Govt to sign \$275m ADB funding deal tomorrow BSS, Dhaka

The government will sign a \$275 million agreement with Asian Development Bank (ADB) next week to fund a project for ensuring supply of safe drinking water in Dhaka city.

Economic Relations Division Senior Secretary Mohammad Mejbahuddin and ADB Country Director Kazuhiko Higuchi will sign the loan agreement on behalf of their respective sides at the National Economic Council confer-

remittance of \$2.212 billion from the USA until May in the FY 2015-16 while Malaysia, with \$1.204 billion, has been in the forth position during the period. In the same period, Bangladesh received remittances of

\$758.62 million from the UK, \$348.90 million from Singapore, \$304.94 million from Italy, \$61.46 million from Australia, \$57million from South Korea, \$23.16 million from Hong Kong, \$19.79 million from Japan and \$22.96 million from Germany. The total remittance from other countries stood at \$721.05 million during the same period. It is believed that about 10 million non-resident Bangladeshis are now living in over 150 countries.
