Barisal man to die for killing wife

A Barisal court yesterday sentenced a man to death for killing his wife for dowry in 2012.

The convict -- Kamal Akon of Mundupasha village under Ujirpur upazila -- was also fined Tk 1 lakh.

According to the prosecution, Kamal beat his wife Tania to death for dowry on October 6 in 2012.

Following the incident, victim's mother filed a murder case.

CU protests B'baria mayhem

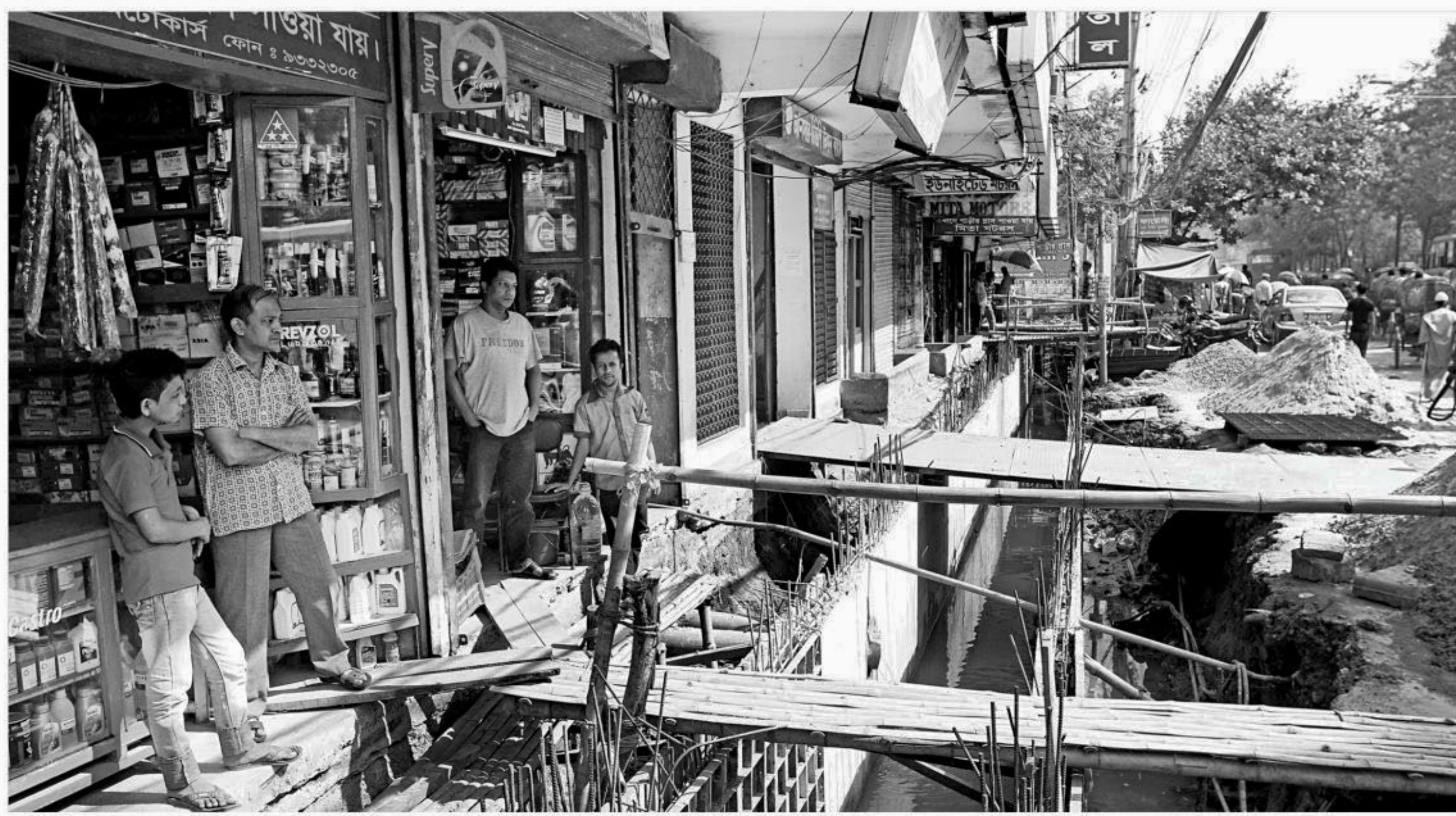
320kg of jatka seized in N'ganj

Noor Hossain Day observed

Different social and political organisations yesterday held various programmes, marking Shaheed Noor Hossain Day.

