OIC chief leaves Dhaka after 2-day visit

Pranab's wife
commemorated
in Narail

Indian High Commissioner in Bangladesh Harsh Vardhan Shringla yesterday said the former first lady of India late Suvra Mukherjee was a genuine friend of the people of Bangladesh and her contributions to promoting people-to-people contacts between the two countries were unparalleled.

"Bangladesh had always been in her thoughts. She reciprocated the love and affection she got from the people of Bangladesh," he said while addressing a commemorative event of Suvra in Narail yesterday.

The event was organised by Suvra Mukherjee Foundation, marking the first death anniversary of Suvra, the wife of India's incumbent President Pranab Mukherjee.

Shringla yesterday made a whirlwind visit to Jessore and Narail districts and interacted with officials, lawmakers and community representatives.

Addressing the event, the Indian envoy said Suvra was born there [Narail] and she always maintained her close association through friends and relatives.

During his 2013 visit to Bangladesh, Pranab visited his in-laws' house in the district.

Mentioning that Suvra wrote two books -- Chokher Aloey, and Chena Achenai Chin, Shringla said, "Suvra Mukherjee is not among us today, but her works will stay with us forever and continue to inspire us to strengthen friendly ties between both the countries."

Prime Minister's Economic Affairs Adviser Mashru Rahman and Dhaka University Vice Chancellor Prof AAMS Arefin Siddique, among others, attended the programme.

UPCOMING 14TH JEC MEETING IN DHAKA

Beijing to discuss ways to
boost investment climate

UNB, Dhaka

Ways for improving trade and investment environment and addressing the "concerns" of Chinese corporations operating in Bangladesh will come up in a broader way in the next meeting of Bangladesh and China in Dhaka on Monday.

The Chinese side will raise seven specific issues, including negotiations on China-Bangladesh Free Trade Agreement, strengthening cooperation on major projects, according to the meeting agenda obtained by the news agency.

China will also discuss ways to strengthen Chinese assistance to Bangladesh, its future expansion, promotion of China-aid projects and cooperation on human resources.

Both sides will hold the 14th session of the Bangladesh-China Joint Commission on Economic and Trade Cooperation (JEC) on Monday with focus on specific issues relating to bilateral trade, economic assistance, investment and mutual cooperation.

Bangladesh and China will discuss ways to have further concrete measures to bolster

bilateral trade, widen economic cooperation and boost investment flow, eying mutual benefits by reducing the bilateral trade imbalance.

Chinese Vice Minister of Commerce Gao Yan will co-chair the 14th JEC meeting with her Bangladesh counterpart Economic Relations Division (ERD) Senior Secretary Mohammad Mejbahuddin, an ERD official said.

Referring to the agenda proposed by China, officials said China wants to review the implementation progress of economic and trade agreements agreed upon by the leaders of the two countries earlier.

China will also discuss Chinese Economic and Industrial Zone in Chittagong and Garment Industrial Park, the officials added.

Apart from evaluating the bilateral economic and trade relations, China will also discuss its economic development.

Bangladesh will discuss ways to close the trade gap between the two countries and will highlight investment opportunities in Bangladesh.


