MP, 7 others charged with war crimes

The prosecution has pressed six charges against eight Mymensingh men including Jatiya Party lawmaker MA Hannan and his son for their alleged crimes against humanity during the Liberation War in 1971.


After receiving the formal charges and other documents, the International Crimes Tribunal-1 yesterday fixed December 11 to decide about taking the charges into cognisance.

Hannan, 80, lawmaker from Trishal in Mymensingh, is the second sitting lawmaker facing charges of committing crimes during the War. Executed war criminal Salauddin Quader Chowdhury was arrested in December 2010 when he was a lawmaker of BNP, the then opposition in parliament.

The other accused are Hannan's son Rafique Sajjad, 62, Khandakar Golam Sabbir Ahmed, 69, Mizanur Rahman Mintu, 63, Hormuj Ali, 73, Mohammad Abdus Sattar, 64, Mohammad Fakruzzaman, 61, and Khandakar Golam Rabbani, 63.

Clinton campaign jolted

FBI obtains warrant to probe more emails; top Democrat accuses bureau chief of breaking the law by trying to influence election

Federal investigators have secured a warrant to examine newly discovered emails related to Hillary Clinton's private server, a source familiar with the matter said on Sunday, as a prominent Democrat accused FBI Director James Comey of breaking the law by trying to influence the election.

The warrant will allow the Federal Bureau of Investigation to examine the emails to see if they are relevant to its probe of the private email server used



for government work by Clinton, the Democratic presidential nominee, while she was secretary of state from 2009 to 2013.

Comey came under heavy pressure from Democrats on Sunday to quickly provide details of the emails, as

Clinton allies worried the prolonged controversy could extend beyond the Nov 8 election and cast a shadow over a Clinton transition if she wins the White House.

Comey's disclosure of the email discovery in a letter to Congress on Friday plunged the final days of the White House race between Clinton and Republican Donald Trump into turmoil. Clinton had opened a recent lead over Trump in national polls, but SEE PAGE 11 COL 1

BROADBAND SERVICE GP fined Tk 30cr

The telecom regulator has slapped a Tk 30 crore fine on leading mobile phone operator Grameenphone for providing internet broadband service to clients breaching rules.

"Mobile phone operators cannot go into internet broadband service like ISPs. That is a violation of rules," Shahjahan Mahmood, chairman of Bangladesh Telecommunication Regulatory Commission (BTRC), told The Daily Star yesterday.

"We have imposed a Tk 30 crore penalty," he said. There was no official

reaction from the GP to the The penalty is related to

GP's GO Broadband initiative, a high-speed internet service offered by Agni Systems and ADN Telecom in partnership with GP. The network solutions

were provided to state-run Sonali Bank.

The introduction of the service in 2014 prompted the Internet Service Providers Association of Bangladesh (ISPAB) to lodge a complaint with the SEE PAGE 13 COL 5

They vote for the first time

22 union parishads in former enclaves in 3 dists go to polls

Yesterday was the first time she exercised her right to vote in her hundred and two years of life.

All these years she had been hearing about people voting to elect their Kashem, who casted his vote at representatives, said Shokho Bewa, an inhabitant of Baniatari village, formerly Dashiarchhara enclave of India, under Phulbari upazila of Kurigram.

Helped by relatives to come to the Nagdah Government Primary School polling centre, she casted her vote.

She seemed very happy as she spoke with The Daily Star after casting her ballot.

Like her, hundreds others who participated in elections to 22 Union Parishads (UP) under former enclaves

in Lalmonirhat, Kurigram and Panchagarh showed great enthusiasm as first-time voters.

"In the previous years, I stood outside polling centres but this time I could get in and vote," said Abul Kamarhat Govt Primary School in Sreerampur union (formerly Latamari enclave) of Patgram upazila, Lalmonirhat.

The elderly man also came to the polling station with support of family members.

The voters enjoyed their first such experience as no incidents of vote rigging, stuffing of ballot boxes, polling station occupying or other irregularities were reported.

Chief Election Commissioner Kazi

Rakibuddin Ahmad at a press briefing at the Election Commission's media centre last evening said the elections were held peacefully.

However, the previous UP polls in other parts of the country witnessed huge electoral irregularities and vio-

As many as 145 lives were lost in violence over partisan UP polls held across the country in six phases from March to June this year, according to Shushashoner Jonno Nagorik (Shujan), a civil rights body.

But the inhabitants of the recently dissolved enclaves enjoyed almost free, fair and peaceful elections, reports our Lalmonirhat, Kurigram and Thakurgoan correspondents.
