

Khaleda Zia returns home

Holding different banners and festoons, several hundred leaders and activists of Dhaka city unit of BNP, gathered on both sides of the Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport road last evening to greet the party chief, Khaleda Zia, as she returned home from Saudi Arabia after completing her 15-day hajj trip.

The BNP chief arrived at the airport by an Emirates airline flight around 5:20pm.

The party's senior leaders including Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir, Mirza Abbas, Abdullah Al Noman and Mohammad Shahjahan were present there to welcome her.

Khaleda along with her entourage left the country on September 7, at the invitation of Saudi King Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud. Later, BNP Senior Vice Chairman Tarique and his family members went from London to Jeddah on the same day to perform hajj with her.

The party and family sources said during the visit Khaleda and Tarique discussed the party's different issues including its reforms, cases against BNP chief and others, as well as next course of actions.

The gathering wrought an hour-long tailback on the airport- Abdullahpur road, which endured until 8:00pm, forcing commuters to unbearably suffer, said witnesses.

10 robbers arrested, 400kg of hilsa seized

Police arrested 10 robbers and seized around 400kg of looted hilsa in Patenga area of Chittagong city yesterday.

The arrestees are Mir Kashem, Abdul Rashid, Rubel, Alamgir, Yahia, Saleh, Khokon, Babul, Jahirul and Mostafa.

A team of police raided the fishing trawler of one Sahed Majhi, 37, of Cox's Bazar and seized the fish following an allegation that the fishing trawler of a local businessman was looted by robbers while it was returning with catch early yesterday.

Sahed, who is accused in at least 10 robbery cases, fled sensing the presence of the law-enforcers. However, police arrested 10 robbers from the trawler, said Officer-in-Charge of Patenga Police Station Alamgir Mahmud.

A total of 846 people, 823 of them BDR personnel, stood trial in the carnage case.

Seventy-four people, including 57 army officials, were massacred during the BDR mutiny on February 25-26, 2009 at the Pikhana headquarters of the paramilitary force, renamed Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB).

The special HC bench comprising Justice Md Shawkat Hossain, Justice Md Abu Zafor

Siddique, and Justice Nazrul Islam Talukder started hearing the death reference and 255 appeals in January last year.

Meanwhile, 17,306 BDR jawans are facing trial in 11 special BDR courts and 60 summary trial courts for mutiny.

At least 78 accused jawans, both in carnage and mutiny cases, died under mysterious circumstances after the mutiny. Many of them reportedly died of heart attack in police custody while a few others committed suicide.
