

SC fixes July 14 for hearing bail plea of Shafik Rehman

The Supreme Court yesterday fixed July 14 for hearing an appeal filed by veteran journalist Shafik Rehman seeking bail in a sedition case.

Chamber judge of the Appellate Division of the SC Justice Hasan Foez Siddique fixed the date after hearing the leave to appeal petition filed against a High Court order that rejected a bail petition of Shafik Rehman.

The case was filed against Shafik Rehman for his alleged attempts to abduct and murder Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's son Sajeeb Wazed Joy.

The former editor of the daily Jaijaidin was arrested on April 16 in the case at his residence by detectives.

The HC on June 7 rejected his bail petition on the ground that the investigation into the case against him was going on.

Rickshaw puller shot in capital

A rickshaw puller was shot during a factional clash between two rival groups over establishing supremacy in Chawkbazar area of the capital yesterday afternoon.

Victim Abdur Rahman, 20, was admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital with a bullet injury on his left leg, said the hospital sources. Talking to journalists, Rahman said he was standing by his rickshaw at Chawkbazar around 3:00pm when the clash was going on. Maruf Hossain Sarder, deputy commissioner (DC) of Lalbagh division of Dhaka Metropolitan Police, said 10 persons were detained in this connection.

Youth hacked to death in capital

Misceants hacked a workshop employee to death in the capital yesterday.

Jahangir Hossain, 20, son of Panchu Miah of Kishoreganj, was attacked in Bhatara Balur Math and died hours after at a local hospital.

Nurul Muttakin, officer-in-charge of Bhatara Police Station, told The Daily Star that following the incident they picked up from the spot three people who were playing card games. They are being interrogated, he said, adding no case was filed immediately. The body was sent to Dhaka Medical College morgue for an autopsy.

additional secretary to the ministry; Md Sirajul Islam, director (planning), Rajdhani Unnayan Kartipakkha; Prof Sarwar Jahan, urban and regional planning department, Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology; Syeda Rizwana Hasan, chief executive, Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers Association; Md Abul Hossain, surveyor, Dhaka settlement office; and Atique Morshed, coordinator, Poribesh Bachao Andolon, according to a ministry circular.

In the circular, the ministry asked the committee to submit a report to it in 30 days after conducting an inquiry on the spot.

SAGAR-RUNI MURDER PROBE Rab asked again to report by Aug 18

A Dhaka court yesterday for the 37th time asked Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) to submit by August 18 the probe report of the journalist Sagar-Runi murder case.

The court passed the order after Assistant Superintendent of Police Wares Ali Miah of Rab, also the investigation officer of the case, failed to submit the report to it yesterday as per the court's earlier order. Earlier, different courts expressed their dissatisfaction over failure to unearth the clue.

Sagar Sarowar, news editor of private TV station Maasranga, and his wife Meherun Runi, senior reporter of ATN Bangla, were killed at their rented flat in the capital on February 11, 2012.

Five youths awarded for winning story writing contest

Five young story writers were awarded yesterday in a Bangla story writing competition titled "Tomar Golpe Sobar Eid."

They are Asif Imtiaz, Sakib Chowdhury, Eleash Nahid, Humayun Rashid and Tamim Rahman.

Drinkit, a water purifier of RFL, and television channel Boishakhi arranged the contest.

Cultural Affairs Minister Asaduzzaman Nur handed over the crests and Tk 50,000 to each of them at a ceremony in the capital's The Daily Star Centre. Around 11,450 young playwrights took part in the contest.

Talking about quality of today's dramas, Asaduzzaman said, "Story, dialogues and plots of the current dramas are very poor. Consequently, the quality has deteriorated..."

Noted litterateurs Selina Hossain, Emdadul Haque Milon and Anisul Haque judged the participants' writings. Anisul urged the young story writers to read more literary works and watch quality movies to write good plays.

Their stories were adopted for producing plays, which will be aired on Boishakhi TV during its Eid programmes.

"It is nothing less than hypocritical and outrageous...to finance two horrible coal-burning power plants in a developing country that needs clean energy not premature disease," said Bill Snape, senior counsel with the Center for Biological Diversity.

"We call...to immediately reject financing all fossil fuel projects in Bangladesh, including the Orion coal projects, and to instead finance renewable energy," said Barnali Ghosh of Brown and Green: South Asian Americans for Climate Justice.

She noted the negative impacts of the projects on livelihoods of the millions of people in Bangladesh and India that live

near the proposed power plant sites.

Advocate Sultana Kamal, convener of the National Committee for Saving the Sundarbans, also urged investors to refrain from supporting the coal-based power plants in the country till a fully independent and internationally acceptable Environmental Impact Assessment was conducted by credible institutions having no conflict of interest.

The proposed 1,320 MW government-run Rampal coal plant and the 565 MW Orion coal plant are located within 14 kilometres of the Sundarbans, a 10,000 sq km (3,860 sq miles) continuous mangrove forest covering Bangladesh and India and listed as a Unesco World Heritage site.

will have to sit together to find out a solution," she said.

Pointing to February's cyber heist looting \$101 million of Bangladesh Bank, she said it was a rare incident. "We are yet to know how the reserve was stolen even after the investigation body placed its report," she said.

Turning to Finance Minister AMA Muhiht's recent admission that there have been massive thefts in the banking sector, Raushan asked him to name the perpetrators.

She also demanded that Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina set up a separate bank for women which would be run by female staff

so that women would feel comfort and be self-dependent by taking small loans.

Turning to the proposed budget, she demanded increasing allocation for education and health sectors.

Terming unemployed educated people "time-bombs", Raushan said now tens of thousands of educated people who were coming out from the 135 public and private universities were remaining unemployed.

"(They) can go off anytime. So, investment will have to be increased to create jobs," she said. She also criticised the government for its failure to revamp the share market.
