

## MP Badi's cousin held with Yaba

UNB, Cox's Bazar

Police arrested a cousin of lawmaker Abdur Rahman Badi along with 10,000 Yaba pills at Chowdhurypara in Teknaf municipality of Cox's Bazar on Thursday.

The arrestee is Mohammad Hossain Kala, son of late Dudu Miah of Shah Porir Dwip Jaliyapara and a cousin of Badi.

Locals said several young men snatched a Yaba consignment from a group of smugglers on Thursday noon. Kala took away a packet of Yaba from Ayesha, wife of one Md Alkas.

Police arrested Kala with the pills, said Md Abdul Mazid, officer-in-charge of Teknaf police. Ayesha was also arrested yesterday morning. A case was filed.

## Waterway workers continue strike

Water transport workers abstained from work on Tuesday demanding, among others, Tk 10,000 as the minimum monthly wage, which the owners are denying citing that they will not be able to operate vessels after meeting the demand.

Bulbul Ahmed, convener of Bangladesh Noujan Sramik Oikya Sangram Parishad, told The Daily Star that their work stoppage will continue until their demands are fulfilled.

## Lokayan: a museum bringing

Thakurgaon, echoed Liza. "Lokayan reminds us of the struggles our predecessors went through over the years."

Dr Md Shahid-uz-Zaman, chairman of the museum, said Lokayan built with the aim of promoting the country's heritage focuses on lifestyles of the grassroots who are neglected in the conventional museums.

Initially, Esdo launched the museum in a room on a small scale in its agricultural farm at the upazila and used to showcase the items spontaneously donated by its employees and locals. Later the authorities collected more items on information from different sources.

As of now a shed for the museum, two thatch-roof houses, an open stage and a hexagonal tin-roof house have been constructed. Added to them is an abode of a feudal lord that demonstrates feudal customs of our ancestors.

On February 1 this year, Nadi Gallery (river gallery) was built in the museum to preserve water from all the rivers of the country and let everyone know of the details of those rivers.

Apart from showcasing the water in bottles, the gallery also displays photographs, documentaries, music and literary works relating to the rivers so as to raise public awareness of river conservation.

"The lives and livelihood of the people are adversely affected by the loss of the rivers. We need to ensure their right to water and simultaneously acknowledge rights of the rivers. And such gallery will help create awareness of river conservation among the

people," Zaman hopes.

Given that the ethnic minority people are losing their heritage coming in contact with modern lifestyles, the authorities added another gallery -- Ethnic Gallery -- the following month, which represents particularly the life and cultures of the ethnic communities.

This is, too, anticipated to be helping the visitors know about these communities, thus promoting inter-communal harmony in the country, they said.

Meanwhile, the construction work of another gallery "Muktijuddho Gallery" is now going on and it will likely be opened for visitors on 26 March next year, informed Zaman, adding that Pali Karma-Sahayak Foundation (PKSF) donated Tk 10 lakh to the gallery.

"In addition to running the museum, we organise different cultural programmes including Barsha Mangal Utshab, Pitha Utshab and Chaitra Sangkranti, to promote cultural heritage among our future generations," he further said.

It is not just that Lokayan serves as a repository of bucolic cultures; it will, they say, also be creating employment opportunities for a good number of poor, marginal people, particularly women and ethnic communities in days to come.

On its compound, there are over 1,000 timber, fruit and ornamental trees and medicinal plants, each bearing a name tag so that visitors can easily recognise them. A set of playground equipment such as cradle, slider and climber, has also been put up there for kids.

in Old Dhaka.

In primary interrogation, the detainees admitted that they have been involved in gold trafficking for a long time and some of their members brought gold ornaments and bars from Singapore, Malaysia, and different Middle Eastern countries through evading taxes, said the Rab officer.

After bringing the gold into the country, they trafficked that to India.

In disguise of a jeweller, Dinbandhu used to operate the smuggling racket, the Rab officer added.

Masud said both Tapas and Dinbandhu worked as carriers of the smuggling racket.

Tapas admitted that he used to travel from Dhaka to Benapole with gold bars in his van about twice or thrice a week.

He also became quite well-off with the money he earned by smuggling and sent his children to English medium schools, said the Rab official.

Tapas also admitted that he learnt about gold trafficking when working at a jewellery store in 2011.
