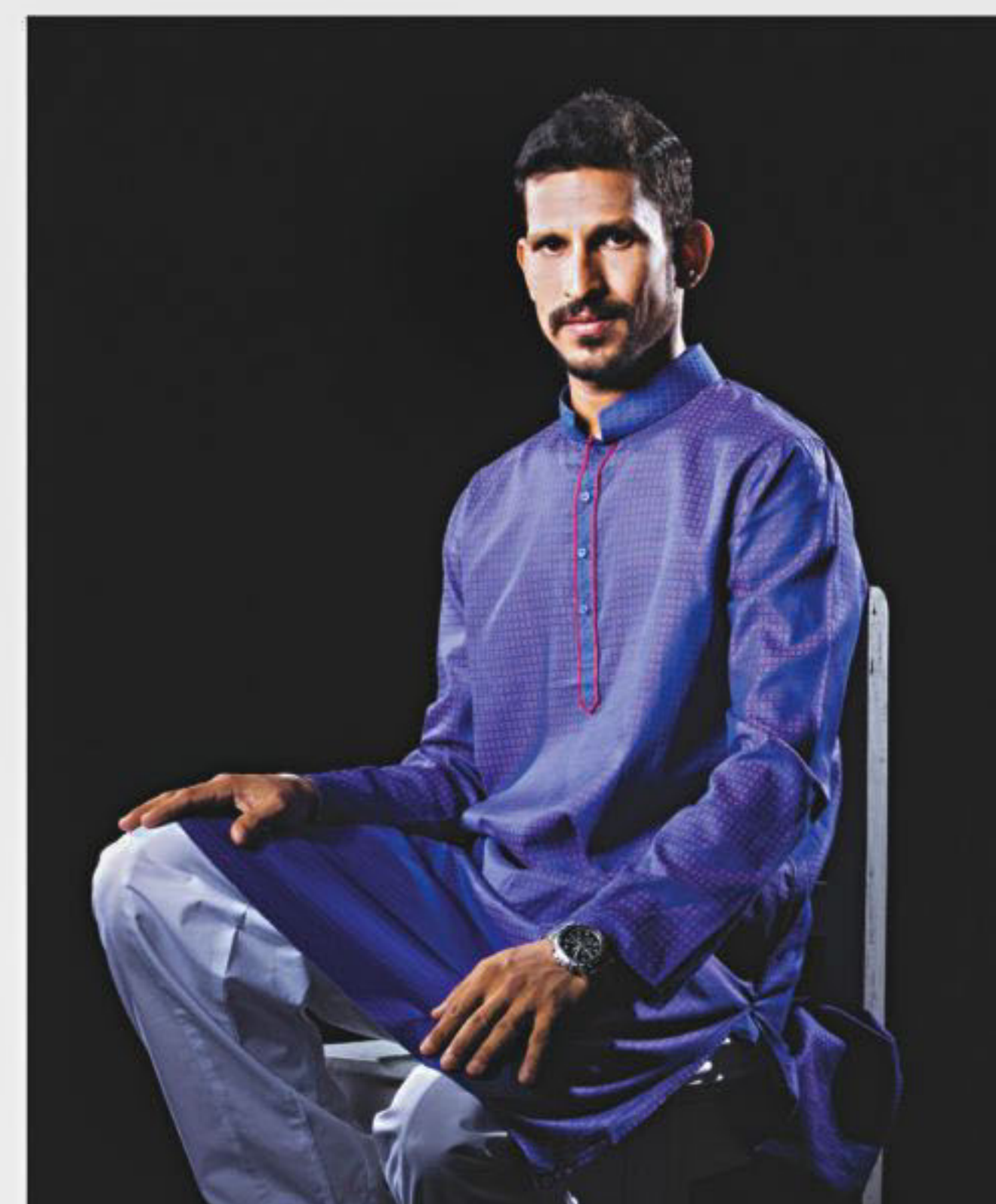


Menswear This Eid
