100 poor families get water purifiers

It was a unique occasion as 100 poor families got water purifiers at the end of a two-day event titled Panir Golpo (tale of water) aimed at raising awareness about safe drinking water to prevent diarrhoea and other waterborne diseases.

Unilever Pureit and The Daily Star jointly organised the programme at Mohini Mohon Bidyapith in Milpara area of the town.

"I am very happy to get a water purifier. Besides, I have known many new things on various waterborne diseases, which will help me to check such problems," said Fatema, 40, a housewife.

Many others shared similar feelings while talking with this correspondent during the programme that included training on awareness building among people about various waterborne diseases, a rally highlighting the issue, door to door leaflet distribution, drama, discussions and distribution of water purifiers.

Around 500 people from different walks of life, including those vulnerable to waterborne diseases in the town, took part in the two-day campaign.

In early July this year, around 800 people were attacked with the disease in the district within a week and The Daily Star ran a report on the issue.

The newspaper conducted a survey on the outbreak of diarrhoea in

different areas of Kushtia town while Unilever Pureit, a multinational production house, showed keen interest on the matter.

Kushtia Deputy Commissioner (DC) Zahir Raihan, Superintendent of Police Proloy Chisim, Additional Superintendent of Police Zoynul Abedin, President of Kushtia Chamber of Commerce Robiul Islam, President of Kushtia town unit of Awami League Taijal Ali Khan, and Unilever Area Sales Manager Rased Hasan addressed the event yesterday.

Emphasising awareness building especially regarding drinking water, DC Zahir Raihan thanked the Unilever Bangladesh and The Daily Star for arranging such programme.

Locals said a mirror of a motorbike belonging to assistant teacher Dulal Hossain was broken as a ball hit it while some students were playing football at the school ground.

When the teacher came to know of the incident, he beat them mercilessly.

Family members took them to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital.

Dulal Hossain could not be contacted as his cellphone was switched off.

Youths' IT training for self-employment

The Department of Youth Development (DYD) has taken an innovative step to provide training to the youth on using computer and browsing the internet in Amtali upazila of Barguna.

Jobless youth, both male and female, can receive training in a mobile ICT (information communication technology) van. After completing training successfully, the trainees will be able to operate a computer as well as browse the internet.

Assistant Director of DYD Md Sultan Ahmed formally inaugurated the month-long training course as chief guest at the premises of Amtali Upazila Parishad on Sunday. Acting Upazila Nirbahi Officer Md Najmul Alam was in the chair.

Forty youths, 20 males and 20 females, are taking part in the course under a special project named 'Technology Empowerment Centre on Wheels for underprivileged Rural Young People of Bangladesh'. Fourteen trainees receive training in a batch and trainees are taking part in three batches daily.

On a visit to the programme on Monday, this correspondent saw two trainers, Babul Parvez and Md Mahbub, giving practical training to the trainees in the ICT van. Each trainee has been given a laptop to facilitate the training.

Md Mithu, a trainee, said he was taking part in the training to acquire knowledge on computer and internet, which would help him contribute to building digital Bangladesh.

Amtali upazila DYD officer Md Tofazzal Hossain said the main objective of the training is to provide skills to the youth so they can free themselves from unemployment.

The ICT van is well-equipped with ultra-modern computer system, mobile internet facilities, multi-media projector, and audio and video systems. The trainees would be given training on all the components, Tofazzal said.

Md Najmul Alam said the training programme was organised in a mobile van so that local jobless youth can avail it easily.

The five-year project started on July, 2014, and will end on June 30, 2019, at a cost of Tk 20 crore. Under the project, 15,840 jobless youths will get the opportunity to receive training on operating computer and browsing the internet.

Idols vandalised in Dinajpur

Unidentified criminals vandalised several idols at a Hindu temple in Birganj upazila of the district early yesterday.

The incident came to light in the morning when Bipul Chandra, priest of Premkangal Durga Temple at Palpara village, went to the temple and found almost all the idols either completely or partially damaged.

Locals suspected that a gang entered the temple when the idol makers left it on Tuesday midnight and vandalised the idols installed ahead of Durga Puja, said Bhupati Pal, president of the temple management committee.

However, the repair works of the damaged idols have already been started, he added.

Officer-in-Charge Akkas Ali of Birganj Police Station said they were trying to identify the culprits behind the incident.
