Mohammedan win at last

Mohammedan Sporting Club tasted their first victory in their 10th match of the JB Bangladesh Premier League with a 1-0 win over high-flying Sheikh Jamal DC at the Bangabandhu National Stadium yesterday.

Former national striker Towhidul Alam Sabuj separated the sides three minutes into the second half with a placing shot from a goal-mouth-melee following a corner from Nzekou Patrice.

The win took the Black and Whites to ninth position with nine points from 10 outings while despite a first defeat, Sheikh Jamal stayed on top with 19 points along with Rahmatganj MFS, who have played a match less.

SHEIKH RUSSEL BACK TO LOSING WAYS

Meanwhile, after breaking the curse for only two matches, Sheikh Russel KC reverted to their losing ways by conceding a single-goal defeat against

Arambagh KS in a JB Bangladesh Premier League encounter at the Bangabandhu National Stadium yesterday.

Brazilian forward Thiago Tyson Silva struck the decisive goal to help Arambagh collect their third win from 10 outings and in doing so provided Sheikh Russel with their seventh defeat. Arambagh have now moved up to fifth position while Sheikh

draw and having handed Mohammedan a 1-0 defeat in their previous two matches, Sheikh Russel reverted to type yesterday, with national strikers Zahid Hasan Emily and Shakhawat Hossain Rony exhibiting equally unimpressive football as they did for the national team in Bhutan last week.

However the former champions had the lion's share of possession, yet saw their scoring opportunities spurned by Rony and Jean Jules Ikanga. Rony missed two absolute sitters as he headed far off target from inside the danger zone while Ikanga saw his low-drive from close range veer wide off the far post.

With the former champions squandering their chances, Arambagh took the lead against the run of play on 37 minutes when Tyson played a one-two with Mohammad Abdullah before driving a left-footer from the edge of the box into the back of the net, which glanced off of Sheikh Russel's Moanem Khan Raju, leaving goalkeeper Ziaur Rahman completely deceived.

Russel remained second from bottom with a measly five points.

The tenth round of the professional league resumed yesterday amidst concerns of crowd attendance as well as players' under-performance after the national team's debacle in Bhutan last week, and the concerns came true as the day saw only a few hundred spectators and another poor display from both sides.

Pique eyes Barcelona presidency

Barcelona defender Gerard Pique believes he can take the unusual route into club politics rather than management when his playing career comes to an end by becoming Barca president.

The Catalan giants are run by a president voted for by the club's near 150,000 members with mandates lasting up to six years.

"I want to be president of Barca. It is the step I would like to take when I retire. I don't see myself as a coach, I don't think I would enjoy it that much," Pique told Catalan TV station TV3.

"I could do very well for this club as president because it is my passion."

Pique, 29, announced his decision to retire from international football after the 2018 World Cup earlier this week due to the latest in a series of attacks on his commitment to play for Spain.

During Spain's 2-0 win at Albania on Tuesday was falsely accused of cutting the colours of the Spanish flag off his long-sleeved shirt as the colours appeared only on the short-sleeved version of the shirt.

Pique has also been consistently jeered by Spain fans when playing for the national team, in part due to his public barbs at Real Madrid and for his outspoken support for a referendum on Catalan independence.

C'Ron feeling confident

Three-time World Player of the Year Cristiano Ronaldo insists he will have a "spectacular" season despite a slow start to the campaign caused by knee ligament damage.

Ronaldo was sidelined for two months by a sprained left knee ligament picked up during Portugal's Euro 2016 final triumph over France, forcing him to miss Madrid's first three games of the season.

He has scored just once in four La Liga games since making his return, but netted five times in Portugal's routs over Andorra and the Faroe Islands in the past week.

"I had a serious injury, I was out for two months. Now I am back and at the start I have less confidence, but bit-by-bit I am feeling better and more confident. I feel that I am back to what I was," Ronaldo told Madrid sports daily Marca on Friday.

"The season is very long and I am sure I am going to have another spectacular season."

Ronaldo is expected to sign a bumper new contract with the European champions until 2021 in the coming days and reiterated his intention to retire in the Spanish capital after becoming the club's all-time top goalscorer since joining from Manchester United in 2009.

"I didn't expect to be at Real Madrid for so long. I have already said that I want to retire here. It is the club in my heart."

"It gives me the opportunity to win individual and collective trophies. What I want most of all is to renew (my contract) with Real Madrid and continue here for many years to come."

Despite bagging two Champions League titles and winning the Ballon d'Or twice during his time with Real, Ronaldo has still only won one La Liga title in seven full seasons.

Zinedine Zidane's men need to get back to winning ways at Real Betis on Saturday after three consecutive La Liga draws have seen them cede top spot to Atletico Madrid on goal difference.

However, with still a two-point lead over champions Barcelona, Ronaldo is convinced Madrid can end a five-year wait to win La Liga.



England set Germany friendly date

England will travel to Germany for a friendly international in Dortmund on March 22, the Football Association announced Friday.

The match will be England's first fixture in 2017 and could mark the start of a new manager's time in charge if interim boss Gareth Southgate does not get the job on a full-time basis.

Southgate, who recently oversaw a 2-0 win at home to Malta and a goalless draw away to Slovenia during England's 2018 World Cup qualification group, has two games left on his temporary deal, a World Cup qualifier against old rivals Scotland and a Wembley friendly with Spain in November.

Gerrard back home for treatment

Steven Gerrard is back home in Liverpool, where he's rehabbing the troublesome hamstring that disrupted his Major League Soccer season, Los Angeles Galaxy coach Bruce Arena confirmed.

Gerrard will miss Sunday's match against the Houston Dynamo, and his status for the remainder of the campaign is unclear.

"Steven had a re-occurrence of his hamstring injury. He's obviously out for a bit," Arena told Spectrum SportsNet.
