# Iraqi forces close in on Mosul

Baghdadi calls upon IS men to fight to the last, attack Saudi Arabia, Turkey

The reclusive leader of the Islamic State group broke a nearly year-long silence as Iraqi forces closed in on Mosul yesterday, urging his jihadists to hold their ground. It was Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi's first statement since Iraqi

forces launched a massive offensive on October 17 to retake Mosul, where the IS chief declared the group's "caliphate" "Do not retreat," Baghdadi said in a purported message

released by an IS-affiliated outlet. "Holding your ground with honour is a thousand times easier than retreating in shame."

In June 2014, days after jihadist fighters swept across swathes of Iraq, he made a rare public appearance in Mosul and announced the creation of an Islamic "state" straddling Iraq and Syria.

The "caliphate" has been shrinking steadily since last year and Iragi forces earlier this week reached the outskirts of Mosul, the jihadists' last major stronghold in Iraq.

If authentic, the recording entitled "This is what God and his messenger have promised us", would be Baghdadi's first since December 2015 and a rare sign of life.

Rumours have swirled about the Iraqi jihadist leader's health and movements but his whereabouts are unclear.

## Kamdeb, a rare, evergreen tree



I visited the National Botanical

Garden in Mirpur more than once last year to take photographs of a few trees and flowers. The garden not only gives you the space to relax and get some fresh air, it also provides visitors and nature lovers with the opportunity to see some rare trees, herbs and shrubberies.

Kamdeb is one such rare tree in the garden. Its scientific name is Callophyllum Polyanthum, while it is locally known as Kiroli, kaan, chandua, toilo, etc. According to botanist Shamsul Huq, there are three trees in the garden. No sapling of the tree was produced. No grafting is possible either.

## Stalker kills RMG worker in Savar

Father killed for protesting daughter's stalking in Manikganj; speech-impaired girl raped in Bogra

Amid a rise in violence against women in the country, a female garment worker has been killed and a speech-impaired girl raped in Savar and Bogra.

In another incident, a father was allegedly killed for protesting against stalking of his school-going girl in Manikganj.

As many as 294 women and children were admitted to eight one stop crisis centres (OCC) across the country between July and September, indicating a rise of above 10 percent compared to the period from April to June, said Abul Hossain, project director of the OCC.

The garment worker, identified as Kalpona Begum, 24, was attacked around 1:30pm on Wednesday by a "mentally-

challenged" man named Shirajul who had been stalking her for a while, said SM Kamruzzaman, officer-in-charge of Savar Model Police Station.

He stabbed her with a knife at Hemayetpur Natunpara of Savar when she was going for her evening duty at Apparel Four Ltd, the OC quoted witnesses as saying. Local people caught Shirajul, beat him up and handed him over to police.

Kalpona, married to Abdur Razzak, was rushed to Enam Medical College Hospital with severe injuries around 2:00pm that day. But struggling with excessive bleeding, she died yesterday morning, the hospital authority said.
