**PVT MEDICAL COLLEGES**  
SC wants to know about admission of 153 failed aspirants

The Supreme Court yesterday issued a show-cause notice to the authorities of 10 private medical colleges each for admitting 153 candidates who failed to fulfill the relevant requirements in admission tests.

The SC asked the chairmen and principals of the colleges to explain by August 21 why they should not be prosecuted and imposed penalty for admitting the candidates.

The apex court also stayed a High Court order asking the Dhaka University authorities to give registration and admit cards to the medical students for appearing in their first professional examinations which DU refused earlier.

Following a writ petition filed by the students, the HC on June 13 this year asked the DU authorities to allow them to sit for the examination.

The SC passed the order after hearing a leave to appeal petition recently filed by DU challenging the HC order.

Attorney General Mahbubey Alam said the 153 aspirants were admitted violating rules. The 10 colleges are MH Samorita Medical College, City Medical College, Nightingale Medical College, ZH Sikder Medical College, AR Medical College, East West Medical College, Tairunnassa Memorial Medical College, Aichi Medical College, Care Medical College, and Ashyan Medical College.

## ACC arrests Moon Group boss among 4

Anti-Corruption Commission yesterday arrested four persons, including the chairman and managing director of Moon Group of Industries, accused in its cases.

Moon's Mizanur Rahman was arrested in the capital's Dhannoddi.

He allegedly was able to withdraw around Tk 94.8 crore of a Tk 108 crore Agrani Bank loan mortgaging a plot centering which a trial was pending, using invalid documents.

Shahjahan Ali of Rupsha Surveyors was arrested in Motihel. He and eight others allegedly took a Tk 40 crore loan from BASIC Bank Limited's Shantinagar branch mortgaging a plot forging documents showing its price double the market value.

Chittagong Residential School and College founder Md Golam Faruque was arrested in Agrabad, reports our Chittagong correspondent.

He allegedly sold a land which he also later mortgaged to Social Islami Bank Limited's Khatunganj Branch with assistance of its officials for a Tk 50 lakh loan.

Former Iban Bima Corporation, Khishoreganj development manager-2 Nurul Islam Bhuiyan was arrested in Mymensingh over a case filed with Kishoreganj Police Station on July 9, 2009.

He allegedly forged cheques to misappropriate Tk 5.9 lakh.

## Engage youths in fight against poverty

Says TIB while placing 9-point charter of demands

Transparency International Bangladesh (TIB) yesterday placed a nine-point charter of demands including youth engagement in the government's poverty eradication plan.

Participation of the youth in economic activities and leadership will facilitate sustainable development and help build a corruption-free country, the anti-corruption watchdog said, marking International Youth Day tomorrow.

Speaking on the occasion, TIB Executive Director Dr Ittehaduzzaman said the youth were taking the wrong path because the right environment was not there.

"Pro-liberation people have to take the responsibility to stop them from going to the wrong direction. The youth should be inspired towards... shunning the wrong paths like militancy and extremism," he told a TIB human chain at TSC of Dhaka University.

Addressing the programme, DU's English literature professor Syed Monjurul Islam urged the youth to read the biographies of great people to find their role models.

Later, a two-day national debate contest for students of class VIII to X was also inaugurated. TIB and Dhaka University Debating Society hosted the competition. Anti-corruption cartoons were also exhibited at TSC. At the programme, the youth took an oath to fight corruption.

### UN experts call for regulating ads directed at children

Rezaul said 362 tea garden workers in Madhabpur upazila of Habiganj are not getting their payments for four months and their rights are being violated.
