

Improve services at police stations

DMP chief asks colleagues

Dhaka Metropolitan Police commissioner Asaduzzaman Mia yesterday asked all concerned to improve service standards in each police station as it is perceived as the visage of police to the city dwellers.

All the success the DMP achieved in various other fields will be blemished by the delivery of below par service quality at the police stations, he said while addressing at a monthly crime conference at the DMP headquarters.

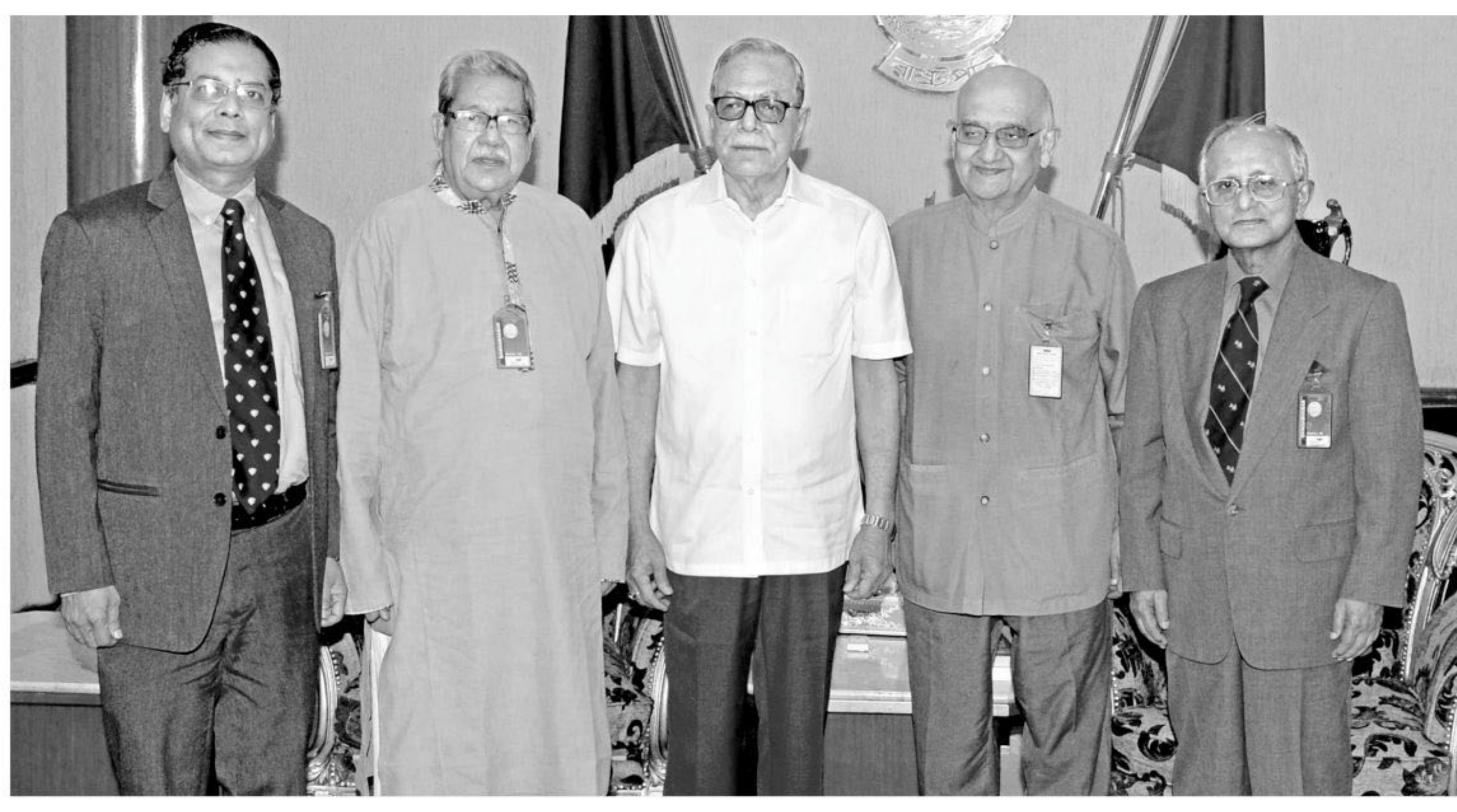
The residents of the capital in recent days were relieved to witness a number of successful operations by DMP's counter terrorism unit as it neutralised a handful of terror plots by either apprehending or gunning down several top terror suspects.

However, many of the residents have been raising their concern over harassment and alleged "arrest trades" at the police stations.

The commissioner at the conference urged all members of the force to ensure transparency and accountability in every step of the way.

Asaduzzaman expressed his dissatisfaction over the slow progress of data entry work for creating a centralised tenants' database titled Citizen Information Management System (CIMS), meeting sources said.

GULSHAN ATTACK CASE

Plea filed for showing Rigan arrested

Detectives have submitted a prayer before a Dhaka court to show Rakibul Hasan alias Rigan, accused in a case filed over Kalyanpur Jahaj Building incident, arrested now in the Gulshan café attack case.

The 20-year-old "Neo JMB" operative was caught wounded during a police raid at Taj Manzeel, also known as Jahaj Building, in Kalyanpur on July 26.

