

### Qualified for medical study, but worried for finance

A brilliant student's dream of pursuing medical education faces uncertainty due to poverty. Jahidul Islam, second son of Azizar Rahman and Kurkum Begum of Arulia village under Bogra Sadar upazila, got chance for MBBS study in Patuakhali Medical College this year. He had obtained GPA-5 in SSC and HSC examination in 2013 and 2015 respectively.

Azizar was an inhabitant of Purba Shujatpur village under Sonatola upazila of Bogra but the Jamuna river devoured all their landed property, forcing them to take shelter at Arulia village under Sadar upazila 25 years ago, family sources said. "I lost my eyesight due to an unknown disease when I was a student of Class VII. Now I am conducting my six-member family through hardship, often depending on others," Azizar said. Azizar and his wife Kurkum Begum have sought help from generous people for fulfilling their son's dream to be doctor. Jahidul's schoolteacher Ebadat Hossain said local benevolent people collected Tk 30 thousand for his admission to medical college and other related purposes but he would need financial support for continuation of his study.

Police recovered the body of a young man from beside Dinajpur-Rangpur highway under Taraganj upazila of Rangpur yesterday. The identity of the deceased, aged about 38-year-old, could not be known immediately. Officer-in-Charge Abdul Latif of Taraganj Police Station said being informed by locals, police recovered the body from Doanipara village in the upazila around 11:00am. Police sent the body, which bore several injury marks, to Rangpur Medical College Hospital for autopsy, the OC added.

## Spare us from land acquisition

*Demand Mymensingh char people*

Thousands of people from five villages held a rally on the bank of the Brahmaputra river at Char Ishwardia village in Sadar upazila yesterday, demanding removal of their homesteads and farmlands from the acquisition list made by the administration. The local administration has made a list to acquire 4,366 acres for infrastructure development of Mymensingh division. The villagers have been protesting the proposed land acquisition since last month, sources said. Speakers at the rally said there are vast char lands on both sides of Brahmaputra, but the administration targeted the densely populated char areas. "When there is a serious scarcity of

farmlands and the government is trying to save them, the administration has made a list to acquire around 4,366 acres of land, most of which are used for growing different crops round the year," they also said. "We asked the administration to implement the first phase covering 1,220 acres. We also asked why the number has been increased from 1,220 acres to 4,366 acres, but they did not give a clear answer," the speakers said. They also alleged that vested and influential quarters in connivance with a section of government officials have a plan to grab the land of poor and helpless char people. "We are ready to assist the government to build a beautiful city, but the khas land should be used on selective

basis to avoid losses of the poor village people," the speakers said. The proposed area includes vast tracts of farmlands and homesteads in Char Anandipur, Char Gobindapur, Char Ishwardia, Char Bhawanipur, Char Durgapur, Char Jelkhana and Char Laxmir Algi in Sadar upazila. There are around 20,000 families in the listed areas and most of them are small and marginal farmers and sharecroppers, locals said. President of Char Ishwardia union unit of Awami League Osman Gani was in the chair. The villagers recently submitted memorandums to Religious Affairs Minister Principal Motiur Rahman and Mymensingh deputy commissioner in this regard.

### Madrassa girl raped, culprit arrested

Pirojpur police arrested a youth yesterday on charge of raping a Class V madrasa girl in Sadar upazila of the district on Wednesday. The arrestee, Mohsin Majhi, 25, son of Alauddin Majhi, is a resident of Durgapur village in the upazila. Police said Mohsin picked up the 12-year-old girl, also an Ebtedia examinee from Durgapur Nesaria Alim Madrasa, from her house around 11:30pm when her mother was asleep and father not at home. He later took the girl inside the toilet of a nearby school and raped her. After searching for her whereabouts, family members found her inside the school toilet around 2:30am. Sensing the presence of victim's family members, Mohsin fled the scene. Following a case filed by the victim's mother, police arrested Mohsin yesterday, Officer-in-Charge Masumur Rahman of Sadar Police Station.

### Dinajpur temple looted

Criminals looted gold ornaments worth about Tk 1 lakh from a temple in Natunbazar area under Birampur upazila of the district early yesterday. ### Teen found dead

Police recovered the body of a teenage boy from a water body at Pachrokhii village in Sadar upazila of the district yesterday morning. The deceased was identified as Tariqul Islam, 18, son of Amzad Hossain of Reiu village in the upazila. Locals found the body floating in the Koyar Beel around 8:15am and informed the law enforcers. The reason behind the death could not be known immediately, said police.

### Youth kills brother

A man was killed allegedly by his younger brother at Tashullya village in Nawabganj upazila on the outskirts of the capital on Wednesday. The deceased was Falan Biswas, 50, son of Hiralal Biswash of the village. Police said an altercation took place between Falan and his younger brother Pabitra Biswas, 35, over ownership of a piece of land in the morning. At one stage, Pabitra hit Falan with a bamboo stick, leaving him unconscious, said Shafiqul Islam, second officer of Nawabganj Police Station. Falan later died at Dhaka Medical College Hospital. Pabitra went into hiding soon after the incident, said police.

### SCHOOLBOY MURDER 2 abductors to die in Comilla

A tribunal here on Wednesday sentenced two people to death for killing a schoolboy in 2013. Judge of Comilla Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal Aziz Ahmed Bhuiya pronounced the verdict. The convicts are Mahe Alam Nayan and Kuddus Alam Rabin. According to the prosecution, Shihab, a Class IV student of a local school and son of Nazrul Islam of Ratnabati village, was picked up by a gang of criminals on January 27 in 2013. The abductors demanded Tk 50 lakh as ransom from Nazrul. Four people were later held. Following their confessional statements, police recovered Shihab's body from a septic tank on February 4 in 2013.
