kids, killed as India, Pakistan exchange fire on border

Two children and another civilian were killed along with a soldier in firing across the border between India and Pakistan, officials from both sides said yesterday, as tensions soar between the nuclear-armed rivals. Pakistans military said an 18-month-old girl and another civilian were killed on its side of the border in "unproweded firing" by the Indian army.

"Due to Indian unproweded firing last night a civilian, what mamad Lait of village langlora, and a minor Haniya, age one and a half, embraced shahadat (marryrdom) while seven civilians were injured, "a military statement said.

The firing took place across the border between Indian-held Kashmir and Pakistan's Punjab province in the villages of Harpal, Pukhlian and Charwah, the statement said.

Robot judges to deal with cases



An AI judge has accurately predicted most verdicts of the European Court of Human Rights, and might soon be making important decisions about cases. Scientists built an artificially intelligence computer that was able to look at legal evidence as well as considering ethical questions to decide how a case should be decided. And it predicted those with 79 percent accuracy, according to its creators. The algorithm looked at data sets made up 584

Wave of strikes hits Iraq's Mosul

IS puts up tough defence as federal forces move forward in several areas; UN planning for 150,000 displaced

Iraqi forces advancing on Mosul faced stiff resistance from the Islamic State group yesterday despite the US-led coalition unleashing an unprecedented wave of air strikes to support the week-old offensive.

Federal forces and Kurdish peshumega fighters were moving forward in several areas. AFP correspondents on various fronts said, but the lithad stayers hitting back with shelling supper fire, suicide car bombs and booly traps.

IS has also attempted to draw attention away from losses around Mosul with attacks on Iraqi forces deswhere in the country, the latest coming on Sunday near the Jordanian border.

Following a weekend visit to Iraq by US Secretary of Defence Ashton Carter, American officials said the coalition was providing the most air support yet to the operation.

One week into Mosul operation, all objectives met thus far, and more coalition air strikes than any other 7-day period of war against ISIL [IS].

Brett McCartk, the top US envoy to the 60-nation coalition, wrote on social media.

"There were 32 strikes with 1,776 munitions delivered against Daesh (IS) targets for the week of October 17-October 23," the spokesman for the coalition, Colonel John Dorrian, told AFP.
