

War crimes accused Ramjan dies at DMCH

Ramjan Ali, an accused of a case filed for allegedly committing crimes during the 1971 Liberation War, died at Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday.

He had fallen sick inside Dhaka Central Jail, a jail guard who took him to the hospital, told The Daily Star.

Prosecutor Rezia Sultana Chaman also confirmed the death.

Ramjan, 78, is one of the four accused from Durgapur upazila of Netrakona arrested on April 12 after the International Crimes Tribunal-1 issued arrested warrant against five including the four.

The accused were allegedly involved in Jamaat politics in 1971, they joined Razakar and Al-Badr Bahini, two auxiliary forces of Pakistani army, according to the prosecution.

Probe in the case started on April 30 last year and the investigation officer of the case has found "preliminary evidence" over the involvement in crimes, it said.

Hannan Shah laid to rest in Kapasia

ASM Hannan Shah, BNP standing committee member, was buried at his family graveyard in Gazipur's Kapasia upazila yesterday.

Hannan Shah, an army officer-turned politician, was laid to rest beside his father after the last namaz-e-janaza at Ghagutia High School ground around 3:30pm.

His first namaz-e-janaza in Gazipur was held at Rajbari around 9:00am followed by another at Kapasia Pilot High School ground around 11:00am, reports our local correspondent.

People from all walks of life alongside the party leaders, supporters and activists attended the namaz-e-janaza.

Hannan died of heart disease at Raffles Heart Centre in Singapore on September 27 at the age of 75.

Khadiza mentioned that Saleh and Nur were beating up her husband on Thursday morning with a broom and punching him when he fell to the ground senseless. Nur then sat on him and hit hard on his chest.

"As I was crying holding my husband, Rahima and Rokeya swooped and kept hitting us," read the statement.

The altercation between Malek and Saleh began when the former put a vase of a medicinal herb at the doorway of his rented flat in Ashkona area of Uttara.

Saleh and his son threw the vase away and beat Malek, 45, with a broom and punched him on the chest and face.

Malek, who had a heart condition, collapsed on the ground and was pronounced dead at a hospital.

reached pinnacle of his profession. He also played a vital role in spreading the spirit of anti-communalism and Bangalee nationalism.

Remembering Musa's brave role during the Pakistan regime, Anisuzzaman said journalists at that time had to follow the directives of the army officials, but his role became a rare example as he used to tell the truth through the gaps in the directives.

He said this book will open a new era in the history of journalism. Chief Information Commissioner Dr M Golam Rahman said Musa was not just a journalist, but also a good reader and listener who used to analyse news with precision.

Golam Sarwar, editor of the Bangla daily Samakal, said Musa fought for the wellbeing of the media people.

Columnist Sayed Abul Maksud said Musa was one of the key second generation Muslim journalists. Monjurul Ahsan Bulbul, president of a faction of the Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists, said it was possible for Musa to become courageous as he had achieved that through his works.

Speaking about his generosity, Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof Dr AAMS Arefin Siddique said Musa had donated to the university twice but asked the authorities not to make it public.
