DEEPLY MOURNED

A congregation of mourners at Army Stadium in Dhaka yesterday, with victim families receiving bodies, foreign diplomats paying tributes to their citizens, and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina meeting and offering her deep condolences and sincere apology to the bereaved people, including from families of the two police officers killed by the terrorists. Nine of the 20 slain hostages were Italian, seven Japanese, one Indian, one Bangladeshi-origin American, and two Bangladeshis. On behalf of their nations, the foreign envoys pay homage: *from left in the top row*, Italian Ambassador Mario Palma, Japanese Ambassador Masato Watanabe, Indian High Commissioner Harsh Vardhan Shringla, and US Ambassador Marcia Bernicat. *On Road 79 of Gulshan-2, bottom left*, where the Holey Artisan Bakery is situated, the general people place flowers in memories of the deceased.