Humayun Kabir, an inspector of the Counter Terrorism and Transnational Crime unit and investigation officer of the Gulshan attack case, on Monday submitted the petition.

On Sunday, Rigan gave his confessional statement before Metropolitan Magistrate Sadrir Yasir Ahsan Chowdhury.

The petition says Rigan was involved in the Gulshan café incident. The IO also submitted a seven-day remand prayer to interrogate Rigan to find out vital clues about the café attack. The court, however, fixed September 25 for passing an order on the petition.

On July 1, militants stormed into Holey Artisan Bakery in Dhaka's Gulshan and killed nine Italians, seven Japanese, two Bangladeshis, one Indian and one Bangladesh-born US citizen. Two police officers were also killed.

Road crashes kill 3

Three people were killed and 33 others injured in road accidents in three districts yesterday.

In Sylhet, two people were killed as a bus hit a motorcycle on Dhaka-Sylhet highway in South Surma upazila.

The deceased were Younus Ali, 30, an UP member of Lalabazar in the upazila and Abdus Sahid, 27. Both hailed from Bagharkhola Kalapur village.

In Tangail, bus helper Ataur Rahman, 30, of Manikganj Sadar was killed and eight people were injured as the vehicle skidded off the Dhaka-Tangail highway in Postkamuri area of Mirzapur upazila.

In Jessore Sadar, at least 25 passengers were injured as a bus hit a roadside tree after the driver lost control over the vehicle in Nangarpur on Jessore-Magura road.

any specific insights into the cause of the incident, but hoped that the committee will be able to complete the investigation in time and submit a report.

Four other probe committees have also been formed.

The National Workers Federation of Gazipur unit and Bangladesh Agriculture Farm Federation yesterday demonstrated and submitted a memorandum to the Gazipur DC, seeking arrest of factory owner Makbul Hossain Lechu and proper compensations for the victim families.

Meanwhile, three rights organisations filed a writ petition with the High Court on September 19, seeking its directives on the authorities concerned to give sufficient compensations to the victims and legal actions against the people responsible for the tragedy.

Ain o Salih Kendra (ASK), Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers Association (Bela), and Bangladesh Legal Aid and Services Trust (BLAST) filed the petition, bhuiyans' lawyer Sharif Bhuiyan told The Daily Star.

The HC fixed September 26 for passing an order on the petition.

Pro-poor governance for cities stressed

Pro-poor governance has to be established in urban areas, said an urban planner yesterday.

Prof Nazrul Islam, chairman of Centre for Urban Studies (CUS), made the call while addressing the inaugural session of a two-day programme "4th Urban Dialogue 2016 -- Towards Healthy & Resilient Cities" at the Senate building of Dhaka University, organised by Urban INGO Forum, Centre for Urban Resilience, and the Department of Disaster Science and Management of DU.

Mentioning that about 20 percent dwellers in the capital are poor and of them 8 percent are extreme poor, Prof Nazrul urged to take a sustainable plan to accommodate the poor in the 1,530 square kilometres of Dhaka city to prevent informal and unhygienic settlements like slums.

Dhaka North City Corporation Mayor Annisul Huq threatened to bulldoze illegal structures on footpaths soon if those are not removed after request. He said six lakh trees will be planted within two years to make Dhaka a green city.

Housing and Public Works Minister Mosharraf Hossain said they had already handed over 10,000 apartments to middle-income people and have a plan to build 20,000 more.

DU pro-Vice Chancellor Prof Nasreen Ahmad, National Director of Habitat for Humanity Bangladesh Jhon Armstrong, National Director of World Vision Bangladesh Fred Witteveen and DU Earth and Environmental Science Faculty Dean Dr Maksud Kamal also spoke.

Contracts approved to give 798 flats to public servants

The Cabinet Purchase Committee yesterday approved seven proposals awarding contracts for building 798 flats for public servants in the capital's Mirpur.

The housing and public works ministry selected six contractors to construct seven 20-storey buildings containing six flats per floor.

It is part of the ministry's housing project for providing 1,064 flats, of sizes 1,250 and 1,500 square feet (sqft), to public servants.

Earlier, the cabinet body awarded similar contracts to local firms in a meeting with Finance Minister AMA Muhith in the chair.

Of the builders, Jamal and Company will independently construct Building-6, comprising 1,500 sqft flats, for Tk 80.63 crore.

It will also construct Building-3 (1,250 sqft flats) with Hasan & Sons for Tk 71.57 crore, and Building-4 (1,250 sqft flats) with Masood and Company for Tk 71.12 crore.

Kusholi Nirmata Limited won contracts for Building-1 (1,250 sqft flats) at Tk 71.41 crore and Building-10 (1,500 sqft flats) at Tk 79.30 crore.

Mazid Sons Construction Ltd got Building-5 (1,250 sqft flats) for Tk 71.13 while National Development Engineering Ltd Building-9 (1,500 sqft flats) for Tk 79.30 crore.

The cabinet body also approved a ministry proposal for increasing by Tk 34.41 crore the cost of a Tk 108.83 crore under-construction housing project at Kakrail for Supreme Court judges comprising a 20-storey building with 76 flats, each of 3,500 sqft.
