C'nawabganj DC dies at meeting

What is more shocking than the news that you have lost your beloved one with whom you have had a chat just a few moments back?

This was the fate the family of Zahidul Islam had to undergo yesterday as they lost him by a sudden death, of which he had no warning.

Zahidul, deputy commissioner of Chapainawabganj, went to the office of the divisional commissioner (DC) of Rajshahi in the morning to attend a meeting.

He suddenly collapsed on the ground in the conference room while talking over phone. He was declared dead at Rajshahi Medical College Hospital, said sources at the DC office...

He left behind his wife, two daughters, one son and a host of well-wishers to mourn his death.

His namaz-e-janaza was held on the Nimtala Eidgah ground in Chapainawabganj town at 4:15pm.

Later, his body was taken to his Suktail village home in Gopalganj Sadar upazila, where he will be buried.

Zahidul joining as the district's deputy commissioner early this year took several commendable initiatives, including declaring the district a "Green District"...

Meanwhile, Chapainawabganj Journalist Forum, Dhaka and Diar, a socio-cultural organisation, expressed deep shock at the demise of the deputy commissioner.

ACC arrests BRTA assistant director

STAFF CORRESPONDENT The Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) yesterday arrested Abdul Hannan, assistant director of BRTA, at his Gazipur office for allegedly abusing power.

Hannan issued fake registration and clearance certificates to shift 18 vehicles from Keraniganj circle to Manikganj when he was an assistant director of BRTA in Manikganj circle between January 18, 2009 and April 3, 2011, ACC Public Relations Officer Pranab Kumar Bhattacharya said.

But the vehicles were not registered from Dhaka [Keraniganj] and no clearance certificates were issued for including those to Manikganj circle, he said.

Stalker gets six months' jail

CU CORRESPONDENT A mobile court sentenced a young man to six months' imprisonment for stalking a female student of Chittagong University (CU) at CU Shuttle train yesterday.

The convict, Md Babul, 28, a vagabond, became abusive at the train. Hearing the student's hue and cry, other students onboard beat Babul and handed him to Hathazari police, said law enforcers.

Youth murders sister's husband, turns himself in

Around 8:30am yesterday, a twenty-year-old youth turned up at Kotwali Police Station of Chittagong city and said he had murdered his brother-in-law.

Police first interrogated him, and then visited the house he lived in and found a body there packed in a sack, from which blood was oozing out.

The deceased was Anjan Dhar, 35, a goldsmith and husband of the youth's sister.

Police recovered the body from his rented house at Afim Goli in Teribazar area, a day after he was stabbed to death by his brother-in-law Babul Dhar.

Sub-inspector Sumit Das of Kotwali, who visited the scene, said Babul used to work with Anjan in a gold ornament shop in nearby Hazari Goli area and live with him and his sister at the rented flat.

Quoting Babul, police said Anjan was killed between 9:00am to 10:00am on Sunday. Babul was angry because his brother-in-law used to have frequent quarrels with his

sister Priyanka Dhar over Anjan's "extra-marital affair", said the SI.

He said Babul's sister and her two children were outside the house when he was murdered.

Police quoted Priyanka as saying that around 2:00pm Sunday, Sumit informed her that his brother-in-law went to Manikchari and asked Priyanka to go to her father's house. Accordingly, Priyanka went to her father's house with her two children and spent the night there, police said.

In the morning, police informed Priyanka of the killing.

"We are interrogating the family. The sack and body would be examined by the Criminal Investigation Department (CID). After investigation it could be known whether Babul alone did the murder or someone else was with him," said SI Sumit.

Suman Dhar, younger brother of Anjan, said Priyanka might also have been involved in the murder. Babul and Priyanka were in police custody.

Man held with 1kg gold at Dhaka airport

Customs Intelligence (CI) yesterday arrested a person with gold bars, weighing over one kilogramme, inside his body at the capital's Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport.

Noticing suspicious movement, CI detectives interrogated Md Khurshed Hossain and made him admit that he was carrying eight gold bars in four packets pushed through his rectum in the toilet of the airplane half an hour before it landed in Dhaka, informed Moinul Khan, director general of customs intelligence.

Khurshed also admitted that he and his gold smuggling partner Imran Hossain lived in Sharjah, United Arab Emirates.

Had the gold been successfully smuggled into the country, it would be sold in different markets in Chittagong, Khurshed told CI officials.

Architect Rafiq Azam invited to Venice exhibition

Md Rafiq Azam, principal architect of a Dhaka-based architectural firm "SHATOOTO", was selected to display his thoughts and innovative projects at the 2016 Venice Architecture Biennale, running from May 28 to November 27, in Italy, according to a press release.

He was invited for the second time after 2014 when he was the first Bangladeshi architect to be invited to the exhibition.

As part of 15th International Architecture Exhibition of "La Biennale di Venezia", the event "Time-Space-Existence", organised by GAA-Foundation, brings together architects from six continents.

Azam was awarded with some of the most influential architecture awards in the past few years, including the A A A 2015 Award, Pertubuhan Akitak Malaysia Award, Emirates Glass Leading European Architects' Forum Award, South Asian Architect of the year Award, and Cityscape Architecture Awards.
