

Shamsul Haq still alive

Memorial meeting told

"I am Syed Shamsul Haq, still alive", a statement made by the poet in different ways in one of his creations, is definitely true not only for us but also for him, said Prof Emeritus Anisuzzaman at a memorial meeting at Bangla Academy yesterday.

He said Shamsul portrayed people, society, politics, culture, personal conflicts and problems of the masses in Bangladesh and also gave solutions through his writings continuously for the last six decades.

"Syed Haq also showed us a dream for the future, for which we will remain grateful to him forever," said the academy president while chairing the programme.

He proved correct his extraordinary decision at a young age to take up writing as a profession, added Anisuzzaman at the meeting jointly organised by the academy and Bangladesh Gyan O Srijonshil Prokashok Samity.

The eminent poet, writer and playwright passed away at a city hospital on September 27 at the age of 81.

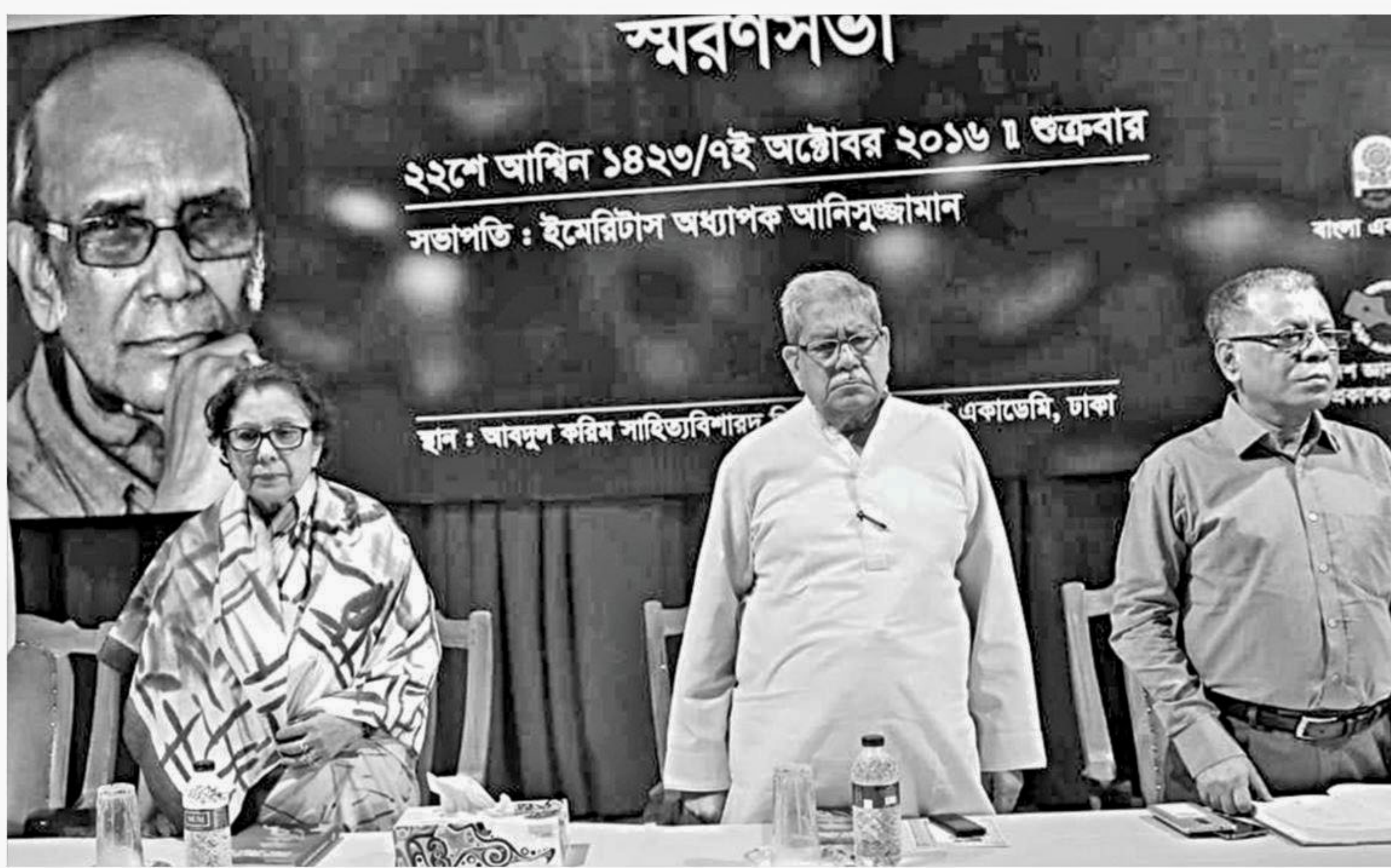
Dr Biswajit Ghosh of Dhaka University said names of Rabindranath Tagore, Buddhadeb Bosu and Shamsul must come up in any list of versatile writers of Bangla literature.

Shamsul will remain alive through his writings as long as Bangla literature and Bangladesh exists, he added.

Renowned academic Prof Serajul Islam Choudhury said Shamsul showed his multidimensional abilities roaming all branches of Bangla literature, journalism, film and radio and showed extraordinary inclination towards his work.

Shamsul's wife Anwara Syed Haq said he was alert and capable of writing even when ill and made their 50 years as a couple feel like a dream.

