



The boiler explosion at Tampaco Foils Limited in Tongi BSCIC industrial area of Gazipur left a trail of carnage and destruction yesterday morning. As firefighting units continue to rescue people and douse the blaze after a fire broke out triggered by the explosion, many injured victims were rushed to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital and Tongi government hospital in Tongi for treatment. The bodies of the deceased were also kept at the hospitals, where teary-eyed relatives of the deceased and injured workers continue to pray for their loved ones. A part of the four-story factory building collapsed after the incident. The biggest industrial disaster since Rana Plaza building collapse in 2013 left 24 workers dead and 74 injured.
