Elephants trample three to death

Three persons including a woman were trampled to death by wild elephants in Garo hills of Jhinaigati upazila under Sherpur district last night. The dead were Jahurul Haque, 50, Ohitun Begum, wife of Sunnat Ali of Panbar village, and Abdul Hai, 32 of Gurucharan Dudhnoi village. Anarullah, former chairman of Kangsha Union Parishad, said a herd of around 50-60 wild elephants entered the Panbar village from the Garo hills around 9:00pm. Normally, the villagers would try to drive away the elephants by beating drums, bursting crackers and burning torches, but the elephants were too fast, he said. The elephants also damaged crop fields and several houses. With the three, at least nine people were trampled by wild elephants in last four months in Jhitaigati and Sribordi.

Fire drill at Khilgaon school

A severely injured girl is put on a stretcher and lowered down with ropes from the roof of a five-storey building before being put on an ambulance safe and sound. The rescue scene unfolded during a drill of Bangladesh Fire Service and Civil Defence in the capital's Khilgaon Girls School and College yesterday marking the International Day for Disaster Reduction 2016. Around 25 students participated in the drill led by the fire department's Deputy Assistant Director Masudur Rahman Akand. "We learned a lot about safety issues and rescue processes... Now we will be able to save ourselves during disasters like earthquakes and... help others, said class IX student Humaira Akter Laboni. Terming the educational institution the "first smart school", Awami League lawmaker Saber Hossain Chowdhury said the drill would soon be conducted in others in the area.

Justice Ibrahim part of history: Dr Kamal

Two cousins 'raped'

Two cousins who came to the capital in search of jobs from Gopalganj district have allegedly been raped for several days by someone they knew and his accomplice. The girls, one aged around 17 and another 15, were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday evening. The victims told reporters at the hospital that they arrived in Dhaka on October 7 and met Mohammad Khokhon, 25, one of their acquaintances, who promised them employment at a garment factory. Khokhon took them to a house at Madhubagh where he raped the older girl. His accomplice Mohiuddin, 45, violated the younger one, they said. The victims said that they managed to flee yesterday afternoon and rushed to Ramna Police Station with the help of a passerby. A case was filed with the police station. Mashuure Rahman, officer-in-charge of Ramna Police Station, said they arrested Mohiuddin from Madhubagh area while Khokhon is on the run.

Khadiza's life support removed

The life support of Khadiza Begum Nargis, who is now undergoing treatment at the Square Hospitals in Dhaka, has been removed as her condition is improving gradually, doctors said. She was still unconscious and kept in oxygen support, they added. She will be under observation for at least two to three more weeks, said AM Rejaus Satter, a physician at the hospital. Meanwhile, Health Minister Mohammad Nasim visited Khadiza last evening.
