Manna gets bail in sedition case

Nagorik Oikya Convener Mahmudur Rahman Manna, who has been in jail for a year and a half, got bail in a sedition case. But he cannot get release as he is arrested in another case.

After hearing a petition filed by Manna, the High Court granted him the bail on grounds that he has been in captivity for 18 months but a charge sheet has not been submitted yet, said Deputy Attorney

General Md Bashirullah. The government will move an appeal before the Supreme Court against the High Court's bail order, he added.

Manna was arrested on February 25 last year, a day after his two telephone conversations with BNP leader Sadeque Hossain Khoka about strengthening the anti-government movement, among many issues, were leaked.

The other case was filed for instigating the armed forces to topple the government.

The speakers said these at a roundtable jointly organised by the Bangla daily Prothom Alo and CARE Bangladesh held at the newspaper's office in the capital, where the textiles

and jute ministry officials, representatives of government and NGOs, jute factory owners, manufacturers and farmers participated.

Mirza Azam, state minister for textiles and jute, said the government will take necessary steps for the industry's development, and a design institute will also be established for the development of producing diversified jute products.

Nasima Begum, joint secretary of the ministry, said, "If we use our own product, the jute industry will be developed."

Demanding fair price of jute a farmer in Rangpur Ali Hossain said the farmers become discouraged when they do not get fair price.

Humayun Khaled, former chairman of BJMC, asked for the govern ment's intervention regarding this.


