

## BCL man held for beating cop

An activist of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) was arrested on charge of beating up a policeman in Benapole of Jessore yesterday.

The arrestee is Towhidur Rahman.

Injured Asaduzzaman Asad, 45, constable of Benapole police immigration office, was admitted to Jessore Medical College Hospital.

When Asad was returning from his office, Towhidur and his brother Mofizur Rahman, vice president of Sharsha upazila unit of the party, beat him following an altercation over crossing a road in the area.

On information, the law enforcers rushed to the spot and arrested Towhidur, said Jahirul Islam, sub-inspector of Benapole Port Police Station.

# Hilsa trader's brutality on poor fishermen

A hilsa trader brutally tortured two fishermen siblings in Kuakata area of Kalapara upazila under the district for their 'failure' to return earnest money.

The alleged perpetrator is Quddus Mridha, a warehouse owner at Alipur fish landing station, while the victims are Abu Taleb, 26, and his brother Helal, 20, of Khalgora fishermen's village near Kuakata.

On Tuesday noon, Quddus came to Khalgora fishermen village and demanded return of the earnest money earlier given to the two brothers, locals said.

There Quddus and his men physically tortured Taleb and Helal, brought the two brothers to Quddus' warehouse, tightened them with rope and tortured them again for an hour.

Informed, Uttam Kumer, sub-inspector of Mohipur Police Station, rushed to the spot and rescued Taleb and Helal from the spot around 2:00pm on Tuesday.

They received treatment at Kuakata Hospital.

Quddus Mridha said, "Abu Taleb, Helal and two other fishermen received Tk 1.50

lakh from me as earnest money in 2013 on condition of selling all their fishes to my warehouse. But after two years, the two brothers stopped giving fish to me. And so, my men interrogated them."

Md Monir Hossain, elder brother of Abu Taleb and Helal, said, "My two brothers took Tk 40,000 as earnest money from Quddus Mridha and Tk 32,000 of it was already paid off."

They were scheduled to pay rest Tk 8,000 in next month but Quddus with his men attacked my brothers before the fixed date, he said.

"Quddus and his men brutally tortured my sons and also threatened them to harass by filling a false case," Moyna Begum, mother of Abu Taleb and Helal, said with tears.

Abdur Rahim Khan, president of Kuakata fish warehouse owners association, said it is inhuman that Quddus Mridha physically tortured fishermen.

"Abu Taleb filed a case with Mohipur Police Station on Tuesday night in this regard. We are taking lawful step after proper investigation," said Maksudur Rahman, officer in charge of the police station.

## Peddlers pledge to check drugs

75 surrender to police

The drug peddlers, who surrendered to police in Lalmonirhat Sadar upazila on Tuesday, pledged to refrain from taking, carrying and trading drugs.

Seventy-five drug peddlers, including eight females, surrendered to police at Krishok Bidrohi Neta Nurulain Mancha in Mogholhat village under the upazila.

Superintendent of Police (SP) SM Rashidul Haque and Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Shafiqul Islam received them with flowers and welcomed them to back to normal life.

"I took oath in presence of police, administration and local people that I will never allow drugs in my life. I will help police to control drugs in the village," said Bakul Hossain, 52, son of Hanif Ali of Karnapur village.

Policemen of five police stations have been conducting special drives against drugs use and trading. At least 150 identified drug peddlers were arrested, 110 cases were lodged, and a huge quantity of contraband drugs were seized in the last two weeks, police said.

Asma Begum, 48, wife of Abul Hossain of Karnapur village in Lalmonirhat Sadar, said she was never at peace and could not save money during 20 years of drug peddling, but she had to face trouble every moment.

Manowar Hossain, 52, son of Shamsul Haque of village Char Falimiri village, said peddling drugs isn't a life, but a curse. "Villagers hate and insult drug peddlers. I surrendered so I could stop peddling drugs," he added.

Mogholhat UP Chairman Habibur Rahman said "Taking help of police I conducted motivation campaign to bring back the drug peddlers to normal life.

Lalmonirhat Sadar Police Station OC Rafiqul Islam said the surrendered drug peddlers are cordially welcome to normal life, but those who did not surrender, will of course face serious trouble.

## Five killed in Natore boat capsized

Five people died as a boat capsized in the River Padma in Beelmaria area under Lalpur upazila.

The deceased were Belal Hossain, 45, of Mohorkaya village, Bhasan Ali, 28, Talukdar Ali, and Arzed Ali, 43, of the same village, Jamal Uddin, 52, and Chandar Ali, 52, of Cwalkbadkoya village.

A boat carrying the five sank in the river around 7:00am on Tuesday, said Omar Faruk, in-charge of Rajshahi fire service.

Of the five, Belal's body was recovered in the afternoon. However, the rest went missing.

## Farmer dies of heat stroke

## 21 YEARS OF YASMIN MURDER I don't want repeat of such incident Says mother

The 21st death anniversary of Yasmin Akhter, who was raped and murdered by three policemen, was observed in Dinajpur yesterday.

The day is also observed as Women Torture Prevention Day across the country.

On the occasion, Sharifa Begum, mother of Yasmin, said, "I wish not to see any repeat of such brutal incident in future."

Kaniz Rahman, president of Bangladesh Mohila Parishad's Dinajpur unit, said this kind of incident would not happen anymore if the accused are punished.

People from all walks of life placed wreaths at the memorial of Yasmin, which was built at Dashmile Intersection on Dhaka-Dinajpur highway in July, 2012.

Marking the day, different non-governmental organisations formed human chains and arranged discussion meetings in the district town.

Fourteen-year-old Yasmin, who had been working as a domestic help in the capital, on her way back home got down at Dashmile Intersection from a Panchagarh-bound bus in the early hours of August 24, 1995.

As she was waiting for a Dinajpur-bound bus, a patrol team of police picked her up in their van on false assurance of giving her a lift to her mother's house. They later raped and killed her and dumped the body by the roadside.

The incident sparked widespread protest. The townspeople staged demonstration demanding arrest and exemplary punishment of the culprits.

In the face of agitation, the district administration imposed a curfew in the town on August 27, 1995. As thousands of people came to the streets violating the curfew, police opened fire on the protesters. Seven people were killed in police firing.

The Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal of Rangpur awarded death penalty to three policemen who were executed in 2004.

## Missing ex-army man found dead

Police recovered the decomposed body of a missing retired army man from the Bairan River in Gopalpur upazila yesterday.

The deceased was Mohammad Shamim, 40, son of late Mohir Uddin of Bildoga village. He went missing five days ago, said locals.

The victim willingly retired from Bangladesh Army one and a half years ago when he was working in Chittagong Cantonment as a soldier, said police. His hands and legs were tied, police added.

They are investigating the matter, said Moksedul Alam, inspector of Gopalpur Police Station.
