

U-16 WOMEN'S FOOTBALL TEAM School suspends teacher for beating up player's father

Police are yet to arrest Jobed Ali Talukder, a physical education teacher of Kalsindur High School and College in Mymensingh's Dhobaura upazila, who allegedly threatened nine Kalsindur members of the Bangladesh U-16 football team with transferring them another school and assaulted Sabuj Miah, father of the team's member Taslima Akhtar.

Police are looking for him, said Md Shawkat Alam, officer-in-charge of Dhobaura Police Station.

The trouble arose when Talukder learned of the girls' unavailability for this year's School Level Summer Football competition starting on September 16. The girls said they will be unavailable as they have to travel back to Dhaka on September 16 to join the Bangladesh Football Federation (BFF) training camp and attend a reception in the team's honour on September 17.

Talukder "assaulted" Sabuj at Kalsindur Bazar Wednesday when he was sharing the day's earlier events involving the teacher with another teacher Md Mofizuddin, according to witnesses. Sabuj lodged a case with Dhobaura Police Station yesterday against Talukder, who was suspended by the school administration for the alleged assault.

He was served a show cause notice asking him to reply within 48 hours during the school governing body's meeting yesterday.

A three-member probe body formed at the meeting was asked to submit its report within two days.

IU publishes draft list of 53 absent students

The authorities of Islamic University (IU) in Kushtia yesterday published a draft list of 53 students of different departments who have been absent for 15 days or above without any notice.

The publicity came following an inquiry as per an instruction by the education ministry, and University Grants Commission (UGC), according to the IU public relations department.

Earlier, the university authorities called a meeting for all concerned to make a list.

Of the absentees, six are from folklore studies, 11 management, 13 finance and banking, five marketing and 18 from applied chemistry and chemical engineering departments.

The public relations department in a Facebook post asked the students to attend offices concerned and explain their absence within September 20.

"We are still working and many departments could not contribute to it as the university is closed for Eid-ul-Azha," said Proctor Prof Mahubur Rahman.

On August 22, the UGC sent letters to all public universities to make such lists.

The instruction came after the country experienced deadly terror attacks in Dhaka and Sholakia in July.

IU Vice Chancellor Prof Rashid Askari said actions will be taken against the students, who would fail to obey the official order, as per the instructions by the higher authorities concerned.

Tutor's beating sends student to hospital

Mercilessly assaulted by a tutor, a student of Bandarban Govt Sishu Poribar, a government-run hostel in Kalaghata of Bandarban for impoverished students of different primary and high schools in the district, is groaning with pain at a Sadar hospital.

The tutor, Md Jashim alias Jashim Hujur, hit Padmo Tanchangya, a 10th-grader living at the hostel, in the hands and legs on Thursday for his alleged carelessness to a child of Jashim who also lives there. He also beat and chased other students approaching to see the incident, alleged witnesses.

It was alleged that Jashim always wanted the hostel students to take care of his child. Chali Mong Marma, a Sangu High

School student residing in the hostel, alleged, "Jashim sir beat me mercilessly with a piece of wood and broke one of my fingers a few months ago."

Two other students -- Pitar Tripura and Kya Noi Marma -- echoed Chali Mong, adding that they fled the hostel being unable to bear the tutor's torture. Asked, Jashim conceded, "I made a mistake. Please forgive me. I will never do this again."

Another student, Krom Poing Mro alleged, "The hostel authorities do not properly provide us with food." Padmo's mother Suroth Tanchangya demanded punishment for the tutor.

Shafiqul Islam, head of the institution, said, "I've visited the victim at the hospital", adding, "It was very cruel and unfortunate."



ZIA CHARITABLE TRUST Khaleda's lawyer allowed to cross-examine IO in graft case

The Supreme Court has allowed BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia's lawyers to cross examine the investigation officer of Zia Charitable Trust corruption case on three issues.

The issues are related to how the IO, Harunur Rashid, is still working after being withdrawn from the Anti Corruption Commission (ACC) in 2005, what he had said in his oath, and whether the board of trustee would be liable or not under the Trust Act, 1882 if the trust property is misused, said ACC lawyer Khurshid Alam Khan.

A five-member bench of the Appellate Division headed by Chief Justice Surendra Kumar Sinha passed the order on Thursday after hearing two leave to appeal petitions filed by Khaleda Zia on May 31 challenging a High Court verdict that cleared the way for running the trial proceedings of the case.

On May 15, the HC rejected Khaleda's two revision petitions challenging a lower court order which on April 17 rejected her two applications in the graft case lodged by the ACC on August 8, 2011.

One of the applications was filed for re-cross examination of the investigation officer of the case while the other for scrutinising the case diary.

Other accused in the case are Harris Chowdhury, Khaleda's former political secretary; Ziaul Islam Munna, assistant private secretary of Harris; and Monirul Islam Khan, assistant personal secretary of former Dhaka city mayor Sadeque Hossain Khoka. Harris is on the run.
