

'PLOT TO KILL JOY'
SC stays
Mahmudur's
bail till Oct 30

The Supreme Court yesterday stayed till October 30 a High Court order that had granted bail to acting editor of the daily Amar Desh Mahmudur Rahman in a case filed for an alleged attempt to abduct and kill Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's son Sajeeb Wazed Joy.

Chamber Judge of the Appellate Division Justice Hasan Foez Siddique passed the order following a petition seeking stay on the HC order.

Mahmudur Rahman cannot get released from jail till October 30 following the Supreme Court order, Additional Attorney General Murad Reza told The Daily Star.

Following a petition filed by Mahmudur, the HC on September 7 granted him permanent bail in the case.

Mahmudur Rahman, a pro-BNP journalist and former energy adviser, has been in prison since April 11, 2013. He was shown arrested in several cases and has got bail in all of them.

UN hails Bangladesh's
commitment to SDGs

The United Nations has appreciated Bangladesh's commitment so far shown to implementing Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), mentioning that still there are more to be done.

"I'm noticing that the government of Bangladesh has made some strong efforts through establishing inter-ministerial committee on SDGs monitoring and evaluation," said Dr David Nabarro, UN Secretary-General's Special Adviser on the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, while responding to a query of the news agency.

He made the remark ahead of the first anniversary of the SDGs that will begin in New York today with over 140 world leaders.

Since the unanimous adoption of 17 SDGs, the cornerstone of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development in September last year, governments, private sector and civil society are quickly moving to take actions that they need to end poverty, address inequalities and tackle climate change by 2030.

To mark the first anniversary, a number of high-level events and side events will be taking place from September 19 to 23 in New York.

Dr Nabarro said he is very pleased to see "good dialogues" in Bangladesh among governments, NGOs, civil society organisations (CSOs), development partners and media ensuring private sector's involvement in the implementation of SDGs.

"Still, more needs to be done. Political commitment, in my view, can never be too much," the special adviser added.

He said he has always been "amazed" and "impressed" by the commitment not just by the government, but also by the civil society, women groups and community organisations in Bangladesh on all aspects of development.

The development gained by Bangladesh in various areas so far is a testimony of the commitment and strength of the country, Nabarro said, emphasising continuation of strong "role played by senior parliamentarians in successfully" implementing the SDGs.

the worst sufferers as they neither have enough space for study in their dormitory nor in the library.
 Faisal Ahmed, a first year student of government and politics, said the dormitory he lives in does not have a suitable atmosphere for study. Moreover, the seating arrangement in the reading room of the dormitory is limited.
 "I along with 25 students live in the common room where freshers have to stay before they get a seat and it is almost impossible to study there. We have to suffer a lot during our examinations, as it is hard to get a seat in the library and take preparations," he added.
 Although the number of students has increased to more than 14,000, the authorities did not expand the library space. However, the university administration plans to build an extension and the foundation stone for the building has already been laid.
 According to library officials, the authorities increased around 200 seats on the first floor for new students.
 Visiting the library, this correspondent found that most of the students were studying books related to job examinations, which they had brought with them. Besides, many guide books were kept on the vacant seats so that others cannot sit on them.
 According to library officials, in the last six months from January to June, 184 books on average have been issued to the students every day while 1,000 students visit the library daily.
 Khaledun Ratul, a student of government and politics, said, "Some rooms on the second and third floors are only for teachers to do research works. However, teachers are rarely seen using the rooms." "If the authorities let students use the rooms, the space crisis in the library will be mitigated," he added.
 Admitting the fact and wishing anonymity, a library official said, "We are not asked to check whether students keep their library cards with them or not. We just search their bags so that they cannot take out any library book when they leave."
 Besides, the library authority does not keep any entry list of students, he said, adding, "If we can stop outsiders from entering the library, the crisis will be reduced," he added.
 Denying the seat crisis for regular students, Librarian Prof Ajit Kumar Mazumdar said the presence of former students in the library creates an "artificial" seat crisis and the number of outsiders in the library is very small.
 "At least 200 new seats have been added to the library last year and 200 more seats and 3,500 books will be added this year. We will not face any crisis once the construction work of the extended part of the library completes."
 "We will install closed circuit television (CCTV) cameras and create an online library so that students can read books by logging into our website from anywhere," he added.
 JU Pro-Vice Chancellor Prof Abul Hossain said, "We have already submitted a project to build the extended part of the library and it needs a lot of money." However, he could not say when the project will be implemented.

Anwar Hossain Milon is the general secretary of ward-10 unit of Jubo League. Rizvi mainly had an enmity with Milon as he was an aspirant for the post in the next committee, they said.
 Sunny's full name is Ahsanul Haque. He is also a Jubo League activist, loyal to Milon while Raza is also a Jubo League activist of Kamalapur area with a criminal background.
 Aminul Haque was a close associate of Jahid Siddique Tarek, the prime accused in Jubo League leader Reazul Haque Khan Milky murder in July 30, 2013. Tarek was later killed in a "shootout" with Rab.
 Rizvi, 34, a father of two, died at a city hospital at 2:30am on Saturday, around three hours after he was shot by eight to 10 unidentified criminals at the Motijheel AGB Colony.
 Before his death, Rizvi is said to have mentioned a few names of his killers before his family members at the hospital.
