The movie is about a city infested with crime, where Affleck's character goes on a mission to find the men who killed his family and bring the long-awaited justice to the city.

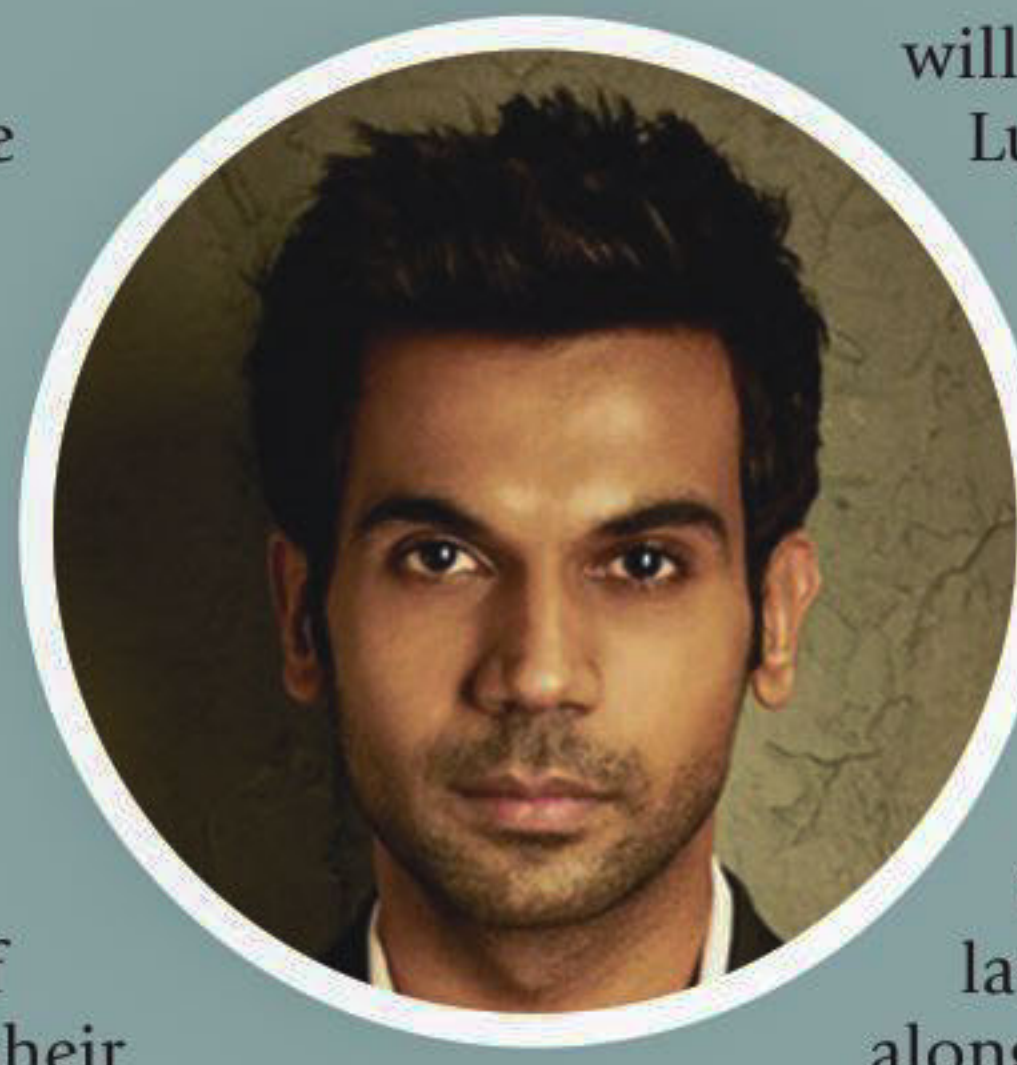
Affleck was last seen in "Triple Nine", and will appear in Kenneth Lonergan's upcoming "Manchester by the Sea" with Michelle Williams.
