

MEDICAL COLLEGE ADMISSION QUESTION

Involve fewer people to prevent leaks

Meeting told

The number of people and phases involved in the process of producing medical college admission question paper and its delivery to examination halls should be brought down to prevent leaks, a meeting was told yesterday.

There should also be an independent committee to conduct the admission test, the speakers suggested. Doctors and professors of medical colleges and universities gave the recommendations at the meeting organised by Doctors for Health and Environment at Dhaka's Jatiya Press Club.

"Some people are doing business by leaking questions," said Prof Anu Muhammad of Jahangirnagar University. "Coaching centres and government officials are involved in this."

Prof Tanzimuddin Khan of Dhaka University said the admission test result processing system had to be more transparent. Dr MA Rashid, a director at DGHS, said the government had already formed a committee to observe this year's admission test to ensure transparency.

Red Card Campaign starts today

The Upazila Governance Project (UZGP) will launch a school-level "Red Card Campaign" today to make students, teachers, guardians and community people aware of fighting against early marriage and sexual harassment.

The campaign will be conducted at 195 high schools under 65 upazilas of seven districts -- Kishoreganj, Brahmanbaria, Sirajganj, Khulna, Barguna, Sunamganj and Rangpur -- and expected to mobilise around 1.5 lakh people.

UNDP and UNCDF are providing technical and financial support to the project implemented by the Local Government Division, the European Union, and Swiss Agency for Development Cooperation.

The schools will hold a daylong workshop and discussion on the consequences of early marriage and sexual harassment -- reproductive health, social and mental risks.

DETAINED MILITANTS

Washington ready to assist Dhaka in investigation

The United States said it is ready to assist Bangladesh in its investigation into the issues of militants detained in the country following the recent terror attacks.

It, however, depends on the Bangladesh government whether it needs any assistance at all, a government official here said.

"As the Government of Bangladesh determines what assistance it requires in this investigation, we stand ready to provide our support," US Embassy Spokesperson Nancy VanHorn told the news agency yesterday.

She made the remark when her attention was drawn to media reports that the FBI is interested to interrogate militants detained in the country.

"Our law enforcement cooperation is focused on capacity building and sharing best practices, including investigative and analytical capabilities that can be helpful when dealing with the emerging threats," Nancy said.

of BADC and some others organisations' land) and fixed the implementing time from June 1998 to 2001.

Advertisements were also published in newspapers on August 20, 2000 by authorities concerned requesting people not to construct any house or structures on the 270 acres of low land areas under the project.

But unplanned urbanisation has been going on unabated there, sources

said. The land ministry on February 7, 2002 cancelled the acquiring process due to the expiration of the scheduled time of section 5(1) of land acquisition, said a Wasa official.

Later the government decided to implement the retention area on around 227 acres of land (private land 101.28 acres, BADC 98.35 acres, Water Development Board 6.36 acres, Wasa 9.7 acres and khas land 11.4 acres)

Wasa on January 25, 2006, again requested the ministry to acquire 116.02 acres of land (104.62 acre private and 11.4 acre khas) to implement the second phase of the Kalyanpur pump station, he said, adding that the ministry on February 11, 2007, finally approved to acquire 112.68 acres of land (101 acre private land).

But it was also not done at that time as a committee again suggested reducing the regulating area and only around 57 acres were acquired due to a fund shortage and decided to acquire the rest around 56 acres in the second phase.

Later on July 11, 2013, in a meeting of Economic Relations Division, a decision was taken to construct the regulatory pond on 171 acres of land (BADC 98.35 acres, Water Development Board 6.36 acres, Wasa 9.7 acres and acquired 57 acres) leaving the process of acquiring 56.19 acres.

Institute of Water Modelling then carried out a study, and suggested setting up another pump having a capacity of 16 cumec to continue the retention areas on 171 acres of land.

It also suggested evicting illegal grabbers from the pond area, excavating the pond to increase its capacity and the canal mouths and setting up boundaries for its proper utilisation.

Wasa later prepared a Development Project Proforma (DPP) following the decision, which was supposed to be implemented by July 2015 to June 2018.

Later, following another decision at a government meeting, Wasa is again preparing to re-submit the DPP.

In Goran Chatbari pumping station, there was only one pumping station with a capacity of 22 cumec. Later in 2010-15, another 22 cumec capacity pump was set up by reducing the marshy lands for the construction of the Rajuk's Utara third phase, said a Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) official.

But BWDB is setting up another pump there having a capacity of 22 cumec as the BWDB handed over 40 acres of land from its retention area to the road transport

and bridges ministry to construct the elevated expressway.

An IWM study suggested setting up another pump with a 22 cumec capacity to meet the deficit of 40 acres of land from the retention area, said Abul Kamal Azad, chief engineer (central zone) of BWDB.

The ministry will bear the cost from the elevated expressway project and have already started setting up the pump and handed over the land to them, he said, adding, an MoU was signed between the two sides on September 21, 2016.

Total retention area of Goran Chatbari is 676 acres (273 hectare) from where they have handed over the 40 acres of land, he said.

Prof Nishat said that keeping a retention pond in front of every pump station is a must.

Though it was planned to keep more areas as retention pond for Goran Chatbari, it was not done due to the pressure of influential people, he alleged.

The areas kept as retention ponds are being protected with huge hurdles, he said.

Nishat said there is no regulatory pond in front of the Kalyanpur pump station, as Wasa does not have the ownership of the pond area. They are increasing the capacity of the pumping station but if the situation continues, the station will lose its effectiveness by the next 10 to 15 years, he warned.

Though it was the suggestion of a high powered committee of the government in 1989 formed after the 1988 flood, to purchase the land, it was not implemented, he added.
