SHAMSUDDIN MILON MURDER Family yet to get justice in five years

Family of Shamsuddin Milon, who was killed in a mob beating in Companyganj upazila on July 27 in 2011, is yet to get justice after five years into the killing of the 17-year-old boy.
On July last year, Officer-in-Charge Aatur Rahman Bhuiyan of Noakhali Detective Branch (DB) of Police, also the investigation officer (IO) of the case, submitted a charge-sheet before a cognisance court against 31 people, including four policemen.
After the hearing on November 5 the same year, Senior Judicial Magistrate Farhana Bhuiyan ordered the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) for fur-

ther investigation.
But nearly nine months after the court order CID is yet to submit the probe report.
Milon's father Gias Uddin said last year he agreed to withdraw the case after police assured him of giving Tk 10 lakh as compensation and a job for his young son.
But they did not keep their commitment, he added.
Contacted, ASP Jalal Uddin Ahmed Noakhali CID said they will submit the investigation report in a short time as soon as the investigation is complete.
After receiving Tk 14,000x his father sent from abroad on July 27 in 2011, Milon went to Charkakra High School to meet his cousin Chumki, a Class VI student of the school.
When Milon was waiting in front of the school, UP member Jamal Uddin along with some villagers caught Milon, suspecting him as a robber and beat him mercilessly, leaving him dead on the spot.
Later, they handed the body to police who kept it with bodies of five robbers in front of the Companiganj police station.
After the news was published in several newspapers, the authorities suspended OC Rafique Ullah, SI Akram Uddin Sheikh, constables Abdur Rahim and Hema Ranjan Chakma of the police station and formed a body to investigate the incident.

Teenage girl violated, one held

A 17-year-old girl was raped allegedly by a youth in Kamalganj upazila of the district on Monday.
The victim is now undergoing treatment at Moulvibazar Sadar Hospital.
Following a case filed by the victim's father, police arrested Jasim Mia, 35, son of late Nazim Mia of Boiddyanathpur village in the upazila, the same night for his alleged involvement in the incident.
Quoting Jamshed Mia, local UP member, police said Jasim forcibly picked up the girl while she was returning from a neighbour's house around 3:00pm.
He later took the girl to his residence at the village and violated her there. As the girl's condition deteriorated he left her at a village field in an unconscious state, police said.
Being informed, police went to the spot, rescued the girl around 9:00pm and admitted her to Sadar Hospital.

People suffer as Patuakhali bus terminal in awful state

Passengers using the Patuakhali central bus terminal are suffering a lot due to water-logging in the terminal, which hampers their movement.
The Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) built the terminal at Kalikapur area on Patuakhali-Kuakata road with the World Bank's assistance at a cost of Tk 1.65 crore in 2003. Since then, Patuakhali municipality has been earning revenue from the bus terminal every year through leasing it.
Most areas of the terminal go under water when it rains as there is no drainage system and rainwater can't flow out, causing immense suffering to the passengers. The sanitation system also collapsed long ago. The toilets have become unfit for use, especially for women passengers.
"There are many potholes filled up with stagnant water at the gate. As a result, passenger can't go to the ticket counters easily," said Abu Zafor Khan, counter-in-charge of Sakura Paribahan. The terminal remains dark at night as there is no electricity connection, which makes the passengers feel insecure, he added.
Md Ujjal Mridha, a local, said the boundary wall of the terminal is broken at many points. Passengers feel insecure as anyone can easily enter the terminal through the broken sections.
Dr Shafiqul Islam, mayor of Patuakhali municipality, said the problems of the bus terminal will be solved soon, and necessary facilities will be ensured considering the interest of the passengers. "We have built a mosque for the passengers," he added.

5 jailed in murder case

A court here on Monday sentenced two men to life term imprisonment and three others to seven and five years in jail for killing a madrasa teacher over a decade ago.
The convicts are Wazed Mollah, 45, his wife Joinab Begum, 40, and their sons -- Ershadullah Mollah, 32, Obaidullah Mollah, 28, and Habibullah Mollah, 25.
Lifers Wazed Mollah and Ershadullah Mollah were also fined Tk one lakh each.
Obaidullah Mollah and Habibullah Mollah were jailed for seven years while Joinab Begum was awarded five years' imprisonment. Joinab was also fined Tk 5,000.
After examining evidence and witnesses, District and Sessions Judge Abdul Kashem Mostafa found the five guilty and delivered the verdict.
According to the prosecution, Maulana Abdul Mannan, teacher of Khepupara Nesaruddin Fazil Madrasa, was beaten to death over a disputed land on February 28 in 2005.