Cultural personalities Ramendu Majumdar and Aatur Rahman, the prime minister's special assistant Mahbulul Haq Shakil, actress Sara Begum Kabori, lyricist Md Rafiquzzaman, the samity President Osman Gani and Shamsul's son Ditiya Syed Haq also spoke.

3 robbers hurt in 'gunfight' with police

Three alleged robbers and two police constables were injured in a gunfight at Durgapur in Kahaloo upazila of Bogra early yesterday, said police.

The injured robbers -- Golam Mostafa, of Atgaria village, and Md Montu, of Kodomtoli village, and Bipul Mia, of Chokdolhat village -- were admitted with bullet injuries to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College and Hospital. The constables, Ahsanul Karim and Mominul Islam of Bogra District Police, received primary treatment at Police Lines Hospital.

Police sources said a gang of robbers, who gathered in the area to commit robbery, opened fire on a police patrol team as it challenged them. When police returned fire, some three robbers managed to flee, they added.

Later, police recovered three machetes, a Chinese axe and knife from the spot. The gang has many robbery cases against its members.

Newborn's body found in travel bag

regarding this." The DG said BGB will construct fences after getting fund from the government and had already submitted a project for 950km of fences.

"As part of jointly curbing transnational crimes, we also handed a list of 12,000 Bangladeshi criminal suspects to India so that they can find out whether any of those have fled there," the DG said.

BSF, in turn, agreed to work on handing over Bangladeshi prisoners soon, he added.

Road crashes kill 6

Six people, including a couple, were killed and six others injured in road accidents in three districts yesterday.

In Bogra, a couple was killed as a Dhaka-bound bus hit their motorcycle and three auto-rickshaws after the driver lost control over the vehicle on Bogra-Dhaka highway in Majhira area of Shajahanpur upazila.

The deceased were Shafiqul Islam, 35, of Shujabad area of the upazila and his wife Mukta Begum, 27. Shafiqul died on the spot while Mukta succumbed to her injuries at Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College Hospital in Bogra after half an hour.

Three passengers of the auto-rickshaws were also injured in the accidents, said police.

In Chittagong, three people were killed and three others were injured as a human hauler hit a roadside tree after the driver lost control over the vehicle on Chittagong-Cox's Bazar highway in Patiya area.

Two of the deceased were identified as Subrata Talukder, 50, and Abu Bakar, 50.

Abu Bakar was declared dead at BGC Trust Hospital while two others were declared dead at Chittagong Medical College Hospital, said Assistant Sub-inspector of CMCH Pankaj Barua.

Meanwhile UNB reports, a cattle trader was killed as a truck plunged into a ditch beside Bogra-Nagarbari highway after its driver lost his control over the vehicle in Dathiya Digor area of Raiganj upazila in Sirajganj.

The deceased was Abdul Latif, of Kishoreganj.

IRREGULARITIES IN RICE DISTRIBUTION AMONG POOR 4 including AL leader held

Police arrested a local Awami League (AL) leader in Panchbibi upazila of Joypurhat on Thursday evening allegedly for selling rice to well-off people instead of poor households at Awlai union violating a recent government order.

Recently, the food ministry prepared a policy to sell rice at Tk 10 per kilogramme to 50 lakh poor households at union levels during the lean periods of September-November and March-April.

Police said they found a list of 324 persons who were solvent and accused in arson

cases and bought the rice from the arrestee, Abdul Khaleque, a ward member and president of AL ward no-8. Villagers also staged demonstrations protesting the anomaly on Wednesday.

In another raid, police arrested three persons, including a woman, and seized 480kg rice of the rice distribution programme, which they were selling to a trader for a higher price at a market in Panchbibi upazila yesterday.

The trio are Aminul Islam of Atapur village, Amena Begum of Angra village, and Sohel Rana of Purba Bajitpur.

Bogra woman drowns

A woman drowned in a water body in Manikpotal village under Dhunat upazila of Bogra yesterday.

The deceased was Jamila Khatun, 47, wife of Ibrahim Ali of the village.

Quoting locals, Mizanur Rahman, officer-in-charge of Dhunat Police Station, said Jamila went to clean the pots in the nearby water body and suddenly fell into it as she slipped.

Later, her floating body was recovered from the water body.

meet in Delhi from October 12 to 15 to discuss issues of mutual interest.

On the status of Bimstec Free Trade Agreement which has been under negotiations for some years, Preeti said, "We would like to get some guidance from our leaders' meeting in Goa."

She said India considers Bimstec to be a "very important component" of its "Act East" policy. This is because it helps New Delhi connect with South East Asia which is experiencing an annual economic growth of 6.5 percent for a population of 1.5 billion and having a \$2.3 trillion economy, she said. She said there were a lot of commonalities among the member countries and "there are no issues" among them.

Amar said Bimstec would be celebrating two decades of its establishment next year and it was a good opportunity to rejuvenate and re-energise the grouping.

"We consider Bimstec as a very important platform to carry forward regional integration and it also puts in focus northeastern Indian state's development as they share border with two Bimstec countries Bangladesh and Myanmar," she said.

Set up in 1997 with the main themes of cooperation over transport connectivity, economic development, energy security and people-to-people contact, Bimstec held its first summit in Thailand that year.

The next summit was hosted by India in 2008 and the third in 2014.
