## 2 'passport brokers' held in N'ganj

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested an alleged passport broker, who is also accused in a murder case, with his accomplice at Jalkuri Passport office in Narayanganj on Monday night.

The arrestees are Khandker Ajmal Babu, 25, of Nabiganj area and Azim Ahmed of Bandar area. Babu is an accused in the case filed over the killing of Bandar Dockyard worker Md Faisal on July 29, said a press release of Rab-11 yesterday.

Members of Rab-11, who conducted the drive, recovered 31 forged passports, seven fake seals of medical officers, 293 birth registration certificates, Tk 55,101, and 21 passport application forms.

The press release said Babu formed the syndicate and had been harassing people at the passport office for a long time.

## Road crashes kill 3

Three people were killed and another was injured in road accidents in three districts yesterday and on Monday.

In the capital, a transport worker was killed as a lorry ran him over from behind while he was unloading goods in Anandabazar area near Dhaka University yesterday.

The deceased Suman Haoladar, 22, of Barisal, was a resident of Sutrapur in the capital.

In Rajshahi, a schoolboy was killed and his friend injured as a Rajshahi University

bus ran them over after an auto-rickshaw hit their motorcycle while they were overtaking the RU bus in Talaimari area on Monday night.

The deceased was Shimul, 15, of Mirzapur, and a student of Masjid Mission School.

In Chittagong, Lal Mia, 43, of Kurigram was killed as a covered-van hit him while he was crossing the Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Madambibirhat area in Sitakunda upazila yesterday. Lal Mia used to work as a security guard in Confidence Cement factory in the upazila.

Police seized the van and detained its driver.

house and noticed that she stayed alone when her aunt went to work at a garments factory.

According to the case statement, Mannan raped her on four different days in July, last year.

"He threatened to set our village house on fire if I told anyone what he was doing to me," she said.

Her aunt found out that she was pregnant about six months after she was raped.

The family then filed a case in March 23, this year, a little over a month before she gave birth to a child. The court issued a warrant against the accused last week.

Her elder brother, a college student in

Dhaka, said his family was very poor and landless while the alleged rapist held much influence.

Bijoy Bosak, police superintendent of Barguna, said the warrant had not reached the district yet and added that prompt action will be taken once the court order reached there.

Contacted, Mohammad Younus, a relative of Mannan who lives near his residence, told The Daily Star that Mannan is on the run. He also said there have been quite a few meetings in the village regarding the issue in the last couple of months, where the girl and his family complained to the village elders, which did not bring any results.

It has been four days since the four-year-old has been admitted to DMCH. Bayezid is diagnosed with premature ageing condition progeria.

He was initially diagnosed by a medical team of Magura Sadar Hospital (MSH), who later suggested sending him to DMCH.

"We just want our son to get better soon," said his father Lablu Shikder.

Dr Samanta Lal Sen, the institute's chief coordinator, said, "Medical tests will be conducted before his treatment begins. We might give some medicines to slow his hormonal growth."

He said they are not sure if it is progeria so they have to wait for the test results.

### Aslam gets bail in two arson cases

The High Court yesterday granted bail to BNP Joint Secretary General Aslam Chowdhury in two arson cases for the next six months.

Aslam, however, cannot get released from jail following the bail orders, as he is arrested in a sedition case filed for hatching a conspiracy to overthrow the government with the connivance of The Likud Party of Israel and Mossad -- its secret intelligence service, Deputy Attorney General Md Bashirullah told The Daily Star.

Novoair, a private-owned local airline, will operate seven flights everyday on Dhaka-Chittagong route instead of six from August 16, said a press release yesterday.

The seventh flight will leave Dhaka airport for Chittagong at 7:15am, and from Chittagong it will leave for Dhaka at 8:30am.

The airline is now operating six flights on the route with the ticket price starting at Tk 3,200.

Novoair is also flying on six domestic routes and an international route. It will soon launch service for India and Nepal.
