Seventy aspirant hajis from Mymensingh and Jamalpur districts have become victims of fraudulence by a hajj operator who has gone into hiding with their passports and money.

40 villagers killed in shelling, air strikes as territory controlled by Kurdish-aligned forces seized in cross-border campaign

Turkey's army and its allies thrust deeper into Syria yesterday, seizing territory controlled by Kurdish-aligned forces on the fifth day of a cross-border campaign that a

monitoring group said had killed at least 40 villagers.

A novel trick to lift cattle

Cattle rustlers in bordering upazilas of the district are resorting to innovative means for selling the stolen cattle.

Ahead of the Eid-ul-Azha these criminals are changing the skin colour of stolen animals, in a sense, giving makeovers to them.

They use hair dye, mehendi and various other colouring agents to turn a white or a red cow into black ones overnight, locals said. Finally, they shampoo

and brush the animal to give it a vibrant and healthy look so they can sell it the next day in a hurry, before the original owner of the animal is able to track down and identify it in the local cattle market, they added.

On August 12, Nazrul Islam of Lalarchak village under Kulaura upazila lost his cow, a red one, to the thieves.

An Australian teenager has become the youngest person to fly solo around the world in a single aircraft.

Lachlan Smart, who is 18 years, seven months and 21 days, beat the previous record holder Matt Guthmiller, who was 19 years, seven months and 15 days old, by almost an entire year.

Smart touched down in 24 locations across 15 countries on his way to breaking the Guinness world record. He landed along the Sunshine Coast at Maroochydore Airport on Saturday, having departed from the same airstrip on 4 July.

"The support I have received from family, friends, the local Sunshine Coast council and community and people around the world that I have never even met has been incredible from the first moment we spoke about this journey," Smart said.


