

# 9 die in road crashes

STAR REPORT

Nine persons, including a schoolgirl, were killed and 29 others injured in road accidents in five districts yesterday and on Friday.

A schoolgirl was killed as a rashly-driven truck ran over her at Sukhia on the Dhaka-Kishoreganj highway in Pakundia upazila on Friday when she was crossing the road, reports UNB.

Setu, 11, was a fifth-grader of Porabaria Government Primary School and daughter of Selim Miah of the upazila.

Police recovered the body and sent it to Kishoreganj Sadar Hospital morgue for an autopsy.

Our Manikganj correspondent reports, two motorbike riders were killed as a Dhaka-bound bus rammed into their bike at Tepa of the district's Shivalaya upazila.

The dead were Alamgir Hossain, 28, of Utholy village and his brother-in-law Razibul Hasan, 25, of Mohadevpur village in the upazila.

Meanwhile, a Dhaka-bound bus of NNB

Paribahan felt into a roadside ditch at Muljan in Sadar upazila of the same district after its driver lost control over the steering, leaving one of its passengers dead on the spot and 15 others injured.

The deceased was Akash Hossain, 17, of Utholy village in Shivalaya upazila.

The injured were taken to different hospitals.

Police seized the vehicle, but its driver and his assistants managed to flee.

Our Dinajpur correspondent adds, a bus collided head-on with a truck on Rangpur-Kurigram road at Laldighi village in Pirganj upazila of Rangpur, leaving the former's two passengers dead and 10 others injured.

The deceased were Afaz Uddin, 43, and Morzina Begum, 33, of Bhurungamari upazila in Kurigram.

Locals took them to Rangpur Medical College Hospital (RMCH).

Meanwhile in the same upazila, truck driver Manik Mia, 40, who was injured on

Indian contractor BHEL to install the plant.

Mentioning that India wants to implement the Rampal project as part of their strategic interest, National Committee Member Secretary Prof Anu Mohammad said, "Circumstantial evidence suggests India is very much aggressive to implement the project to ensure their presence in the Bay of Bengal."

Bangladesh's strategy should be getting out of the Rampal project as soon as possible as this project will be harmful for bilateral relations between India and Bangladesh, he stressed.

Himadri Majumder Himu who was also a member of anti-drug organisation Shikor, was brutally beaten, dogs were unleashed upon him and then he was pushed off a four-storey building in Panchlaish Residential Area in Chittagong city on April 27, 2012. Tipu owns the building.

Himu succumbed to his injuries at a Dhaka hospital on May 23, 2012.

On May 24, 2012, the murder case was filed with Panchlaish Police Station, accusing five persons -- Tipu, Shahadat, Jahedul Islam Shawon, Mahboob Ali Khan Danny and Tipu's son Junaid Ahmed Riad.

Of them, Danny was arrested on February 15 this year and Shawon and Riad are now on the run.