They commemorated the supreme sacrifice of pro-democratic activist who laid down his life during an anti-Ershad movement in the late 80s to restore democracy.

Leaders and activists of political parties, including Awami League and BNP and their associate bodies, have paid tributes to the martyr by placing wreaths at Noor Hossain Square in the capital's Gulistan.

Shaheed Noor Hossain Sangsad placed floral wreaths at the square and held prayers at his grave in Jurain. The organisation later held a discussion at Jatiya Press Club.

Communist Party of Bangladesh also observed the day as Shaheed Noor Hossain-Tito Day and also held a discussion in its office.

Meanwhile, HM Ershad's Jatiya Party observed the day as "Democracy Day" and organised a discussion in its chairman's Banani office. Leaders of the party claimed to have "restored democracy" in the country and said people wanted to see Ershad in power again.

Painting the historic slogan "Swairachar Nipat Jak, Ganatantra Mukti Pak" (down with autocracy, let democracy be freed) on his back and chest, Noor joined the movement of then opposition parties on November 10, 1987.

SB takes charge of Ctg airport immigration dept

Rab detains five headed for Iraq illegally

A team of the Special Branch from Dhaka yesterday took charge of the immigration department of Shah Amanat International Airport in Chittagong, as part of a government initiative to hand over the stewardship of all immigration departments to SB from other branches of the police.

The Chittagong Metropolitan Police used to oversee this department, with a team of 65 personnel, said Assistant Commissioner Palash Kanti Nath of the team.

He told The Daily Star that the public administration department would gradually hand over charge of all immigration departments to SB.

Mohammad Shahriar Alam, superintendent of police of SB, who leads the new SB team of 40 at the airport, said, "We started our operations and are observing the situation. If necessary we

would bring more personnel."

Meanwhile, there were allegations that the police officials overseeing the airport's immigration department were involved in human trafficking through the airport.

Besides, there were frequent incidents of detention of illegal immigrants heading out to various countries, especially in the Middle East.

Even a day before, on Wednesday, the Rapid Action Battalion detained five persons at the airport who were trying to go to Iraq using fake documents, said a press release yesterday.

The five--Tuhin Islam, 26, Md Rasel Dali, 27, Mohammad Sohag, 32, Md Ripon, 23 of Munsiganj and Sajib Ahmed, 30 of Netrakona--had passed the immigration check point and were about to board an Air Arabia flight. They were supposed to pay

FOR RESIDENT INFO COLLECTION Militants can't reside in capital anymore

Says DMP boss

Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) Commissioner Asaduzzaman Mia yesterday said militants can no longer reside in the city due to steps like beat policing and collection of citizens' and tenants' information.

Police activities have now become easier as the building and apartment owners collect tenants' information and verify those, the commissioner told the monthly crime conference held at the DMP headquarters in the capital.

Meeting sources said police have already made entry of information of around three lakh city dwellers in its Citizen Information Management System.

The crime conference, attended by officers-in-charge of all the police stations and deputy commissioners of all divisions and high police officials, discussed the recent rise in rape incidents.

The sources said the DMP boss asked his forces to remain alert so that no misunderstanding arose with members of other forces. He also instructed to inform the high officials if anyone from law enforcement agencies violates traffic rules.

The commissioner asked the traffic cops to take snaps of the rule violators, if possible. He also awarded officers of different units for their performances.

Senior assistant commissioner of Rampur Traffic Zone (east division) was awarded for the seventh consecutive months for playing a significant role in removing the area's gridlock.
