

Tackle terrorism with iron fist

JSC meeting urges govt

Speakers at a memorial programme yesterday for the seven Japanese victims of the July 1 Gulshan café attack urged the government to deal with the issue with an iron fist.

Japan Study Centre of Dhaka University organised the mourning rally at the base of Aparajeya Bangla and brought out a silent procession on the campus as part of their weeklong programme.

"Militancy is a major problem and it has turned into a disease for our society," said Pro-Vice Chancellor Md Akhteruzzaman.

The centre's Director Prof Abul Barakat said, "Earlier militancy was linked to madrasas but now it is prevailing in various renowned private universities. Disciplines of arts like philosophy and history are not taught in those universities; it is one of the reasons behind this," he said. "Militancy can be started based on other religions besides

Robbers loot valuables from flat

Armed robbers looted valuables from a flat of a five-storey building in Tejgaon area of the capital yesterday.

Officer-in-Charge of Tejgaon Police Station Mazharul Islam said seven to eight robbers stormed into the house at Shahinbagh and took the house members, a woman and her daughter, hostage at gunpoint.

The criminals locked the two into a room and fled after looting the valuables, said the OC.

On information, police rushed to the spot and rescued them from the room.

2 Ctg teachers held over question paper

Two schoolteachers were detained yesterday for allegedly comparing the deeds of anti-coal-fired power plant movement leader Liakat Ali to that of the Father of the Nation in a question paper of class IX in Banshkhali upazila of Chittagong.

They are Dukul Barua of Bangabandhu High School; and Taherul Islam, head teacher of Naseria Khatun RK Girls High School.

Earlier, Chittagong Deputy Commissioner Mesbah Uddin formed a probe committee comprising additional deputy commissioner (education) and Chittagong district education officer.

As per the committee's direction, the two teachers were held for interrogation, said Officer-in-Charge Md Alamgir Hossain of Banshkhali Police Station.

The students from 97 schools participated in the examination of the subject "Bangladesh o Bishwa Parichoy" under the question on July 17, an official said.

Liakat is leading the anti-coal fired power plant movement in the upazila's Gondamara union, said the official.

Huge Yaba haul in Ctg

10 lakh pills seized in Coast Guard drives

Members of Bangladesh Coast Guard (east zone) in two drives seized a total of 10 lakh Yaba tablets, worth over Tk 50 crore, in Anwara upazila of Chittagong on Monday.

Lieutenant Commander Zulhas Faisal at a press briefing yesterday said Coast Guard members on Monday afternoon were following a boat which was going to Shah Pari Island in Cox's Bazar from Myanmar coast.

When the law enforcers chased the wooden boat, it speeded away in the deep sea.

Later, all the Coast Guard outposts -- in Bahar Chara, Inani, Himchari and Cox's Bazar -- were informed and around 11:30pm a coast guard special team conducted a drive in Sangu Gas Field area near Chittagong coast.

Sensing the presence of the law enforcers at Gohira coast, the boat crews swam away after creating a hole in the boat to let it sink in the water, said the Coast Guard official.

Later, Coast Guard members recovered 9.5 lakh Yaba tablets kept in five sacks on the boat.

In another drive in Dobashi Bazar area of the upazila on Monday, Coast Guard members arrested two people -- Doyal Krishna, 40, of Sitakunda and Mohammed Hossain, 55, of Teknaf -- with 50,000 Yaba tablets kept in a bag which they were carrying.

The arrestees were handed over to Anwara Police with the Yaba tablets.

Meanwhile, police arrested Fajal Kabir, 32, of Teknaf with 5,000 pieces of Yaba tablets during a drive in Chittagong city's Raufabad area yesterday, said Mohammad Mohsin, officer-in-charge of Bayezid Bostami Police Station.

In another drive in the city's Majjar Tek area, police arrested Abdul Karim, 35, of Teknaf with 1,000 pieces of Yaba tablets, said Sub-inspector of Karnaphuli Police Station Mohammad Hossain.
