3-year-old Mirpur boy goes missing

A three-year-old boy has been missing from his residence at Mirpur since 11:00am yesterday.

Mosammat Rubi, a domestic worker, left Sujon and his six-year-old daughter at her residence at Avenue 5 of Mirpur-11 before going to work. As she returned in the afternoon, she found Sujon missing, she told the BBC Bangla.

Fire service officials said the incident was reported at 8:00pm and they searched for Sujon in the nearby canal. "We will begin the search at 7:00am today," an on-duty fire official told this correspondent around 11:00pm yesterday.

Four arrested over threat to UNO

Police yesterday arrested four persons including a young woman for allegedly threatening upazila nirbahi officer of Bhaluka in Mymensingh.

They are Md Mofizuddin, and Sujon Miah, of Kharuali village; Shawkat Mondol, of Kanthali, and Farhana Akhtar Rony, of Medila, police said.

"Some unknown callers on Monday threatened to blow off my office and residence," alleged Kamrul Ahsan Talukder, UNO of Bhaluka, who lodged a general diary with police. Using mobile tracking, police arrested the four, said Md Mamun-or-Rashid, officer-in-charge of Bhaluka Police Station. One of the arrestees wanted to take revenge on the other over past enmity, and threatened the UNO using his mobile phone, he said.

He was also called for consultations, two weeks after Turkey's ambassador left Dhaka.

A source at the Turkey's embassy in Dhaka yesterday confirmed to The Daily Star about the ambassador's return. The foreign ministry also received the note of his return, said an official, who wanted not to be quoted.

Since his departure, deputy chief of mission Ahmed Gurbuz had been discharging the responsibilities of the ambassador. However, the Turkey's foreign ministry has called back three of its diplomats, including Gurbuz. Instead of going back home, they left Dhaka for the US and Russia, diplomatic sources said.

International news agencies on Thursday quoting Turkey's Foreign Minister Mevlut Cavusoglu reported that two officials from Bangladesh fled to New York as military attaches and diplomats from Turkey's different missions were fleeing to escape post-coup inquiry.

President Erdogan recently survived a failed coup attempt following which his government detained 35,022 people including half of army generals.

Rickshaw-puller dies as truck runs him over

A rickshaw-puller died as a truck ran him over in Amberkhana of Sylhet city yesterday evening.

Enraged, locals blocked the road and vandalised at least 15 vehicles, said witnesses.

Identity of the victim could not be known as of filing of this report at 8:00pm.

Monojir Islam, assistant commissioner of Sylhet Airport Police Station said they have arrested the driver and the blockade was withdrawn afterwards.

The body was sent to a hospital for an autopsy, said police.

Pirojpur teenage girl 'raped by neighbour'

A schoolgirl was allegedly raped by her neighbour in Bhandaria upazila of Pirojpur on Thursday.

Alleged rapist Rubel Talukder, 21, of Mathbaria upazila was arrested, said Bhandaria police, adding that that they were trying to arrest his friend Ujjal, 22, as the family sued them.

The 14-year-old was admitted to a hospital.

The girl's mother alleged that Rubel picked her daughter by a motorbike at knife-point while she was going to school and violated her in Ujjal's house.

Dhaka Women's Marathon held

A mini marathon for women was held in the capital yesterday.

Three-hundred women from different professionals and backgrounds took part in the 10km "Dhaka Women's Marathon" themed "Empowerment for health, empowering women."

Organised by Everest Academy in association with Dhaka South City Corporation, the race began from Teacher-Student Centre (TSC) of the Dhaka University with the marathoners running for an hour and 25 minutes before returning to the TSC.

DU Vice Chancellor Prof AAMS Arefin Siddique inaugurated the event at 9:00am where Bangladesh's first Everest conqueror Musa Ibrahim was present, among others.

Sumi Akhtar of Bangladesh Army won the first prize as she finished the race in 48 minutes and 22 seconds.

"I keep on practicing everyday and that, what I think, made me the winner," she told the BBC Bangla.

Sarmin Sultana, a student of Eden Mohila College, said, "I have come here to encourage women."

Some 203 of the 300 women finished the marathon within the given time.

The first prize winner received Tk 30,000 along with a trophy, medal and a certificate.

Besides, a mom-a-thon was arranged for the mothers. It was a symbolic marathon in which women took part in a 50 metre race with their children.
