

Killed JMB man Abdullah's aide arrested

A team of Dinajpur Detective Branch (DB) arrested an operative of outlawed militant outfit Jama'at ul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) with bombs and sharp weapons from Nawabganj upazila of the district yesterday.

The arrestee is Alamgir Kabir, 24, son of Nurul Huda of village Bollavpur village under the upazila. He was a close friend and aide of Abdullah, who was killed in the Kalyanpur raid in the capital on July 26.

A DB team raided Alamgir's house and arrested him with six crude bombs and two sharp weapons.

He was produced before the Judicial Magistrate's Court with a prayer for a seven-day remand. Senior Judicial Magistrate Gopal Chandra granted a three-day remand.

Shortage of docs, nurses in Rangamati hospital

Twelve-year-old Sonalika Chakma from Midingya chari village in Suvolong union under Barkal upazila, sleeps on the balcony due to lack of beds at Rangamati General Hospital. Like Sonalika, many patients sleep on floors as they have not got cabins or beds due to shortage of space.

The hospital started its journey with 50 beds in 1985 which was later increased to 100-bed, but there was no increase in human resources and infrastructure development.

When the hospital was established, the district's population was three lakh, but it is now 6.5 lakh. When the number of patients increases, they face problems such as lack of beds, shortage of doctors and nurses, and out-of-order diagnostic equipment. Most of the toilets are not suitable for use.

A hospital source said there are only 21 doctors against 31 posts and 60 senior and junior nurses against 83 posts. There are many posts vacant, such as, anesthesiologist, dental surgeon, eye consultant, medicine consultant, lady consultant, surgery consultant and emergency medical officer. There is no radiologist or pathologist to conduct diagnostic tests.

Md Jakir Hossain, 32, a patient, said sometimes the hospital X-ray machine and other diagnostic machines remain out of order, so the patients have to go to nearby diagnostic centres and private clinics to get the tests done.

Sishir Chakma said they are to go to a pharmacy in the town to buy any medicine.

Advocate Mihir Baran Chakma, convener of health sub-committee, Socheton Nagorik Committee (Sonak) Rangamati, said they have requested the authorities to set up a public toilet as there is no public toilet in the hospital.

Dr Sneha Kanti Chakma, district civil surgeon, said the district has posts for 176 medical officers at present, but there are only 87 people employed.

The doctors are working relentlessly, he said, adding that if all the posts are filled up hospitals will be able to run actively.

Mongkheu Ching Marma, resident medical officer (in-charge), said food and medicine are allocated for only 100 patients in the general hospital. Increasing hospital infrastructure, human resources and emergency doctors should be done as soon as possible, he added.

ATTACK ON BAULS

Two sent to jail

A Chuadanga court on Monday sent two people to jail on charge of assaulting two bauls and burning down a baul akhra in Chuadanga on Saturday.

The arrestees are Nasir Uddin alias Kalu, 28, son of Abdul Jalil, and Alauddin alias Ala, 25, son of Molam Hossain of Madna village under Damurhuda upazila of Chuadanga.

Abu Jihad Md Fakhru Alam, officer-in-charge of Damurhuda Model Police Station, said police arrested them on Monday for their alleged involvement in the incident. Police teams raided their homes separately and arrested them, he added.

The arrestees were produced before the court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate of Chuadanga. Senior Judicial Magistrate Abdul Halim sent them to jail.

Unidentified criminals assaulted two bauls and set fire to their akhra at Gobindpur village in Damurhuda upazila of Chuadanga. The criminals also cut off their hair.

The bauls are Julmat Ali, 58 and his gurubhai (senior baul) Rinupada Halder, 66.

Julmat Ali, also mentor of the akhra, filed a case with Damurhuda Model Police Station on Saturday, accusing nine unnamed people.

Accused flees from police custody

A handcuffed suspect in the imam and marriage registrar killing case escaped from police custody in Lichutola (Banani) area under Shahajampur upazila of Bogra yesterday.

He is Anisur Rahman, 42, son of late Mohosin Ali of Baniagati village under Dhunat upazila, and an office assistant at Mohishur Dakhil Madrasa in the village.

Police said Rafiqul Islam, sub-inspector (SI) of Dhunat Police Station, and two constables were escorting Anisur to a Bogra court when he fled the scene on the excuse of answering the call of nature.

Gaziur Rahman, senior assistant superintendent of police, said action will be taken against the policemen if any negligence is found.

Man gets life for murder in Joypurhat

A Joypurhat court yesterday sentenced a mason to life imprisonment for killing a young man in 2010.

The lifer is Anwarul Islam, 35, son of Abu Bakkar of Elta village in Kalai upazila. He was tried in absentia.

According to the prosecution, Anwarul beat up Abdul Wahed, 30, son of Afzal Hossain of the village, mercilessly, leaving him dead on the spot following an altercation over a trivial matter on July 30 in 2010.

A murder case was filed with Kalai Police Station the same day.

After examining witnesses and evidence, Additional District and Sessions Judge Md A Moziul found Anwarul guilty and pronounced the verdict.

3 missing women found dead

Police recovered bodies of three women of a family, who had earlier gone missing from Gazipur, from the Jamuna River at Enayetpur of Sirajganj district on Monday morning.

The victims -- Meherun Akter, 45, wife of Hadikul Mondol, Nasrin Mondol, 30, wife of Badal Mondol, and Nasrin's adopted daughter Jaimati, 5, went out from their Tengra village home in Sreepur upazila of Gazipur district to see a doctor on Sunday, police quoted the family members as saying.

"They went out from the house at about 11:00am on Sunday to consult a doctor for Jaimati. After going to Gazipur Chowrasta at noon they called the family members. Then they had no contact with us," Md Shafikul Islam, uncle of Nasrin, said.

"After hearing about recovery of three women's bodies here, family members came here and identified the bodies today [Tuesday]," said Md Rashidul Hasan Bishwas, officer in charge (OC) of Enayetpur Police Station.

"Earlier informed by locals, police recovered the bodies from the southern part of the Jamuna River near Khawaza Eunus Ali Medical College and Hospital at about 11:00am.

"There were injury marks in the necks of the victims. It seems they were strangled dead and thrown into the river."

"A case was filed with Enayetpur Police Station and the police started investigating the incident," the OC said.

Cop beaten up for collecting illegal toll

A policeman was beaten up on allegation of collecting illegal toll at Golora bus stand in Sauria upazila yesterday.

The accused is Al-Mamun, constable of Manikganj police outpost.

Divisional action will be taken against Mamun if he is found guilty in primary investigation, said Superintendent of Police Mahfuzur Rahman.

Locals said Mamun in plainclothes went to the bus stand in the morning and started demanding money from vehicles.

Seeing this, local people gave him a good beating and handed over him to police, said Monirul Islam, district intelligence officer.

Tk 1 crore Indian drugs seized

Locals said Labu went to take a bath in the pond on Monday and went missing. On information, firefighters recovered the body the following day. He drowned in the pond, family members suspected.

Girl drowns in pond

A minor girl drowned in a pond at Biswanathpur village in Shibganj upazila yesterday. The deceased was Sanjida Khatun, 6, daughter of Abdus Samad of the village. Police and family sources said Sanjida fell into the pond near their home while playing on its bank around 7:30am and drowned.

Four cows burnt alive

Four cows and a goat were burnt alive in a fire at Ghoshpara village in Chirirbandar upazila early yesterday. Locals said a fire broke out at a cattle farm around 2:00am. On information, firefighters rushed to the spot and doused the flame, which originated from a mosquito coil.
